*****Limited Entry Stock Trial:**

Limited by number of runs the judge is permitted to judge in a day, and by stock limits. A waiting list will be made in order of receipt if trial fills. Please include your email address on entry (or enclose a self addressed stamped postcard if you do not have email) so we can confirm if you are accepted or on the waiting list.

Gate entries will be accepted as detailed above. Run Order will be determined on day of trial.

Substitutions allowed; No refunds unless slot is filled by another dog.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program, a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Directions to Tucker Creek Farm: GPS 48.308, -89.391

From Thunder Bay: head south on Highway 61 towards the US border. We are 6.5 miles / 10.5 km past the airport, 1 km past the Neebing Roadhouse. We are the first driveway on the right hand side just past Re-Cool Recycling and across from DeBruins Nursery.

From the US border, heading north on Highway 61 we are approximately 28 miles / 46 km from the border towards the city of Thunder Bay. The address is 3020 Highway 61, on the left, just after you pass Gillespie Road, and opposite DeBruins Nursery. If you see the "Welcome to Thunder Bay" sign you have just passed our driveway. ☺

Please pull off the sides of the driveway. Please pick up after your dogs and put the bags in the garbage cans provided. There will be either a luncheon or concession for the trials. BBQ, snacks and refreshments will be available for sale.

Farm Trial Course Descriptions & Diagrams

Duck Farm Trial – July 15, 2021

Course will use 10 head of Ducks. They will be given 15 minutes to complete the course with a 3 minute warning. Ties will be broken by the sort points and then time.

