

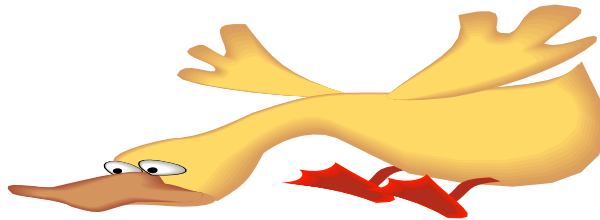

**RUNS per day – 52 RUNS OF Sheep , 40 runs of Ducks**

**Course Director: Donna Fisher**

**Handlers meeting starts at 8:15 am and trial starts at 8:30am. Run order will be drawn day of the trial. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as well as possible to allow time to exchange dogs between runs. There will be a set run order and dogs will be expected to run at their assigned time. If a handler has a conflict, they must notify the Course Director ahead of their assigned run time**

- AM DUCKS TO BEGIN 20 minutes after Sheep Trial begins**
- PM TRIAL TO BEGIN 15 MINUTES FOLLOWING THE AM SHEEP TRIAL**

**Saturday: Course B clockwise - sheep Ducks Course A clockwise**

**Sunday: Sheep will be course H counter clockwise / DUCKS: course A counter clockwise 5 head/Ducks. 3-5 head/Sheep.**

- Substitutions of another dog you own will be allowed.
- Please notify the Course Director of move ups as soon as possible.
- Individuals are responsible for any damage done to or by himself, his family, his visitors and his dog, both on the premises and in the trial arena. ASCA, NHASC, & Rodney & Donna Fisher assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- All dogs MUST be on leash when not competing. This includes dogs that handlers don't think need leashes. Please clean up after your dog.
- All dogs must be crated away from the trialing arenas.

**Directions: 15857 Hwy 105, Plantersville, Tx 77363**

**From Dallas: 45 South to the Conroe 105 exit- Go west towards Navasota....coming into Plantersville, look for the black pipe fencing on the right.**

**From Houston: 45 North to the Conroe 105 exit, Go west towards Navasota....coming into Plantersville, look for the black pipe fencing.**

**From Waco: take 6 south towards College Station. Navasota is approximately 20 miles. At Navasota you will take the Conroe 105**

**exit. Go east, approximately 14 miles to the 1774 light in Plantersville. We are the first place on the left with black pipe fencing.**
