**Jr. Handling:** Pee-Wee 3-5, Sub Jr 6-7, 8-12 Novice, 8-12 Open, 13-17 Novice, 13-17 Open, BJH

**Non-Regular Classes** (Divided by Sex): 2-4 Month Puppy, 4-6 Puppy, BOB Puppy.

**Regular Altered & Intact** (Divided by Sex): 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, Am. Bred, Bred-By, Open (Divided by Color), Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed

**Sweepstakes classes offered:** (Divided by Sex): Puppies: 2-4, 4-6, 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18

Veterans: 7-10 years old, 11 years old and older

**Movement class:** will not be divided by sex or age.

**There will be a Movement Class offered on Sunday August 8th, between shows. This class will be held in honor of Marjorie Tripp and the winner will be presented with the “Marjorie Tripp Award”.**

**Awards:** Ribbons 1st – 4th Place, Rosettes, awards all shows, all days. Great junior prizes!

**Driving Directions from the North:** take I-15 exit 325. Turn right onto Park Lane. Go to the roundabout and take the 3rd exit (Eastbound Clark Lane). Turn right (South) on to the road between the DMV and Correctional Center. Follow the road past the horse barns and blue buildings. We are in building #3 (South building).

**Driving Directions from the South:** take I-15 exit 322. Continue to the stop light and make a left. Follow the road over the freeway and continue straight through the next light. Turn left (South) on to the road between the DMV and Correctional Center. Follow the road past the horse barns and blue buildings. We are in building #3 (South building).

**Facility Accommodations:** The show will be held indoors on a high-quality matted floor over concrete. The grounds will open at 7:00 AM for set ups. The ring is 100% matted. Ringside seating is ok, but if you did not travel together please remain 6' apart. Indoor setups must be 6' apart. Building has swamp coolers and heaters.
