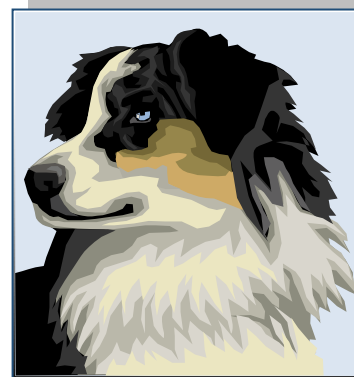

"Day of Trial" entries will be accepted if Run Limit(s) have not been exceeded.

SPECIAL RATES FOR DOGS ENTERED IN ALL 4 ARENA TRIALS/ALL CLASSES OF STOCK - PRE-ENTRY FEE: ALL FOUR TRIALS ARE: \$500/PER DOG (\$100 SAVINGS.) OTHERWISE, INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES ARE AS FOLLOWS: SHEEP \$50 PER TRIAL; CATTLE \$60 PER TRIAL; DUCKS \$40 PER TRIAL.

SPECIAL RATES FOR DOGS ENTERED IN ALL 4 ARENA TRIALS/ALL CLASSES OF STOCK – POST-ENTRY FEE: ALL FOUR TRIALS ARE: \$540/PER DOG (\$200 SAVINGS.) OTHERWISE, INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES ARE AS FOLLOWS: SHEEP \$60 PER TRIAL; CATTLE \$70 PER TRIAL; DUCKS \$50 PER TRIAL.

HANDLER'S MEETING will be conducted at **7:45 a.m.** for all levels/all stock.

TRIAL BEGINS immediately following Handler's meeting in sheep/cattle arena; ~15 minutes later in duck arena. **Cattle will be run back-to-back first – concurrent with Ducks. #2 Duck Trial may run first; followed by #1 Duck Trial – or as announced by Course Director(s). Event(s) may or may not have a set lunch break for exhibitors; please plan accordingly.**

ENTRIES & FEES: No telephone, facsimile, email or incomplete entries will be accepted. All entries must be on ASCA entry forms with proper fees included. • The entry limit per Judge will be accepted in postmark order. If a class of stock is full, the dog will be put on a waiting list.

• Selling runs is not permitted unless the trial is full. If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run, the transaction must be handled by the **Trial Secretary**. All offers to buy or sell runs must be submitted to the trial secretary at least one-half hour before the trial starts. • Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. There is a \$75 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of cash, Money Order or Cashiers' Check.

Stockdog Trial Awards

1st place awards to all classes. 1st - 4th place ribbons in all classes. Qualifying score ribbons to all qualifiers in Regular classes. The following special awards and rosettes will also be given:

Rosettes for **High-In-Trial Aussie, High-In-Trial Other Breed, High-In-Trial Junior – Each Day** (Sat & Sun). Overall **High Combined (HC) Aussie** Trophy Buckle for Sat/Sun Trials (consisting of 4 trials); Overall **High Combined (HC) Other Breed** Trophy Buckle for Sat/Sun Trials (consisting of 4 trials); **Most Promising Young Aussie** Trophy Buckle for Sat/Sun Trials (as determined by the judge/s). In order to qualify for the weekend awards, dogs must be entered in all 4 trials. **Requirements:** All scores obtained from any Regular (Advanced, Open, or Started) level or combination of levels will count towards the Weekend High Combined scores. The Aussie and Other Breed with the highest total weekend score will be awarded the "Weekend High Combined Aussie/Other Breed" awards. Awards & Scoresheets for Saturday will be presented after the conclusion of the second trial and re-setting of the arena. Awards & Scoresheets for Sunday will be presented after the conclusion of the second trial that day.

