### DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

**From the south:** Take I-15 North to Exit 289: Bangerter. Turn left on Bangerter and go approximately 3.8 miles. Turn left on 2700 West. At 4 way stop (0.7 mi.) turn right onto 14400 S, 2834 W is the second house (gray house) on the right. Turn in at 2<sup>nd</sup> driveway and drive back past the barn to park.

**From the north:** Take I-15 South to Exit 289: Bangerter. Turn right on Bangerter and go approximately 3.5 miles. Turn left on 2700 West. At 4 way stop (0.7 mi.) turn right onto 14400 S, 2834 W is the second house (gray house) on the right. Turn in at 2<sup>nd</sup> driveway and drive back past the barn to park.

#### MOVE-UPS

After submitting your entry form, we will accept move-ups or changes *in writing only* (or e-mail to [QTrackerUT@gmail.com](mailto:QTrackerUT@gmail.com)) through Oct 5, 2020 at 6PM. No changes will be accepted after this date. There will be no same day move-ups during the trial. Move-up forms must be completed and turned into the score table within 30 minutes of the end of the last class on Saturday.

#### AWARDS

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run.

#### REFUNDS

There shall be **no** refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. **If this event is cancelled due to city, county or state requirements related to the COVID-19 pandemic, entry fees will be refunded in full.**

## **EQUIPMENT**

Rubberized contacts: A-Frame (5"6" and slatted), Teeter, and Dog Walk; Open Tunnels (24" diameter, 12', 15' and 20'); Weave Poles (24"); Displaceable Tire Jump; Winged and Non-Winged Jumps.

## **TRAINING IN THE RING (NEW ASCA RULE)**

Toys may be brought into the arena for training purposes. These toys may not involve food or treats of any kind, may not make noise, or may not leave parts behind. All handlers declaring toys will mark the gate sheet with a "T" at the run check-in and will run in their regular place on the running order. Upon entering the ring, handlers must declare to the judge that they have a toy. They will be immediately eliminated whether or not the toy is used and will have the specified time for training in the ring. If handlers bring a toy in the ring without declaring it, they will be asked to leave immediately. It is permitted to toss a toy a short distance but remember that the dog aggression rules are in effect for dogs who leave the ring to retrieve a toy. (Effective June 1, 2019)

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- ASCA agility trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs and you do not have to have an ASCA registration or QTracking number to participate.
- If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd include your dog's ASCA registration number on the entry form.
- If your dog is not ASCA registered and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA QTracking number and include it on the entry form. An ASCA Service Membership and QTracking Number Form is included with this premium and is also available at [www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org).
- The postmark (not the delivery date) will determine the entry order. Any Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient signature.
- There will be a \$35.00 service charge for any returned check. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- Confirmations and other communications are sent primarily via e-mail. It is your responsibility to make sure that the secretary's e-mail address QTrackerUT@gmail.com is allowed by your spam blocker, and to change options that strip attachments from emails.

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of American with Wasatch Working Australian Shepherd Club as the sponsoring club.

**Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial including the following:**

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of are eligible to compete in ASCA agility trials.
- Exhibitors should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in sufficient control to perform all the obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- Exhibitors agree that if their dog(s) is (are) left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owner/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- No food, toys, tents, crates or other aids or devices shall be permitted within 10' of the ring.
- All dogs shall be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.
- The organizing committee may not refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization. Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption list, description of classes, levels and division are included in the current ASCA Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook. A copy of the handbook may be downloaded free from the ASCA website: [www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org).

### The Ultimate Agility Adven-Chair 2020

Compete in the 2020 WWASC ASCA sanctioned agility trials to be eligible for the Ultimate Agility Adven-Chair. You must compete in both of the 2020 WWASC ASCA agility trials to be eligible. Each 10-point Q is worth 1 point and a 5-point Q is worth 1/2 point. Trial dates to qualify Jun 20 - 21, and Oct 10 - 11.