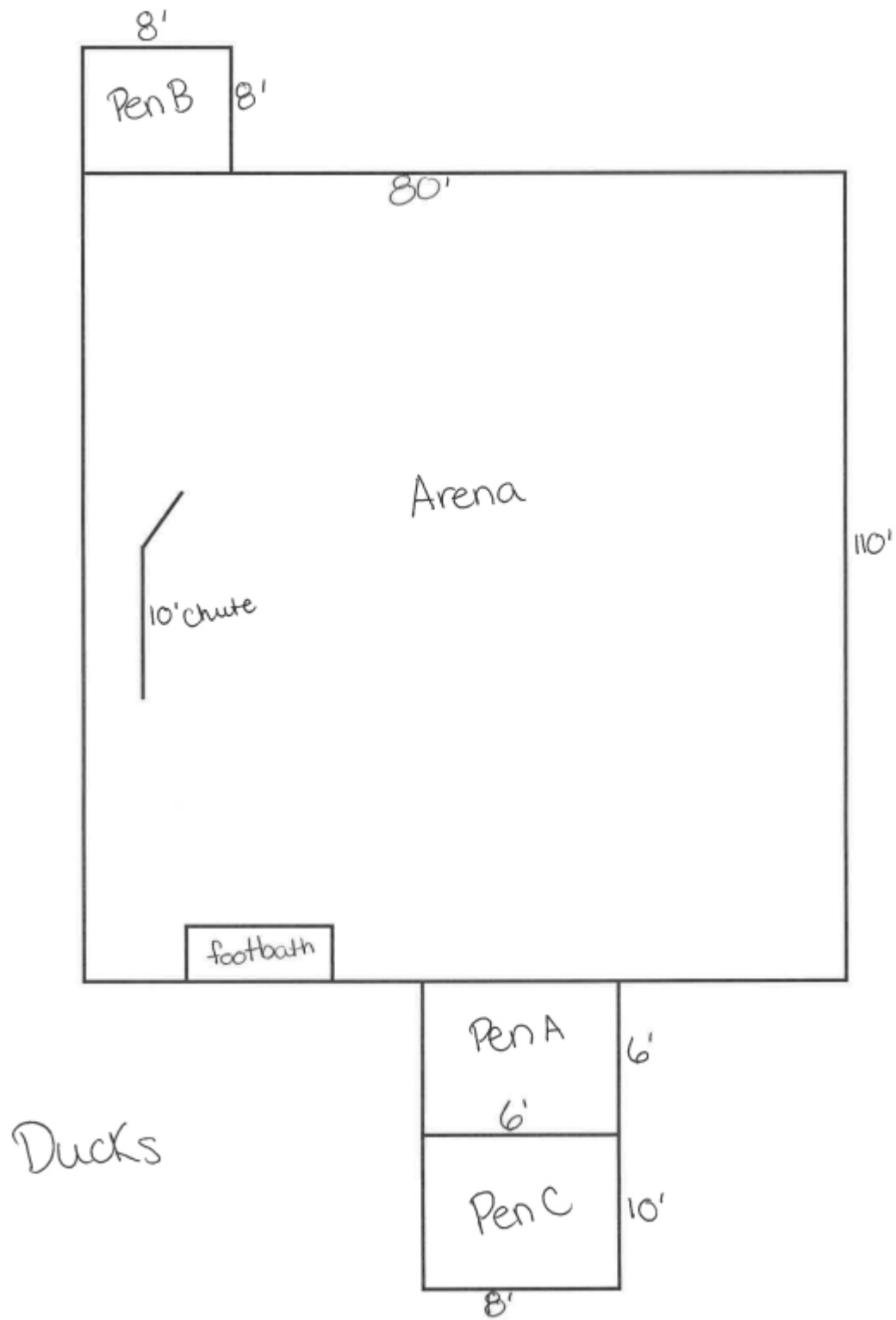
Advanced

1. Dogs will gather the Ducks in Arena (**Gather: 20 points**)
 - a. The gather is 75ft and the handler must remain at the post to send the dog
2. Ducks will be brought to Pen A to complete the sort of 5 ducks (**Sort: 25 points**)
 - a. Sorting 5 marked ducks in pen
3. Move marked ducks into Pen C (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
4. Bring remaining ducks to chute and put them through the chute using the end with a wing (**Chute work: 20 points**)
5. Ducks are then brought to the footbath simulation (**Footbath: 20 points**)
6. Ducks will be driven the length of the Arena (approximately 100ft) (**Drive: 20 points**)
 - a. Handler will remain at the start of the drive
7. Bring ducks to Pen B, and then back into Arena (**Pen Work: 10 points**)
8. Bring ducks back down to Pen A and then into Pen C with the rest of the ducks (**Pen Work: 10 points**)
9. Time stops when all ducks are in Pen C and Pen C gate is closed

Open

1. Dogs will gather the Ducks in Arena (**Gather: 20 points**)
 - a. The gather is 75ft and the handler move halfway to the stock (approx. 37ft)
2. Ducks will be brought to Pen A to complete the sort of 5 ducks (**Sort: 25 points**)
 - a. Sorting 5 ducks in pen, 3 must be marked and any remaining 2 will do
3. Move marked ducks into Pen C (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
4. Bring remaining ducks to chute and put them through the chute using the end with a wing (**Chute work: 20 points**)
5. Ducks are then brought to the footbath simulation (**Footbath: 20 points**)
6. Ducks will be driven the length of the Arena (approximately 100ft) (**Drive: 20 points**)
 - a. Handler can walk with dog for up to half of drive
7. Bring ducks to Pen B, and then back into Arena (**Pen Work: 10 points**)
8. Bring ducks back down to Pen A and then into Pen C with the rest of the ducks (**Pen Work: 10 points**)
9. Time stops when all ducks are in Pen C and Pen C gate is closed

Mixed Farm Trial – July 15, 2021

Course will use 10 head of Sheep and 5 head of Ducks. They will be given 15 minutes to complete the course with a 3 minute warning. Ties will be broken by the sort points and then time.

