Entries are limited to 100 runs per judge.

Junior Handlers: \$10.00 per class regardless of how many classes or types of classes entered.	

Day of trial entries will be taken, if trial has not closed, on Sunday, October 31st from 5pm to 7pm in the Obedience/Rally Pavilion. Armbands can be picked up during this same time. Move-ups will be processed on Sunday, October 31st from 5pm to 7pm in the Obedience/Rally Pavilion. No move-ups will be taken on Monday, November 1st.

Entries must be made on the current ASCA Rally Entry form which can be found at <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/rallyentryform.pdf>. Entries must be paid in full at the time of entry in US funds only. No entries will be accepted that require a signature or require a trip to the post office. If you use overnight mail, you must waive signature. No email or phone entries allowed. For immediate confirmation of receipt, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard. Receipt of entry will be confirmed after pre-trial entries close.

The trial will be held under cover on packed dirt in 40' x 50' rings. Limited, ring-side crating will be available. NO grooming will be allowed in the ring-side crating area. This is an ASCA sanctioned event and will be governed by the rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America.

Ribbons and Awards:

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores of 170-194.

X-Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores of 195-200.

Rosettes and Prizes will be awarded to 1st through 4th class placements, High In Trial, High Combined, and High In Trial Junior Handler.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete at this trial.

TCASC reserves the right to re-assign judges as needed. To the extent possible runs will be in catalog order, but due to the large number of expected conflicts, trial will not be stopped to maintain a strict catalog order. Dogs may run out of order at judges' discretion to keep the trial moving. Rings will not be held for longer than twenty (20) minutes to clear conflicts.

If you anticipate a ring conflict, PLEASE notify the steward of your conflict **BEFORE** your class is scheduled to start.

Only Aussies eligible to enter the ASCA Rally National Trial will be allowed to enter this pre-trial.

No bitches in season will be allowed to compete at this trial.

Lunch and breaks will be taken at judges' discretion. Food vendors are available on site and within close driving distance.

Large entries in classes will be divided up for smaller group walk throughs.

Cancellation Policy: Cancellation of pre-entries may be made by 7pm on September 30, 2021 for a full refund. No refunds will be given for requests postmarked after September 30, 2021 or emailed after 7pm on September 30, 2021. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

No entry shall be accepted from:

- 1) a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally program
- 2) a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs
- 3) a person not in good standing with ASCA