WWASC will award the High Point Aussie and Highest Point Non-Aussie with an agility chair with table embroidered with the 2020 Adven-Chair title and your dog's name.

**AGREEMENT**

**IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT**—(1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s) and handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents; as well as ASCA®'s affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees, judges, contractors, insurers, and agents. (3) Applicant enters into this Agreement in consideration for being allowed to submit an entry form and, if approved, to take part in related activities of ASCA® and/or its affiliates. (4) Applicant acknowledges entering into this Agreement voluntarily, after the opportunity to obtain independent legal review of it and to have questions about its likely meaning answered through such review. (5) Applicant accepts the terms of this Agreement not only on his/her own behalf but also for his/her successors, assigns, beneficiaries, heirs, parents/guardians, and anyone else who might raise a claim on his/her behalf or as a result of her suffering harm. (6) To the extent any provision or application of this Agreement turns out to be unenforceable, the rest of it still remains fully effective. (7) This Agreement is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice-of-law rules, and—to the extent permitted by law—any legal action by Applicant that names Releasees as one or more defendants shall be filed and heard solely in the state or federal courts serving the county of ASCA®'s headquarters: Brazos County, Texas. (8) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event. (9) Applicant represents that the dog(s) being entered is/are not known to pose a hazard to persons, other dogs, or property and that all required rabies and other vaccinations under the state and local law of the dog's state of residence are current. (10) Applicant acknowledges awareness of and assumes the risk associated with his/her participation and that of his/her dog(s) in this event and related activities, among which are personal injury to Applicant and those affiliated with Applicant, injury to Applicant's dog(s), and damage to Applicant's property. As but a few examples, Applicant and/or his/her dog(s) may be injured from the condition of (or failure to warn of the condition of) floors, stairways, lighting, security measures or a lack of them, electrical devices, fittings, show rings, parking areas, motor vehicles, and unfamiliar animals and people. (11) Applicant releases Releasees from any claim or liability whatsoever arising from any injury, harm, liability, or demand in anyway said to occur during or in connection with related events, also waiving any right to assert such claims that he/she otherwise might have in the absence of this Agreement. (12) Applicant also agrees to indemnify Releasees from any claim that Applicant or those acting on Applicant's behalf, for Applicant's benefit, or in Applicant's place, might assert against Releasees. The obligation in this regard extends even to Applicant's paying settlements, judgments, and expenses and costs of legal defense incurred by Releasees. (13) The waivers, releases, and promises of indemnification undertaken by Applicant in this Agreement EXTEND EVEN TO: CLAIMS ASSERTING NEGLIGENCE PER SE, CONDUCT THAT IS INTENTIONAL OR RECKLESS, CLAIMS OF FRAUD, CLAIMS INVOLVING DEATH, ACTIVITY THAT WOULD OVERLAP WITH ALLEGATIONS OF CRIMINALITY, AND/OR CLAIMS SEEKING EXEMPLARY DAMAGES. They apply without regard to the basis of the claim (e.g., based on tort, breach of contract, common law, implied or express warranty, or otherwise). Applicant's promised indemnification of Releasees also extends to claims third parties assert against Releasees said to be based on Applicant's conduct. (14) INFECTIOUS DISEASE—Applicant's promises and assumption of risks in this Agreement also extend to the risk and any asserted harm Applicant and the dog(s) may suffer from actual or threatened exposure to infectious disease, whether COVID-19 or otherwise, and Applicant accepts full responsibility for taking such measures as may be required or prudent to protect Applicant and well as other participants in the events. Applicant represents being aware of related recommend health practices, e.g., masking and distancing. (15) Applicant assigns to ASCA® the sole right to pursue any claim in connection with or arising in relation to the scheduled events that Applicant or those acting for Applicant otherwise might assert against any person or entity affiliated with ASCA®. (16) There are no provisions to this Agreement other than as spelled out here and they may not be modified except by formal ASCA® board action. This Agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum protection from liability allowable under the law.
