### Directions to Louis Pearce Pavilion:

**From Austin/San Antonio--** Hwy 21 to Bryan, As you're coming into Bryan, turn RIGHT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Pkwy). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

**From Houston--** Hwy 290 to Hempstead. Turn RIGHT onto Hwy 6 North. Take the "Business 6" exit (Business 6 becomes Texas Ave) in College Station. Turn LEFT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Pkwy-- Walmart will be on the left). Go a couple of miles on 2818, and turn RIGHT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

**From Dallas/Ft. Worth--** South on I-35 to Waco. From Waco, take Hwy 6 south all the way to Bryan. As you're nearing Bryan, take the "FM 2818-- Bryan Business Park-- George Bush Library" exit, and turn RIGHT onto 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Pkwy). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

### Conformation Information:

- Junior Showmanship-- ALL PEEWEES ARE TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT IN THE RING (non-regular)** Peewee (at least 3 years, to under 6 yrs) Sub-Junior (6 years, to under 8 yrs); (regular) Novice Junior (8-12 yrs), Open Junior (8-12 yrs), Novice Senior (13-17 yrs), Open Senior (13-17 yrs). Non-regular Peeweeps and Sub-Juniors will each receive a participant ribbon and a prize of their choosing, and are not given class placements.
- Puppies-- (non-regular)** 2-4 and 4-6 puppy classes, divided by sex. First place winners to compete for Best of Breed Puppy and Best Opposite Sex Puppy.
- Veterans--(non-regular)** 7 to under 10 yrs, and 10+ yrs, divided by sex. Winners of each class to compete for Best Veteran.
- Altered & Intact--(regular)** 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, American Bred, Bred By, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed.

- Exhibitors should be ringside for all classes, ready to be called in. It is the judge's discretion whether to delay a class, or to allow an exhibitor to enter the ring late.
- Rosettes and prizes are given for Best Junior, Reserve Junior, Best of Breed Puppy, Best Opposite Sex Puppy, Best Veteran, Altered and Intact Winners Dog/Bitch, Altered and Intact Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch; Altered and Intact Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best of Winners.

### **General Information:**

- PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS**, at the show site AND hotels. **NO BATHING/GROOMING DOGS AT HOTELS!**
- This is an indoor, climate controlled facility. Ring will be on dirt; crating/grooming is on concrete or dirt. Forced air dryers and hair dryers are not to be used inside the pavilion.
- Access to the building will be after 6:00 PM on Friday, June 4.** The large doors will **NOT** be opened for unloading, so be sure to bring your dolly or cart for unloading through the regular doors. **If you prop doors open for unloading, PLEASE close them ASAP when done.**
- There are plenty of electrical outlets. Please use power strips/surge protectors to help avoid tripping the breakers if you run extension cords to outside for using dryers. Fans and dryers are not permitted inside the pavilion.
- DOG/PUPPY SALES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Any person found to be selling dogs on the premises will be asked to leave and not return.
- Puppies under the age of 2 months are prohibited from the show grounds, INCLUDING the RV parking areas.
- Puppies/dogs over the age of 16 wks are required to have proof of rabies vaccination. Tags do not constitute such proof.
- Eastex ASC, ASCA, and Texas A & M University assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children. Children are to be supervised at all times.
- Any handler, owner, or spectator being abusive towards a dog, not picking up their dogs' poop, and/or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the show site for the duration of the show weekend.
- DO NOT LEAVE DOGS OVERNIGHT IN THE PAVILION.**
- Please clean up and sweep your grooming setup areas before leaving. Push brooms are available.
- Entries on NEWEST official ASCA entry forms only. Copies may be made if signed statement is on the back. No other forms accepted. All entries must be signed on the back. Any entry form that is not properly completed does not constitute a valid entry, and armband numbers will NOT be issued until the entry form is complete and correct!!!** Conformation entry forms can be filled in online (has "text entry") at <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/conentryform.pdf> then printed out, SIGNED on the back, and mailed in. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ON THE NEWEST FORM THAT HAS THE COVID-19 WAIVER!!**
- Entry fees will only be refunded prior to the show closing, which is the day-of-show registration period. No entry will be accepted for a dog or from a handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Make checks payable to **Eastex ASC**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$30 service charge for returned checks.

- All dogs' ages will be calculated by their age on each day of show. Be prepared to present papers on all dogs six months of age or older. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

# COVID-19 Information

Below are the rules that must be followed by all exhibitors. Let's work together to make this a great event for everyone.

## **General Practices**

1. Clubs, officials and participants and anyone attending the show are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held. Also, judges have been hired under the mask mandate and unmasked exhibitors will not be allowed in the ring or ringside.
2. Be respectful. Not all of our participants have the same level of comfort being out and about at this time. Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Ring side chairs must be spaced out 6' apart unless you are attending with other individuals.
3. Should you choose to disrupt the show in any way you will be asked to leave. Again, please be respectful of others.
4. The waiver below must be signed by all individuals attending. This is in addition to the ASCA waiver that is on the entry form. Parents must sign for minors. If a waiver is not signed, you will be asked to leave the grounds immediately. Please include waiver with the pre-entries.
5. **Masks are no longer mandated by the Stated of Texas, but continue to be required by Texas A&M University at the time of this premium.** We will expect all people to be wearing a mask covering mouth and nose at all times when you are inside the Pavilion. Please follow this and make it safe for everyone.
6. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils etc. – Please bring your own.
7. All set ups must be at least 6' apart. People can set up on the dirt as well-- bring your mats!
8. No forced air dryers allowed inside the pavilion.
9. Pre-entries are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to reduce the face to face contact the secretary has with exhibitors. There will be a separate table with entry forms and waivers for DOS entries that must be filled out before approaching the secretary. Please remain 6' away unless asked to step forward.
10. The Ring will have two gates, an entrance & exit. Each will be marked. Ribbons will be placed on a table and it is the exhibitor's responsibility to pick up the correct ribbon as you exit the ring. We will have a return area for ribbons, but these ribbons will not be reused at this event.
11. Know the armband numbers and classes entered for your entries before going to the ring. Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate. While showing your dog maintain social distance from other exhibitors. Be prepared to show your dog's bite. Please give the judge plenty of personal space as you exhibit your dog.

## **Waiver of Liability and Informed Consent COVID-19 Waiver**
