Opening / Closing Dates: Entries postmarked September 1 – October 2, 2021: entry fee: \$30.00. Day-Before-Show Entries (if available) \$35.00. All Junior Entries \$10.00. Check-in, Move-ups, and Day-Before-Show registration (if available) will be on October 29, 2021 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and will be held in the Obedience/Rally Building.

AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded for all awards except Q ribbons. Rosettes and placements (1-4) will be issued at the completion of each class. High in Trial, High Combined, HIT Junior, and High Scoring Special Recognition categories rosettes will be awarded at the completion of the show. Judge's books will be posted for each competitor to review their scores.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and Regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. All special rules from the 2021 National Specialty must be followed.

- ASCA has the right to reprimand or suspend any person or persons from any or all privileges of ASCA for conduct prejudicial to the best interests of the Australian Shepherd, ASCA events or ASCA. Exhibitors are to maintain the highest level of sportsmanship and are to conduct themselves accordingly. Foul or abusive language, yelling at exhibitors or judges, disorderly conduct, and/or poor sportsmanship will not be allowed and shall be disciplined in accordance with Chapter 11 and the ASCA Dispute Rules and ASCA Discipline Guidelines.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- GAASC, ASCA, and the Brazos County Expo assume no liability for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, property, and/or children whether the result was by accident or any other cause. Please supervise children at all times.
- It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, COVID or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is required that you pick up after your dog at the show site. All dogs must be on lead.
- Please see the 2021 National Specialty premium for information on directions to the site, hotels, RV parking, emergency veterinarian care, food vendors, etc.
- All exhibitors will be expected to abide by any state, local, and site **Covid-19** mandates in effect on October 30, 2021.

AWARDS RULES AND ELEGIBILITY

All scores will first have the HIT calculation points added per ASCA Rally Rulebook 1.18.3

- **High Combined** for dogs entered in both Excellent B and Masters B. Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.
- **High In Trial** for dogs entered in any level A or B class. Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.
- **High In Trial Junior Handler** for dogs handled by anyone 17 years or younger on June 1st of the current ASCA year competing entered in any level A or B class. Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.

For Special Recognition Awards, please note your eligibility on included SRA Eligibility form (below) with ranking of the awards by importance to you. Include one SRA Eligibility form for each dog. Special Recognition Awards are limited to one win per entry. All scores will first have the HIT calculation points added per ASCA Rally Rulebook 1.18.3.

Special Recognition Awards:

- **High Scoring Veteran Dog** for dogs born before October 30, 2014. Ties will be broken by 1- older dog, 2-Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 3- time, and 4-runoff.
- **High Scoring Bred by Exhibitor** for dogs handled by owner/co-owner of record who is also a breeder of record or dogs handled by an immediate family member of the breeder who maintains ownership of the dog. Ties will be broken by 1- Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 2- time, and 3-runoff.
- **High Scoring Champion of Record** for dogs with confirmed ASCA Champions of Record title. Ties will be broken by 1- Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 2- time, and 3-runoff.
- **High Scoring WTCH** for dogs with confirmed ASCA WTCH title. Ties will be broken by 1- title (SDCH, WTCH-X, WTCH-M, WTCH) 2 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 3- time, and 4-runoff.
- **High Scoring FTCH** for dogs with confirmed ASCA FTCH title. Ties will be broken by 1 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 2- time, and 3-runoff.
- **High Scoring Farm, Ranch, and/or Stockdog** for dogs with confirmed ASCA farm trial, ranch trial, ranch dog, and/or arena trial titles below WTCH or FTCH. Ties will be broken by 1 – title, 2 - class of stock (C, S, D), 3 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 4- time, and 5 - runoff.
- **High Scoring OTCH** for dogs with confirmed ASCA OTCH title. Ties will be broken by 1 – title (OTCH2, OTCH-02, OTCH, OTCH – 0), 2 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 3- time, and 4 - runoff.
- **High Scoring Obedience Dog** for dogs with confirmed ASCA Obedience title lower than an OTCH. Ties will be broken by 1 – title (UDX, UDX-0, UD, CDX, ODX, CD), 2 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 3- time, and 4 - runoff.
- **High Scoring ATCH** for dogs with confirmed ASCA ATCH title. Ties will be broken by 1 – title (ATCH-III, ATCH-II, ATCH), 2 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 3 - time, and 4 - runoff.
- **High Scoring Agility Dog** for dogs with confirmed ASCA agility title lower than ATCH. Ties will be broken by 1 – Division (Elite, Open, Novice), 2 – class (Gamblers, Regular, Jumper), 3 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 4- time, and 5 - runoff.
- **High Scoring Tracking Dog** for dogs with confirmed ASCA tracking title. Ties will be broken by 1 - title (MTCH, UTDX, TDX, TDU, BTD), 2 - Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 3- time, and 4 - runoff.
- **High Scoring Dock Jumping Dog** for dogs with confirmed ASCA Dock Jumping title. Ties will be broken by 1 – level (CH, Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov), 2- division (Ultra, Pro, Elite, Fly, Deluxe, Classic, Spring), 3- Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 4- time, and 5 - runoff.
- **High Scoring MVA National Competitor** for dogs entered in 2021 ASCA National as a MVA competitor. Ties will be broken by 1- Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 2- time, and 3-runoff.
- **High Scoring MVJ National Competitor** for dogs entered in 2021 ASCA National as a MVJ competitor. Ties will be broken by 1- Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 2- time, and 3-runoff.
- **High Scoring Rescued Dog** for dogs with obtained from a rescue organization. Ties will be broken by 1- Rally class (Mast, Exc, Adv, Nov) (B, A), 2- time, and 3-runoff.
- **High Scoring C Class Dog** for dogs entered in any level C Class. Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.
- **High scoring Master Dog** for dogs entered in Master level class (B, A). Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.
- **High scoring Excellent Dog** for dogs entered in Excellent level class (B, A). Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.
- **High Scoring Advanced Dog** for dogs entered in Advanced level class (B, A). Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.
- **High Scoring Novice Dog** for dogs entered in Novice level class (B, A). Ties will be broken per ASCA rules.
