2 – 4 mos.; 4 – 6 mos.; 6 – 9 mos.; 9 – 12 mos.; 12 – 15 mos.; 15 – 18 mos.; 18 – 20 mos.; divided by sex

Junior Showmanship:

Non-Regular: Pee-Wee 3 - 5; Sub Junior 6 - 7

Regular: 8-12 Novice; 8-12 Open; 13-17 Novice; 13-17 Open

Conformation:

Non-Regular: 2 – 4 mos.; 4 – 6 mos.; divided by sex.

Regular: Altered then Intact: 6 – 9 mos.; 9 – 12 mos.; 12 – 15 mos.; 15 – 18 mos.; Novice; American Bred; Bred By Exhibitor; Open Blue Merle; Open Red Merle; Open Black; Open Red; Best Of Breed.

Awards

For Sweeps Only –

50 % of monies from Veterans Sweeps will be retained by the Club,
the remaining 50% will be split 60% to BOBV, 40% to BOSV.

50 % of monies from Puppy Sweeps will be retained by the Club,
the remaining 50% will be split 60% to BOBP, 40% to BOSP.

There will be no monies awarded for class wins.

For Conformation Show Only –

Flat ribbons will be awarded to all class placements. Rosettes and awards will be given to BJH, RJH, BOBP, BOSP, WD, RWD, WB, RWB, BOB, BOW, and BOS for both Altered and Intact.

All dogs over 6 months of age must have permanent registration papers from A.S.C.A. available.

Show grounds are open from 7AM to 7PM daily.

Shows will be on the grass. Canopies are suggested. No power available. Generators are acceptable.

Grounds will be available for set-up Friday after 5PM. Please see more information on this in the ASC of WA flyer under Camping. Any set ups or marked spaces prior to this time will be removed.

There will be no food available onsite. Bring your own food, water and beverages!

Parking: we will be down on the infield for the race car track, please park appropriately. If you park before the rings are set up you might be asked to move.

OASA would appreciate if all handlers and owners would please pick up after your dogs.

Owner/handlers will be fined \$250.00 per day for not cleaning up set ups or picking up after their dogs.

ASCA requires:

All shows will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation Program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

No dogs will be sold on the show grounds.

OASA requires:

All dogs must be on a leash or confined to a crate or ex-pen at all times, except during competition.

Dogs must be leashed to and from the parking area, to the show ring, and grooming area.

Dogs that are on a grooming table must be attended at all times.

All dogs must be current on rabies vaccinations, and proof must be available for inspection by the show committee.

Any owners not in compliance with these regulations will be asked to leave the grounds. No refund of any event fees will be given.

All exhibitors must provide their own PPE and Masks must be worn in the ring!

We will limit the number on the show grounds to exhibitors only unless state guidelines are relaxed by show date.

Please keep other family members at home!

Social Distancing guidelines will be mandatory!

Masks must be worn in the porta-potties.

From the South on I-5: Exit 88A. Stay on this road going thru Tenino and on into Rainier. As you get into Rainier take a right on Alaska Street. Go straight into the Rainier Sportsman's Club grounds.

From the North on I-5: Exit 116 Mounts Road, go left on to Old Nisqually Road, 3.8 miles take a left on Reservation Road. Take Reservation Road to the end, you will be at Hwy 510, take a left on Hwy 510. Stay on Hwy 510 all the way to Yelm. In Yelm take a right on First Street South (which is also Hwy 507). Follow Hwy 507 into Rainier, take a left on Alaska Street and proceed straight into the Rainier Sportsman's Club.