Notice to Exhibitors

- Entry forms can be downloaded at <http://www.asca.org/Portals/0/stockentwfill.pdf>. NOTE: Only the newest version of the Stockdog Entry Form will be accepted.
- In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum "Service" membership is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA qualifying scores earned when applying for a Tracking Number. A Tracking Number Application can be downloaded at <http://asca.org/Portals/0/trackapp.pdf>.
- Use **only ASCA entry forms** that require exhibitor's or parent/legal guardian's signature on the back.
- **Correct amount must accompany entry form.** Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. There is a \$75 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of cash, Money Order, or Cashier's Check.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial(s) cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of a public enemy, strikes, COVID outbreak, or other causes beyond the control of HPASC. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. Exhibitors must be in good standing with ASCA and/or HPASC.
- **Run order** will be determined by random drawing by members of the HPASC Trial Committee prior to the trial. Gate entries ("Day-of-Trial" entries) will run last in class entered.
- Additional entries will be made from a waiting list established in order of receipt. Additions will be made prior to the start of the trial and are at the discretion of High Plains ASC. Fees will be refunded to the original entrant before close of entries only if a replacement dog is entered in place of the absent dog.
- Dogs entered in the Novice Handler Division **may not** compete in any other division on the same class of livestock on the same day. Dogs entered in the Junior Handler Division may compete in any other division on the same class of livestock on the same day. Scores from the Junior Handler and Novice Handler Division are not eligible toward certification or special awards (i.e., Started/Open/ Advanced, Sheep/Cattle/Ducks, Weekend High Combined, etc.).
- **Should the entered dog injure stock**, owner of the dog will pay for veterinarian services or will pay the market value of the stock (at the stock owner's option) see ASCA's Agreement on the back of the entry form). Market value of the stock has been determined to be \$1,200 for cattle, \$250 for sheep, and \$75 for fowl. (U.S. Dollars)
- **Other Breeds** - All herding breeds and mixes thereof listed as eligible to compete in ASCA Stockdog Trials. Non-ASCA registered Aussies are considered "other breed." See Appendix 1, ASCA **Stockdog Rules and Regulations**.
- Training devices (mechanical and/or electrical) will not be permitted on trial grounds.
- **Bitches in season** are permitted and will run in draw order.
- **Tied scores within the same class will be broken by time.**
- Each owner/handler is responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be confined or on lead at all times, except when competing. Dogs are not allowed to run loose on the trial site.
- This trial will follow all rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. For a copy of ASCA's rules, go to <http://www.asca.org/Portals/0/StockdogRules.pdf>.

HPASC reserves the right to substitute a judge and/or provide an overflow judge, if deemed necessary. Questions or conflicts during the event should immediately be brought to the attention of the Course Director.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Owners/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing. • Children must be under direct adult supervision at all times.

• High Plains ASC (HPASC), its officers and members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. Trialing is inherently dangerous; ground/footing is uneven. Knowing this, you assume full liability for yourself, dog, and stock if any damage is caused by you or your dog to stock or others. **By attending this event on private property, you agree to clean-up after your dogs AT ALL TIMES and remove any/all trash items upon departure.**

Livestock: Crossbred hair sheep 3-5 head (value \$250 each). Beef Cattle (~700#) - 3 head (value \$1,200 each). Indian Runner/Cross Ducks - 5 head (value \$75 each). (U.S. Dollars)

Directions to Trial Location: Cappy Pruett Ranch - 36600 E. 144th Ave - Hudson, CO 80642. Take I-76 to Exit 22 Bromley Lane - head east. Follow Bromley/152 Avenue for 8.7 miles...follow the road to the right (Imboden Rd) for 1.1 miles...road again turns to the right (144 Ave) for 1.3 miles...Cappy Pruett Stockdog Training sign on the right.

Trial Location will be available from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm each day, or one hour after conclusion of event. No un-entered dogs (except set-out and/or pen dogs) will be allowed at the trial site, unless permission has been granted by site owner(s).

IMPORTANT NOTICE: May in Colorado can offer **any kind of weather...be prepared!** **Bring your own canopies; chairs; extra water/meals.** Cool off tubs will be provided for dogs. **No RV's, Campers, Trailers, or Tents may camp overnight at the trial site without registration fee and/or permission from site owner. Food and beverage will NOT be available on site - unless ordered ahead of time using the lunch order form (later in this document.)** There are fast food restaurants within 15 miles of the site. Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.

WE NEED YOUR HELP! Stockdog trials are inherently labor-intensive and require untold hours of work – months before the event; all during the event; and even after. **Please consider helping by re-setting the arena(s) at the end of Saturday's trial day to make ready for the next day.** Awards/scoresheets will be given out after the arenas are set and ready for the next day.

HEALTH – PLEASE TAKE NOTE re: COVID-19: HPASC members, guests, entrants, and workers are expected to abide by the rules & regulations in place for COVID-19 in the State of CO at the time of this trial.

If your state is on lockdown at the time the trial is held and you cannot attend due to that lockdown, you have contracted COVID within 2 weeks of this trial, or you've come in contact with COVID-19 two weeks before this trial, your money will be refunded. We do request you provide proof and tell us as timely as possible so we can get your run(s) to someone else.

RESTRICTIONS include mandatory social distancing between set up areas and wearing a mask outside of the trial arena when walking around the trial site or being situated within 6' of others (MASKS ON at the registration desk and during awards ceremonies.) Signs will be posted to instruct you what will be required to do under Colorado law at the host facility during the trial days. One warning will be given; failure to abide after one warning will result in you being asked to leave and forfeiting all entry fees. You are responsible for knowing and abiding by the Colorado laws regarding COVID-19 at hotels, motels, restaurants, grocery stores, RV sites, etc.
