All ASCA registered dogs over 6 months old must have ASCA registration number. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or any person not in good standing with ASCA. **All entries must be on a current ASCA entry form (June 2020 revision). Checks returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check and exhibitors and/or owners for which a check has been returned will be reported to ASCA – NO EXCEPTIONS. FRASC will add a \$35.00 NSF fee to the amount of each returned check. Any exhibitor/owner with a check returned must pay all future FRASC event fees by cash, money order and/or cashier’s check.

**GROUNDS INFORMATION**

- ❖ Show ring and grooming will be on lawn. Bring shade. Water is available. There is no electricity. HOWEVER, there will be RV spots available for daily use for a \$25 per day fee.
- ❖ Grounds open at 7 am and close at 10 pm.
- ❖ FRASC will provide bottled water for exhibitors throughout the weekend. However, there will be no food provided ring side. There are a few food options available within a mile of the show site.

**COVID-19 INFORMATION**

- ❖ Masks will be required or those exhibitors who are not fully vaccinated, in accordance with state guide lines.
- ❖ No masks will be provided to exhibitors or spectators. You must bring your own mask / face covering.

- ❖ Exhibitors will be required to read and sign a waiver in order to pick up arm band numbers or enter the ring. There is a waiver with the premium. A wristband will be given to each person signing the waiver. NO EXHIBITORS will be allowed in the ring without a wristband.
- ❖ Everyone in attendance will be expected to maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet both in and out of the show ring. Individual set u must be spaced a minimum of 6 feet apart.
- ❖ Spectators or individuals not directly involved in the showing of dogs each day should be kept to a minimum.
- ❖ All entry forms and waiver must be completed prior to coming to the entry table. FRASC will provide extra entry forms at a table located away from the entry secretary but will not provide any pens. Please ensure you bring a pen if entries need to be completed at the show.
- ❖ All exhibitors and spectators are expected to act in a responsible manner with regarding to social distancing, sanitizing of hands, and wearing appropriate face covering as outlined above. While hand sanitizer will be provided by FRASC for judges, stewards, and volunteers, all exhibitors and spectators should bring their own hand sanitizer in the event that extra is not available.
- ❖ FRASC, along with Brookside Equestrian Park its management and employees, reserve the right to request anyone behaving in a reckless or inconsiderate manner with respect to COVID-19 to leave the grounds. If this becomes necessary, no refund of entries will be made.
