Once this application is received by the Business Office and approved by the Agility Committee it will be forwarded to the host club. The host club shall coordinate, with the applicant, the classes to be offered to the applicant.

- The Apprentice Judge should work with the host club to agree on a schedule of classes based on expected number of runs, finish time, etc.
- The host club must offer the Apprentice Judge at least one class of each titling type of class scheduled each day of the trial. The host club may offer the Apprentice Judge all classes all weekend if the trial is expected to be small.
- The host club shall offer the Apprentice Judge no less than 100 runs per day in any combination of Regular, Gamblers and Jumpers. If the total number of runs for the entire trial, per day, is less than 100, the Apprentice Judge shall be offered all runs for judging.
