Dogs, followed by Bitches: 6-9 months, 9-12 months, 12-15 months, 15-18 months, Novice, American Bred, Bred by Exhibitor, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners. Best of Breed: WD, WB, and Champion Dogs and Bitches

1st-4th strips for class wins and strip or rosettes to WD, RWD, WB, RWB, BOB, BOS, BOW

Entries open 9/1/2021

Entry Info: Pre-Entries must be postmarked no later than September 20, 2021

Day-of Entries will be accepted prior to each conformation show.

NOTE: JUNIORS entry fees are FREE

Non-Regular Classes: \$12 each show or All four shows: \$40/day

DAY-OF ENTRY FEE: \$25 each show or ALL Four shows: \$40/day (yes you read this right)

Regular Classes: \$20.00 each show or ALL four shows/day: \$70/day

DAY-OF ENTRY FEE: \$35.00 each show or ALL four shows/day: \$70/day (yes you read this right)

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS OF ENTRIES: Checks will be deposited upon receipt.

Entries will be refunded in the form of vouchers for the next RRASC show if the show is cancelled for any reason. Weather for this time of year will be cool in the morning sunny/hot or "who knows" during the day in NM. We suggest you dress in layers.

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America, Inc. ("ASCA®"). Rules and entry blanks may be downloaded at <http://www.asca.org/formsandrulebooks> or you may call the ASCA office at (979) 778-1082 or contact Roadrunner ASC Show Secretary to have an entry blank or flyer mailed to you via USPS. Blank Entry forms will be available at the show.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA or RRASC or AASC All ASCA rules apply.

We will have fruit trays/Muffins/Donuts for breakfast all days

There will be no food vendor on site. Fast food is about 7 miles away. (There is a small Allsup's store and gas station about 2 miles from the show site.)

IMPORTANT NOTICE & INFO:

Covid rules for the state of NM will be followed.

- *Limited camping on site-No hookups, no dumping facilities, and entrance will not accommodate a huge RV, no electric available. Porta-potty on site.*
- *Grooming Area is wherever you want to set up.*
- *The Show Secretary, Committee and Members of Roadrunner ASC, Amigos ASC and Los Suenos Horse Farm assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator.*
- *When not in the ring, all dogs must either be crated, in x-pens, or on lead and under control at all times.*
- *Remind children to stay back from the rings and away from crates and x-pens. Please teach your child to ask permission prior to petting or approaching any dog.*
- *Remain at least 10' back from the ring when dogs are competing.*
- *You are responsible for picking up not only after your dog but also cleaning up your set-up or crate area. All hair, trash and poop must be cleaned up and disposed of properly.*
- *This show will be held outdoors on grass at a private residence. There is limited shade. Bring your own shade and plenty of water.*
- *Poor Sportsmanship will NOT be tolerated (ASCA Rulebook Section 1.11).*
- *Do not leave your dogs crated in automobiles that are unattended at hotel/motels)*
- *Setups can be left over night at your own risk, gate is locked at night.*
- *Please use caution when parking in pasture as not to cause ruts.*



- *Due to the time of year, there may be mosquitos/flies so please plan accordingly*
