No entry fees will be refunded after the close of pre-entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35 service charge for returned checks.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete. These trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS and keep your dog on a leash when not competing.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

ASCA Rally trials are open to all breeds, including mixed breeds, with an ASCA Registration or ASCA QTracking number. No dog without an ASCA individual registration, LEP number or ASCA QTracking number may compete in any ASCA Rally Trial. Show Grounds: The Show Grounds are the boundaries of the grounds on which ASCA events are being held. They include, but not limited to, all areas outside the ring/trial arena (including the buffer zone) set aside for grooming, holding of dogs, and parking of vehicles of the exhibitor.
