Through submission of entry, the competitor acknowledges that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and TWANG/ASCOT trial policies, including, but not limited to the following:

All healthy, trained dogs, purebred or otherwise, at least eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA Agility Trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry. Requests for refunds after closing are at the discretion of the club. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, will be excused from the Agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in control will be excused from the Agility trial. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial, a report will be sent to ASCA and may be banned from further TWANG/ASCOT events. No entry will be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from all of the ASCA programs nor anyone not in good standing with ASCA.

**Dogs entering the jump height classes 20" or less (with height less than or equal to 20") that do not have a permanent ASCA, AKC or NADAC height card must be measured. Dogs entering 20+" or 24" jump heights are exempt. Please include a copy of your card with your entry.**

No leads, collars, food, toys, etc will be allowed on the course. All dogs must be on lead or securely crated when not in the ring.

Entries must be made on the enclosed entry form. Copies may be made. Entries must be signed, complete, and paid in full to be accepted. Make all checks and money orders payable to TWANG (Texas Working Agility Novice Group). Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and there will be a \$25.00 service fee on all returned checks. Entry into future trials and participation in this trial will not be allowed until all fees are paid in cash or money order. Illegible or incomplete entry forms do not constitute a valid entry.

Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks are not permitted on the trial grounds.

TWANG/ASCOT, its board of directors, ASCA, management, and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, owners or to any of their dogs, personal property, or children.

### Food

There will be snacks and drinks available at the facility. **The only outside food/beverage permitted in the facility will be bottled water.**

### Directions

The facility is near the northwest corner of the intersection of I-30 and Loop 820, on the west side of Fort Worth. Mapquest directions say to take Exit 4 off of Loop 820 toward White Settlement Road, turn left, then left again onto Jim Wright Fwy S, take a right on Expedition, then the first left onto Settlement Plaza Drive. We suggest you check with a navigation system to get clear directions to the site.

### Important Information

**Catalogs/Run Orders** - No catalogs will be printed. Running order lists will be posted at the ring gate. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as the class allows. You are responsible for being present when it is your turn to run. We will not hold the ring for absent handlers.

**Move-Ups** - All move-up requests must be received by the trial secretary by August 10, 2021. There will be NO move-ups offered on the weekend of the trial.

**Awards** - TWANG will award strip ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place as well as for all qualifying runs.

**FEO (For Exhibition Only)** – We will accept FEO entries. Dogs must be at least 15 mos old. Any dog less than 18 mos must jump 4” lower than their regular jump height. They are not eligible for any prizes or awards. This is a non-qualifying class.

**Agility Obstacles** - The following obstacles may be used at this agility trial:  
Dog Walk – Slatted rubber, A-Frame – Slatted rubber, Weave Poles 24” centers, Slat less rubber Teeter, Tire Jump (displaceable), Open Tunnel, Non-Winged single hurdle(s), Winged single hurdle(s), Double bar hurdle. 4- & 8-inch dogs will have a 5’ A-frame, all others will have 5’6”.

### Entries

Entries must be postmarked by August 6, 2021 to qualify for pre-entry fees, which are as follows:

1 – 9 runs: \$15 each  
10 – 19 runs: \$13 each  
20 or more runs: \$11 each

### ACE Program

ASCA is offering an ACE Agility Program that permits any dog to jump 4” lower than their standard jump height and dogs 10 years or old to jump 8” lower than their standard jump height. For details, please refer to Chapter 4 of the most recent rulebook available at <http://www.asca.org>.

**COVID-19 Information**

1. All attendees will be required to sign a COVID-19 Waiver. Please sign and include the waiver with your entry form. This applies not only to participants but to anyone planning to attend the event with the participant (including minors). If more people attend the event with you than were listed on the waiver you sent with your entry, bring them to see the Trial Secretary so that the additional attendees can sign the Waiver as well.
2. Non-participants and the young, elderly, and anyone at risk are encouraged to remain at home.
3. Clubs, show officials, participants and anyone attending the show are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
4. Do not attend if you are sick or have been in the last 14 days.
5. Do not attend if you have been near anyone with symptoms.
6. Social distancing is recommended in crating areas, seating, restrooms, and anywhere else lines could be formed (Check-in, Course Map Postings, Results Postings, concession stand, etc.).
7. If you don't want volunteers to touch your leash, you may carry it in your pocket during your run as long as it's entirely concealed. If your leash falls off or the dog grabs your leash during your run it will be considered a toy in the ring and scored as an elimination. ASCA, TWANG, and ASCOT assumes no liability if the handler chooses to pocket their leash and it catches on obstacles and/or causes the handler to trip.
8. Participants are encouraged to use hand sanitizer.
9. Show officials and participants may be wearing face masks if government/facility regulations require it or if they choose to do so. You are strongly encouraged to accustom your dog to seeing people wearing facemasks prior to entering the trial.
10. Additional guidelines may be specified in your confirmation letter or at the event.
11. Please contact the Trial Secretary or Chairperson if you have any additional questions.

