Entries will be accepted in postmark order. In the case of duplicate postmark entries, a random draw will be made of those entries to determine the order of acceptance. Run order will be drawn on July 16th. **Correct entry fee must accompany an official, signed, and FULLY completed ASCA entry to be considered a valid entry. YOU MUST USE THE CURRENT ASCA STOCK DOG ENTRY FORM TO BE A VALID ENTRY.** Forms are

Directions: From I-35 North: Take 35 North to Exit 165/County Road 70 (Rock Creek Exit). Head east (right) till you reach the 4 way stop. At the stop take 361 North (left). Follow 361N to County Road 117 /Liberty Road (1.3 mi). Head east (right) on 117/Liberty Road. Follow the road until it stops (2 mi). Head north (left) on County Road 4/Military Road/Government Road. This is a paved road. From County Road 4 head north until you reach Russell Road (.6 mi). Head east (right) on Russell Road. Elysian Farm will be the 3rd house on your right (.6 mi). Our driveway is not paved. Please use caution when driving or parking if it is wet out.

Sheep Farm Trial

8 Sheep Farm Runs

Note: A set-out dog may be used

North Woods ASC – Sheep Farm Trial Course Description

- Pen Work – 25 points

6 head of sheep will be put into pen B. Dog and handler must move sheep from Pen B, to Pen C, to Pen D, to Pen L. Gates must be closed in all pens so dog has to move stock individually through each pen. Dog and handler will take all head from Pen L and put into Arena A and settle by pan of grain outside Pen L.

- Gather work – 20 points

- Open handler may go halfway between Cone A and sheep. Dog must stay at Cone A until sent. Handler will send dog for outrun and bring sheep to Cone A. If handler moves closer than halfway to sheep when dog is sent judge will deduct points at their discretion.
- Advanced handler /dog will go to Cone A. Handler must stay at post and send dog for outrun and bring sheep to Cone A. If handler moves from Cone A after the dog is sent judge will deduct points at their discretion.

- Chute work – 20 points

Take stock thru Chute entering thru east end. Mark 3 head of sheep with marking paint and place ribbon around one sheep's neck (can be marked or unmarked sheep).

- Location specific task – Hold – 20 points (on map it is marked incorrectly- it will be across arena on opposite fence of chute)

Take stock to marked hold area. Stock must be in hold area and settled until judge calls “Hold.”

- Open handler may drive or fetch to Hold Area.
- Advanced handler must stay at chute until livestock crosses the plane of Cone A.
- Location specific task – Ribbon pull – 20 points
 - Open handler may use fence line to help hold sheep for ribbon pull.
 - Advanced handler may not use fence line to help hold sheep for ribbon pull. Must be done off the fence
- Sort work – 25 points

Take sheep to 12' Gate at Pen L. Put 3 marked head into Pen C. Put 3 unmarked head into Pen D. Put all 6 sheep back into Pen L. Dog and handler may use any combination of gates and pens to accomplish above.

Run completed when all 6 head are in Pen L and all gates are closed.

Notes:

- Time limit is 20 minutes, with a 3-minute warning. Open and Advanced Farm trial dogs must earn 70% or more of the total points (91/130) to qualify. Dogs must earn their open farm title before entering the advanced farm trial class.
 - Ties will be broken by: 1st) time; then by (2nd) Pen work part 2; and finally (3rd) Sort work, as needed.



Duck Farm Trial (See Duck Arena)

8 Duck Farm Runs

- Pen Work Part 1 (All Pen work is worth a total of 25 points/ Part 1 is worth 5 points) 10 head of ducks will be put into Pen A. Dog and handler will take ducks out of Pen A.

Time will start when handler opens the gate.

- Gather (20 points) Ducks will be left at outside of Pen A. Dog will be set at Cone A. Ducks will be gathered to Cone A. They do not have to go around cone in any direction.

Advanced: Handler must stay at Cone A when sending dog. Note: Control points will be deducted, if a handler leaves Cone A early.

Open: Handler may go up to half way between Cone A and ducks. Control points will be deducted, if handler goes closer when sending.

- Bridge (20 points)- Dog and handler will take ducks over bridge north to south. Ducks will be taken through Gate #1 into 50 x 75ft arena.

Advanced: Bridge will have one wing

Open: Bridge will have two wings

- Sort Work (25 points) - Dog and handler will gate sort the 3 of the 5 marked head into Pen C.
- Chute Work (20 points). The dog and handler will put all 10 head of ducks into the Chute.
- Pen Work (Part 2 worth 20 points). Dog and handler will put 3 head of ducks into Pen C. Put 3 head of ducks into Pen D. Put 4 head of ducks into Pen E. Put all head of ducks back together
- Hold (20 points) - The dog and handler will take ducks to the hold area. Judge will call "that's a hold" when all ducks are settled in area. After judge has called a hold ducks will be put back into Pen A.

Advanced: Handler must stay at Cone A until dog has driven stock half way to hold area. Note: Control points will be deducted if a handler leaves Cone A early.

Open: Handler and duck may drive or fetch ducks to hold area.

Run is complete when all 10 head of ducks are in Pen A all gates are closed.

Time Limit: 20 minutes. A 3-minute warning will be given at 17 minutes.

Ties will be broken by: 1st by sort, then (2nd) by Pen work part 2; and finally (3rd) gather, as needed.

Bitches in season will run in order. Run order will be drawn night before.
