Handlers meeting will start at 8:00 AM

Run order will be drawn prior to the trial

Please notify secretary prior to the handlers meeting if you have a bitch in season

Bitches in season will run at the end of the run order

A dog may be used in the pens to move livestock

Pre-entries must be postmarked no later than September 10th, 2021.

Day of entries will be accepted between 7:30 and 8:00 AM if run limits have not been met

COVID-19 CONSIDERTAIONS:

All persons at the trial site must check in with the trial secretary. Compliance with all rules and regulations for COVID-19 in the jurisdiction controlling the trial site is required. The trial is located in the County of Elbert, State of Colorado. Failure to comply with COVID-19 mandates may result in you being asked to leave the trial and forfeit your entry fees. If you contract COVID within 14 days of the trial or you have been in direct contact with COVID-19 within 14 days of the trial your entry will be refunded if substantiating proof is provided. Regardless, please do not come if you suspect you may have COVID-19 and provide some notice to the trial secretary so we may sell your run(s).

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. All dogs must be crated or leashed except while competing.
2. All entries must be submitted on the latest approved ASCA entry form, for the event in which your dog is entered. Entry forms are available on the ASCA website, at www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms.
3. Telephone, email, facsimile or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
4. Trial is open to all eligible breeds listed in Appendix 5, ASCA Stockdog Rules and Regulations.
5. Each dog that is not ASCA registered will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number in order to have trial points tracked and receive ASCA titling certificates. In the event your dog is not ASCA registered and does not already have a tracking number, it is a one time fee of \$10/dog. A minimum of an ASCA Service membership is required at the time of application to obtain a tracking number.
6. Prior to close of entries, refunds of pre-entries will be refunded upon written request.
7. After close of pre-entries, entry fee refunds will be issued only if your spot is filled by a wait list or day of entry. You must submit your request in writing. Requests will be processed and filled in the order received.
8. Entry fee will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent without written notice, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
9. Substitutions will be allowed only with a dog owned by the same person as the original entry.

10. Post dated and returned checks will invalidate all entries associated with that check. Writer of a returned check will be required to pay a \$50 administrative fee, in addition to all bank charges associated with the returned check. If the issue is not resolved within 10 days, the writer of said check will be reported to ASCA.
11. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot start or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other cause beyond the control of Southern Colorado Australian Shepherd Club or the trial secretary.
12. All persons entering this dog trial/event, exhibitors, handlers, children or spectators hereby waive any claim for damages against Southern Colorado Australian Shepherd Club, Australian Shepherd Club of America, Hachita Farms, any members of the aforementioned clubs, the trial secretary or the course director in the event of any loss, damage, or injury to persons, dogs or property. It is understood working with livestock and trialing are inherently dangerous activities.
13. Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their safety.