**AGREEMENT**

**IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—**(1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s) and handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents; as well as ASCA®'s affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees, judges, contractors, insurers, and agents; (3) Applicant enters into this Agreement in consideration for being allowed to submit an entry form and, if approved, to take part in related activities of ASCA® and/or its affiliates. (4) Applicant acknowledges entering into this Agreement voluntarily, after the opportunity to obtain independent legal review of it and to have questions about its likely meaning answered through such review. (5) Applicant accepts the terms of this Agreement not only on his/her own behalf but also for his/her successors, assigns, beneficiaries, heirs, parents/guardians, and anyone else who might raise a claim on his/her behalf or as a result of her suffering harm. (6) To the extent any provision or application of this Agreement turns out to be unenforceable, the rest of it still remains fully effective. (7) This Agreement is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice-of-law rules, and—to the extent permitted by law—any legal action by Applicant that names Releasees as one or more defendants shall be filed and heard solely in the state or federal courts serving the county of ASCA®'s headquarters: Brazos County, Texas. (8) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event. (9) Applicant represents that the dog(s) being entered is/are not known to pose a hazard to persons, other dogs, or property and that all required rabies and other vaccinations under the state and local law of the dog's state of residence are current. (10) Applicant acknowledges awareness of and assumes the risk associated with his/her participation and that of his/her dog(s) in this event and related activities, among which are personal injury to Applicant and those affiliated with Applicant, injury to Applicant's dog(s), and damage to Applicant's property. As but a few examples, Applicant and/or his/her dog(s) may be injured from the condition of (or failure to warn of the condition of) floors, stairways, lighting, security measures or a lack of them, electrical devices, fittings, show rings, parking areas, motor vehicles, and unfamiliar animals and people. (11) Applicant releases Releasees from any claim or liability whatsoever arising from any injury, harm, liability, or demand in anyway said to occur during or in connection with related events, also waiving any right to assert such claims that he/she otherwise might have in the absence of this Agreement. (12) Applicant also agrees to indemnify Releasees from any claim that Applicant or those acting on Applicant's behalf, for Applicant's benefit, or in Applicant's place, might assert against Releasees. The obligation in this regard extends even to Applicant's paying settlements, judgments, and expenses and costs of legal defense incurred by Releasees. (13) The waivers, releases, and promises of indemnification undertaken by Applicant in this Agreement EXTEND EVEN TO: CLAIMS ASSERTING NEGLIGENCE PER SE, CONDUCT THAT IS INTENTIONAL OR RECKLESS, CLAIMS OF FRAUD, CLAIMS INVOLVING DEATH, ACTIVITY THAT WOULD OVERLAP WITH ALLEGATIONS OF CRIMINALITY, AND/OR CLAIMS SEEKING EXEMPLARY DAMAGES. They apply without regard to the basis of the claim (e.g., based on tort, breach of contract, common law, implied or express warranty, or otherwise). Applicant's promised indemnification of Releasees also extends to claims third parties assert against Releasees said to be based on Applicant's conduct. (14) INFECTIOUS DISEASE—Applicant's promises and assumption of risks in this Agreement also extend to the risk and any asserted harm Applicant and the dog(s) may suffer from actual or threatened exposure to infectious disease, whether COVID-19 or otherwise, and Applicant accepts full responsibility for taking such measures as may be required or prudent to protect Applicant and well as other participants in the events. Applicant represents being aware of related recommend health practices, e.g., masking and distancing. (15) Applicant assigns to ASCA® the sole right to pursue any claim in connection with or arising in relation to the scheduled events that Applicant or those acting for Applicant otherwise might assert against any person or entity affiliated with ASCA®. (16) There are no provisions to this Agreement other than as spelled out here and they may not be modified except by formal ASCA® board action. This Agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum protection from liability allowable under the law.
