No email or phone entries accepted. Do not send entries that require a signature or a trip to the post office.

All other classes and walkthroughs will follow in sequential order.

Lunch break, if needed, will be at judge's discretion.

Please report any move-ups during check-in or on Saturday before you leave if you need to move-up for Sunday morning. Forms will be available on site.

Fees:

Pre-Entry Price: \$15.00 for first regular class each dog, \$10.00 second regular class same dog/same trial (Masters B and Excellent B in the same trial).

Junior Entry Price: \$10.00 each class entered. DOT entries for juniors is \$15.00 each class entered.

Day of trial entries will be accepted if the trials have not filled as of the pre-entry closing date. Fees for Day of trial fees will be \$20 for each class entered; no price breaks for DOT entries.

Awards:

Qualifying scores will receive a green ribbon; strip ribbons will be awarded for placements in each class. X Qualifying ribbons will be awarded in rally for scores of 195 and higher. Rosettes will be awarded for High Scoring Australian Shepherd, High Scoring Other Breed, High in Trial Overall, High Combined, High in Trial Junior Handler. New Title ribbons will be available for those finishing a title.

Special Notices for Exhibitors:

Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete in these trials.

Gates on Saturday and Sunday will open at 8:00a.m.

No harsh training is allowed on the trial grounds at any time. Please read the rules for the classes and events you are entered to make sure you have a full understanding of ASCA Rules and Regulations.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

All Entries must be on the official ASCA entry form only. No other forms can be accepted. All entries must be signed. Rally entry forms can be downloaded at: <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/rallyentryform.pdf>.

All entries must be accompanied by a check or money order for the appropriate amount or will not be considered a valid entry and not be accepted for entry. Entry forms must be postmarked between 10/15/2021 and 12/04/2020. Do not send entries in a manner that requires a signature or a trip to the post office.

No entry fees will be refunded. Make checks payable to TCASC. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be subject to a \$35 fee, and will also be reported to ASCA if restitution is not made in a very timely manner.

All dogs must have an ASCA registration number or an ASCA tracking number to compete, except those who submit their application for a tracking number with their entry. No entry will be accepted without a tracking number, registration number or a valid application with a check made payable to ASCA for a tracking number. The State of Texas requires a current rabies vaccination. All dogs over 12 weeks of age must have a current rabies certificate. A tag does not show proof of vaccination. Thank you for your cooperation.

NO dogs Under 6 months of age will be permitted at this trial.

Any handler or owner using excessive abuse towards a dog or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the Trial site for the duration of the Trial. No entry will be accepted by persons or dogs not in good standing with ASCA.

Grooming, crating, food and dog treats must be kept at least 10 feet from the ring.

TCASC, their Boards of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
