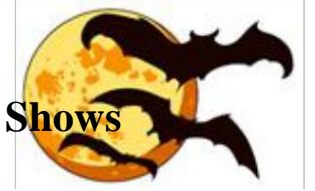

Saturday: Day of Show entries taken 9:00-9:30 am. Show begins at 10:00 with non-regular puppies. Sunday: Day of Entries taken 8:30-9:00 am. Show begins at 9:30.

PM: Shows will begin ½ hour after completion of AM show, not before 12:00 pm. Day of show entries will be taken for 10 minutes after AM BOB.

From the West: Traveling eastbound on the CA-91 Fwy, pass Weir Canyon Road. Take Exit 41 for Gypsum Canyon Road. Turn left at the bottom of the off-ramp. Pass under freeway and turn left at the signal. This will lead you right into our entrance.

From the East: Traveling westbound on the CA-91 Fwy toward Beach Cities, pass Green River Road. Take Exit 41A for Gypsum Canyon Road. At the bottom of the off-ramp continue straight through the signal into our entrance

All entries must be on a current ASCA entry form. Juniors must use a separate entry.
All entries must be completed (with agreement signed on back) or they will be refused.
Dogs 6 months & over must have ASCA Registration number on entry form.

No entry shall be accepted or refunded from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Events will be held under current rules and regulations of ASCA

Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the show committee, ASCA, the show veterinarian or the judge. Entry fees will not be refund if the show must be canceled or not completed due to acts of nature or emergency situations, including riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of Lakeside ASC .

Lakeside ASC, their Boards of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.

COVID-19 INFORMATION

Masks will be required in accordance with state, county, and/or city ordinance, whichever is strictest. Exhibitors will be required to wear masks while in the ring if required by the conformation judge. Masks must be worn when social distancing of 6 feet cannot be maintained on the show grounds. Masks must be worn with face shields.

No masks will be provided to exhibitors or spectators. You must bring your own mask. Exhibitors will be required to read and sign a waiver in order to pick up arm band numbers or enter the ring. A wristband will be given to each person signing the waiver. **NO EXHIBITORS** will be allowed in the ring without a wristband.

Everyone in attendance will be expected to maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet both in and out of the show ring. Individual set ups must be spaced at least of 6 feet apart.

Spectators or individuals not directly involved in the showing of dogs each day must be kept to a minimum and should remain with their cohort.

All entries forms must be completed prior to coming to the entry table. Lakeside ASC will provide extra entry forms at a table located away from the entry secretary, but will not provide any pens. Please ensure you bring pen if entries need to be completed at the show.

All exhibitors and spectators are expected to act in a responsible manner with regard to social distancing, sanitizing of hands, and wearing appropriate face covering as outlined above. While hand sanitizer will be provided by Lakeside ASC for judges, stewards, and volunteers, all exhibitors and spectators should bring their own hand sanitizer in the event extra is not available.

Lakeside ASC reserves the right to request anyone behaving in a reckless or inconsiderate manner with respect to COVID-19 protocols to leave the grounds. If this becomes necessary, no refund of entries will be made.
