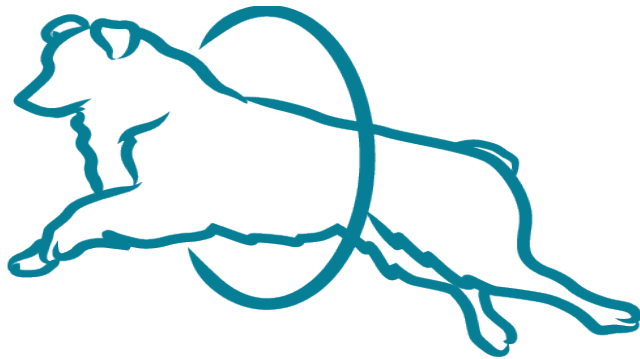

ASCA agility - fast, flowing, and fun!

Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) agility offers 3 classes:

- **Regular:** Obstacles may include jumps, tire, tunnels, teeter, A-frame, dog walk, and weave poles (6 for novice; 12 for open and elite). There is no table. Complete the numbered course accurately and within time.
- **Gamblers:** Accumulate points for 30 seconds by completing the above obstacles in a course of your choosing; when the buzzer sounds, complete a numbered gamble of 4-5 obstacles from a distance.
- **Jumpers:** Complete a numbered course of jumps and tunnels accurately and within time. There are no weave poles in jumpers.

Any dog can enter ASCA agility: ASCA agility is open to all breeds and mixes 18 months or older. Dogs 15 months or older can enter FEO (for exhibition only) and jump a lower height. No points for titles in this division. You don't have to register with ASCA. But if you apply for a QT number, ASCA will keep track of your qualifying scores and titles.

You can start at any level: Qualifying scores will first be applied to titles for lower classes skipped. If you qualify at a higher level, you cannot go back to a lower level in that class. ***All dogs may enter elite classes***

Training in the ring is allowed: You will be eliminated but have standard course time to repeat contacts, etc. **No treats or toys allowed** in the ring.

Refusals are not faulted: If your dog misses the obstacle or balks, you can try again and might still qualify.

ASCA programs of competition: Championship and ACE

- **Championship** – ASCA's traditional competing class.
 - **Veteran** dogs ≥7 years old jump 4" lower
 - **Junior** Handlers ≤17 years old may jump their dogs 4" lower
- **ACE** – ASCA's lower height class. Dogs jump 4" lower
 - **ACE Senior** dogs ≥10 years old jump 8" lower

See page 2 for a chart of what heights dogs will jump for these classes.

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA

You could get a title!

- For Jumpers and Gamblers titles, you need 20 points (2 clean runs).
- For a Regular title, you need 30 points (3 clean runs).

Notice to exhibitors

- This trial is open to all dogs being at least eighteen (18) months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's mental or physical performance or dogs exhibiting any signs of aggression toward people or other dogs.
- Dogs are not required to have an ASCA registration, LEP, or QT number to enter this trial. Handlers do not need to be ASCA members. However, if you wish ASCA to record your qualifying scores and send you ASCA titling certificates, you must register your dog and become a service member of ASCA at the time of registration. You can get the form from the ASCA website (<https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/trackapp.pdf>) or at the trial.
- Club management will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the site. In such case, no entry fees will be refunded.
- No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility program, a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs, or a member not in good standing with ASCA. The business office gives us a list of these dogs and handlers with the sanctioning paperwork.
- Dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs and themselves.
- We will not refund entries if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire, public emergency, act of God or act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. We will not refund entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for the dismissal.
- We may refund entry fees for injured dogs or bitches that come in season, if notification in writing or by email is received before the trial begins. A note from a veterinarian may be requested.
- We will refund entries in the event of handler communicable disease illness if notification received before trial begins.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be charged a \$30.00 fee

- **No food, toys, other aids or devices allowed on the course or within 10 feet of the ring at any time. Dogs must run naked – no collars allowed.**
- Any dog showing aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the trial. Any dog, which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles safely, will be excused from the trial.

- **Leashes:** During the Covid-19 timeframe, exhibitors may choose to wear or pocket the leash, so long as it is attached tightly or completely inside the pocket. If the leash falls out or the dog grabs for the leash to play, it will be considered a toy and the run will be eliminated. ASCA assumes no responsibility if the handler chooses to wear or pocket their leash and it catches on obstacles and/or causes the handler to trip.

Awards and Prizes

- Self-serve green qualifying ribbons for each qualifying score
- Self-serve flat placement ribbons for 1st-4th place (each class & jump height)
- Rosette, pole, and memento for each team completing an ATCH title
Please let us know before you run so we can be prepared to celebrate!
- Rosettes and prizes awarded Saturday and Sunday for:
 - HIT Novice, Open & Elite (Championship Program)
 - HIT Overall for ACE, Veteran Dog, & Junior Handler

HIT based on qualifying scores in Gamblers, Regular, and Jumpers runs. A full Q earns 7/6/5 points in Elite/Open/Novice; Q-5's earn half the points. Ties will be determined by fastest YPS in regular qualifying runs and then highest number of gamble points in qualifying runs.

Measuring: If you are in any class **except** 20+/16+, you must either be measured at the trial or present a permanent ASCA, AKC, or NADAC jump height card to the trial secretary.

- Certain breeds – short and long ones, mostly – get an exemption and jump 4" lower than standard height

Check the rules to see if your dog qualifies for an exemption.

Entry & Fee information

Entries open July 5, 2021 and close August 23, 2021. We will email confirmations unless you request otherwise. We will accept day of entries if the trial does not fill.

Please double check your confirmation and contact the trial secretary with corrections to avoid delays on the morning of the trial. Please contact the trial secretary if you do not receive a confirmation email.

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/ handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as “Applicant”). (2) “Releasees” here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant’s dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/ requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant’s dog/Applicant’s property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant’s dog/Applicant’s property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant’s dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant’s promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.
