- This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.

- Returned checks are not a valid entry and a service charge of \$35 will be charged.
- Move-Ups can be made via US mail or email to the show secretary by October 18.
- No classes will be judged prior to start times listed, but may be judged later.
- All exhibitors will be expected to abide by any state, local, and site Covid-19 mandates in effect on October 30, 2021.
