**FROM WEST:** I-86 East to Exit 53. Stay straight to second light. Turn right on to Grand Central Avenue. One mile to Fairview Road (next to Byrne Dairy). Turn left on to Fairview Road. Entrance on left.

**FROM EAST:** I-86 West to Exit 54 (Route 13) towards Horseheads/Ithaca. Keep left to take the ramp to Horseheads. Turn left onto South Main Street. Take a right at the first light, which is Fairview Road. Entrance on right.
