Driving Directions:

FROM SOUTH: Take HWY 395 to Gardnerville. At the traffic signal at HWY 395 & Waterloo Lane, *turn right* onto Waterloo.

FROM NORTH: TAKE HWY 395 to Gardnerville. At the traffic signal at HWY 395 & Waterloo Lane, *turn left* onto Waterloo.

(Waterloo street name changes to Toler, then to Fish Springs Road). Travel approximately 6 miles to Windmill Road, turning left onto Windmill. Go ¾ mile to the herding facility at the corner of Windmill & Sheena Terrace. Turn right onto Sheena Terrace to ranch entrance just past the first house on the right. Signs will be posted.
