Directions to Louis Pearce Pavilion:

From Austin-- Hwy 21 to Bryan. As you're coming into Bryan, turn RIGHT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station, and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

From Houston-- Hwy 290 west to Hempstead. Turn RIGHT onto Hwy 6 North. Take the "Business 6" exit (Business 6 becomes Texas Ave.) in College Station. Turn LEFT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway-- Walmart will be on the left). Go a couple miles on 2818, and turn RIGHT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

From Dallas/Ft. Worth-- I-35 South to Waco. From Waco, take Hwy 6 south all the way to Bryan. Take the "FM 2818—Bryan Business Park--George Bush Library" exit, and turn RIGHT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station, and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

Conformation Information:

- **Junior Showmanship**-- (non-regular) **Peewee** (3 years, to under 6 yrs) **Sub-Junior** (6 years, to under 8 yrs); (regular) **Novice Junior** (8-12 yrs), **Open Junior** (8-12 yrs), **Novice Senior** (13-17 yrs), **Open Senior** (13-17 yrs). Non-regular Peewees and Sub-Juniors will each receive a participant ribbon and a prize, and are not given class placements. An adult must accompany peewees in the ring.
- **Puppies**-- (non-regular) 2-4 and 4-6 puppy classes, divided by sex. First place winners to compete for Best of Breed Puppy and Best Opposite Sex Puppy.
- **Veterans**—(non-regular) 7 to under 10 yrs, and 10+ yrs, divided by sex. Winners of each class to compete for Best Veteran.
- **Altered & Intact**—(regular) 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, American Bred, Bred By, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed.
- Exhibitors should be ringside for all classes, ready to be called in. It is the judge's discretion whether to delay a class, or to allow an exhibitor to enter the ring late.

- Rosettes are given for Best Junior, Reserve Junior, Best of Breed Puppy, Best Opposite Sex Puppy, Best Veteran, Altered/Intact Winners Dog/Bitch, Altered/Intact Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch; Altered/Intact Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best of Winners.

General Information:

- **PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS**, at the show site AND hotels. **DOGS ARE NOT TO BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT AND NO BATHING/GROOMING DOGS AT HOTELS!**
- This is an indoor, climate controlled facility. Ring will be on dirt; crating/grooming is on concrete and/or dirt. **NO FORCED AIR OR HAIR DRYERS ALLOWED INSIDE THE PAVILION!**
- **Access to the building will be after 5:00 on Friday, Feb. 12.** Driving in will be permitted on Sunday after the show is over. Otherwise, be sure to bring your dolly or cart for unloading/loading through the regular doors. PLEASE do not prop any of the doors open for very long. **Clean your setup area after you pack up to leave-- brooms are available.**
- **DOG/PUPPY SALES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Any person found to be selling dogs on the premises will be asked to leave and not return.
- Puppies under the age of 2 months are prohibited from the show grounds, unless present for the eye clinic ONLY. Puppies/dogs over the age of 16 wks are required to have proof of rabies vaccination. Tags do not constitute such proof.
- Eastex ASC, ASCA, and Texas A & M University assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children. Children are to be supervised at all times.
- **Any handler, owner, or spectator being abusive towards a dog, exhibiting poor sportsmanship, refusing to wear a mask covering nose and mouth at all times inside the facility, and/or not picking up their dog's poop, will be asked to leave the show site for the duration of the show weekend.**
- **Entries open December 31, 2020 and must be on NEWEST official ASCA entry forms only.** Copies may be made if signed statement is on the back. No other forms accepted. All entries must be signed on the back. **Any entry form that is not properly completed does not constitute a valid entry, and armband numbers will NOT be issued until the entry form is complete and correct.** Entry forms can be filled in online (has "text entry") at <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/conentyform.pdf>, then printed out. Entries can be paid via Paypal, with Monday, February 8, as the deadline for pre-entry discounts. Email entries and waiver to callistoaussies@hotmail.com and send entry fees to Paypal account eastexasc1@gmail.com. **IF USING PAYPAL, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE 2.9% + \$30 TRANSACTION FEE ADDED TO YOUR TOTAL ENTRY FEES.**
- Entry fees will only be refunded prior to show closing. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Make checks payable to **Eastex ASC**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$30 service charge for returned checks.
- All dogs' ages will be calculated as of day of show. Be prepared to present papers on all dogs six months of age or older. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

COVID-19 Information

Below are the rules that must be followed by all exhibitors. Let's work together to make this a great event for everyone.

● **General Practices**

- Clubs, officials and participants and anyone attending the show are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Be respectful. Not all of our participants have the same level of comfort being out and about at this time. Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Ring side chairs must be spaced out 6' apart unless you are attending with other individuals.
- Should you choose to disrupt the show in any way you will be asked to leave. Again, please be respectful of others.
- The waiver below must be signed by all individuals attending. This is in addition to the ASCA waiver that is on the entry form. Parents must sign for minors. If a waiver is not signed, you will be asked to leave the grounds immediately. Please include waiver with the pre-entries.
- All those who are not actively participating in showing, prepping, or grooming need to stay home. We highly recommend that young children or elderly do not attend.
- **Masks are Mandatory per the current State of Texas, Brazos County, the cities of Bryan and College Station ordinances and Texas A&M University.** We will expect all people to be wearing a mask at all times when you are inside the Pavilion. Please follow this and make it safe for everyone.
- Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils etc. – Please bring your own.
- All set ups must be at least 6' apart. People can set up on the dirt as well-- bring your mats!
- No forced air or hair dryers will be allowed inside the pavilion.
- Pre-entries are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to reduce the face to face contact the secretary has with exhibitors. There will be a separate table with entry forms and waivers for DOS entries that must be filled out before approaching the secretary. Please remain 6' away unless asked to step forward.
- The Ring will have two gates, an entrance & exit. Each will be marked. Ribbons will be placed on a table and it is the exhibitor's responsibility to pick up the correct ribbon as you exit the ring. We will have a return area for ribbons, but these ribbons will not be reused at this event.
- Know the armband numbers and classes entered for your entries before going to the ring. Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate. While showing your dog maintain social distance from other exhibitors. Be prepared to show your dog's bite. Please give the judge plenty of personal space as you exhibit your dog.