Advanced

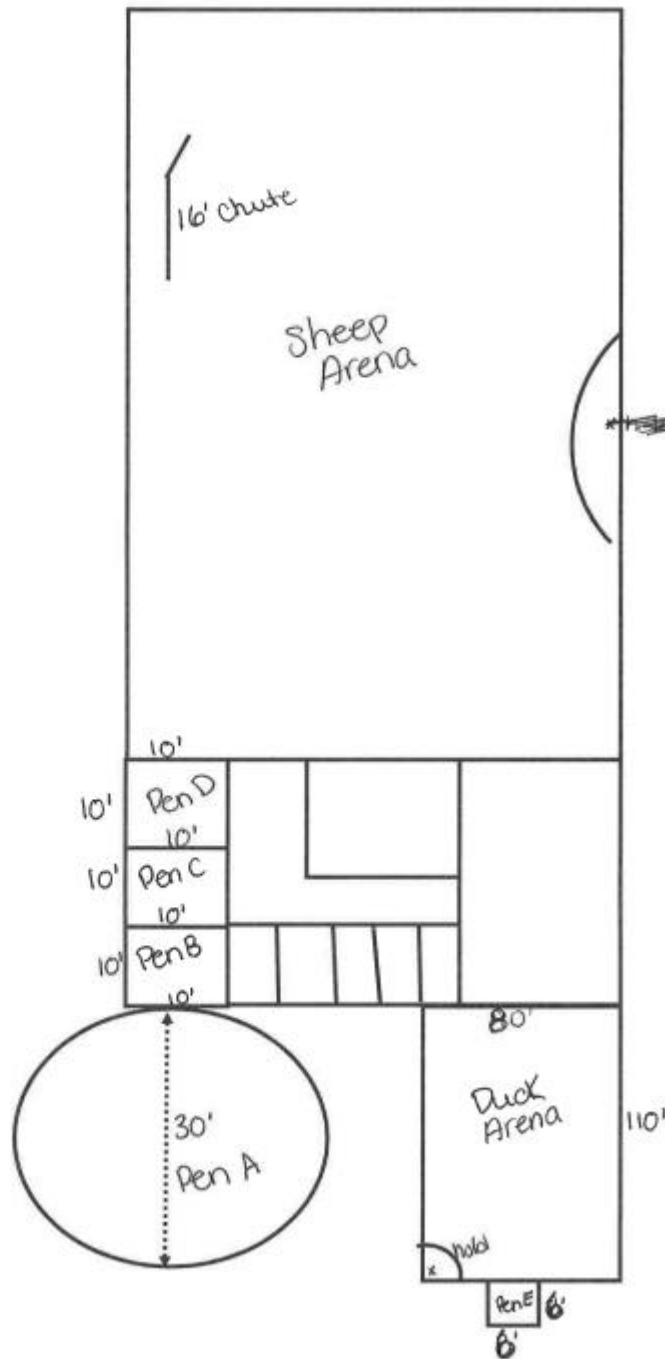
1. Dogs will gather the Ducks in Duck Arena (**Gather: 20 points**)
 - a. The gather is 75ft and the handler must remain at the post to send the dog
2. Ducks will be driven the length of the Arena (approximately 100ft) (**Drive: 20 points**)
 - a. Handler will remain at the start of the drive
3. The ducks will be brought the area of the arena to complete the hold (**Hold: 20 points**)
4. Ducks are brought to Pen E for re-pen (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
5. Teams will move to Pen A and bring sheep from Pen A to Pen B, then to Pen D then to Sheep Arena (**Pen Work: 15 points**)
6. Dogs will bring sheep through chute in Sheep Arena (**Chute: 20 points**)
7. Sheep will be sorted using either gate off pen D (**Sort: 25 points**)
 - a. 5 marked head of sheep are to be sorted
8. Sorted sheep are moved to Pen A, and then remaining sheep are also moved to Pen A
9. Time stops when all sheep are in Pen A and all gates are closed

Open

1. Dogs will gather the Ducks in Arena (**Gather: 20 points**)
 - a. The gather is 75ft and the handler move halfway to the stock (approx. 37ft)
2. Ducks will be driven the length of the Arena (approximately 100ft) (**Drive: 20 points**)
 - a. Handler can walk with dog for up to half of drive
3. The ducks will be brought the area of the arena to complete the hold (**Hold: 20 points**)
4. Ducks are brought to Pen E for re-pen (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
5. Teams will move to Pen A and bring sheep from Pen A to Pen B, then to Pen D then to Sheep Arena (**Pen Work: 15 points**)
6. Dogs will bring sheep through chute in Sheep Arena (**Chute: 20 points**)

7. Sheep will be sorted using either gate off pen D (**Sort: 25 points**)
 - a. 3 marked head of sheep and two others are to be sorted
8. Sorted sheep are moved to Pen A, and then remaining sheep are also moved to Pen A
9. Time stops when all sheep are in Pen A and all gates are closed

Diagram 2 - Mixed Farm Trial



Course will use 10 head of Ducks. They will be given 20 minutes to complete the course with a 10 minute warning. Ties will be broken by the sort points and then time.

Advanced

1. Dogs will gather the Sheep in the Arena (**Gather: 20 points**)
 - a. The gather is 150ft and handler must stay at the handler post
2. Dogs should move sheep from Pen F to Pen E (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
3. Dogs will complete a hold at the designated area (**Hold: 20 points**)
 - a. Handler must be at least 30ft away from the sheep
4. Dog will then move the sheep to Pen F and out to Field 1 (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
5. Dogs will complete a Figure 8 in Field 1 as shown in the course map (**Field work: 20 points**)
6. Dogs will bring sheep back to Pen F and back into Arena (**Pen work: 5 points**)
7. Sheep will be put through the chute in the arena (**Chute: 20 points**)
8. Sheep will be sorted using either gates in Pen D (**Sort: 25 points**)
 - a. 5 marked head will be sorted
9. Sorted sheep will be moved to Pen A and then remaining sheep moved to Pen A (**Pen work: 10 points**)
10. Time stops when all stock are in Pen A and all gates are closed and latched

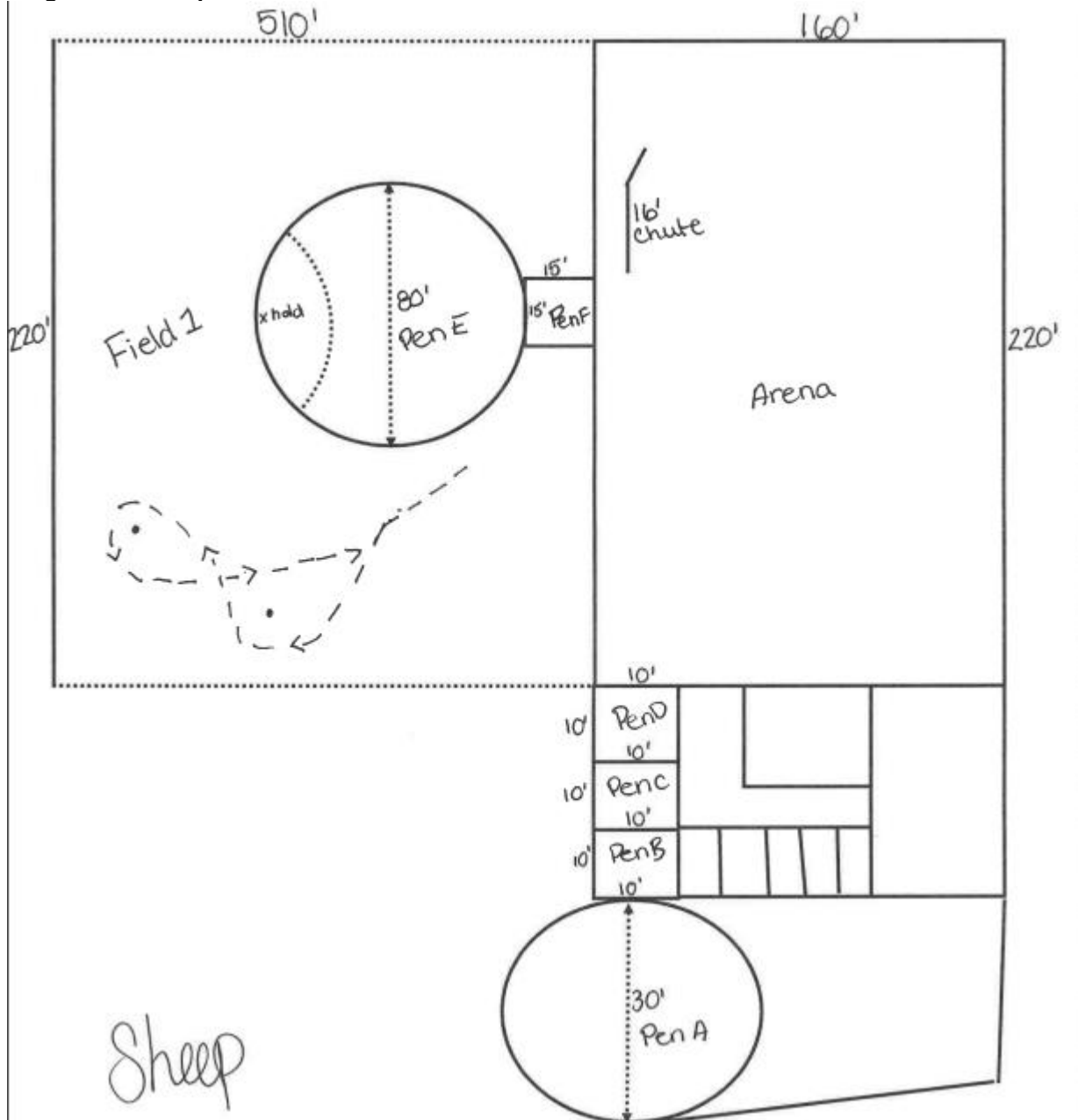
Open

1. Dogs will gather the Sheep in the Arena (**Gather: 20 points**)
 - a. The gather is 150ft and handler may go half way to the stock (75ft)
2. Dogs should move sheep from Pen F to Pen E (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
3. Dogs will complete a hold at the designated area (**Hold: 20 points**)
 - a. Handler may be with the sheep
4. Dog will then move the sheep to Pen F and out to Field 1 (**Pen Work: 5 points**)
5. Dogs will complete a Figure 8 in Field 1 as shown in the course map (**Field work: 20 points**)
6. Dogs will bring sheep back to Pen F and back into Arena (**Pen work: 5 points**)
7. Sheep will be put through the chute in the arena (**Chute: 20 points**)
8. Sheep will be sorted using either gates in Pen D (**Sort: 25 points**)
 - a. 3 marked head and 2 others will be sorted

9. Sorted sheep will be moved to Pen A and then remaining sheep moved to Pen A
(Pen work: 10 points)

10. Time stops when all stock are in Pen A and all gates are closed and latched
