### Directions to Grimes County Fairgrounds:

**From Austin/San Antonio**-- Hwy 290 to Brenham. Cross over Hwy 36 and continue through Brenham on 290F until it intersects Hwy 105 in town. Stay on 105 all the way to Navasota to Hwy 6. Turn LEFT and go north on Hwy 6 to the next exit for Hwy 90. Exit Hwy 90 and go east approximately 1-2 miles and turn LEFT onto FM 3455. Fairgrounds will be on the LEFT approximately 1 mile.

**From Houston**-- Hwy 290 to Hempstead. Turn RIGHT onto Hwy 6 North to Navasota. Exit Hwy 90 and go east approximately 1-2 miles and turn LEFT onto FM 3455. Fairgrounds will be on the LEFT approximately 1 mile.

**From Dallas/Ft. Worth**-- South on I-35 to Waco. From Waco, take Hwy 6 south all the way to Navasota. Exit Hwy 90 and go east approximately 1-2 miles and turn LEFT onto FM 3455. Fairgrounds will be on the LEFT approximately 1 mile.

### Conformation Information:

1. **Junior Showmanship**-- ALL PEEWEES ARE TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT IN THE RING (non-regular) Peewee (at least 3 years, to under 6 yrs) Sub-Junior (6 years, to under 8 yrs); (regular) Novice Junior (8-12 yrs), Open Junior (8-12 yrs), Novice Senior (13-17 yrs), Open Senior (13-17 yrs). Non-regular

Peewees and Sub-Juniors will each receive a participant ribbon and a prize of their choosing, and are not given class placements.

2. **Puppies-- (non-regular)** 2-4 and 4-6 puppy classes, divided by sex. First place winners to compete for Best of Breed Puppy and Best Opposite Sex Puppy.
3. **Veterans—(non-regular)** 7 to under 10 yrs, and 10+ yrs, divided by sex. Winners of each class to compete for Best Veteran.
4. **Altered & Intact—(regular)** 6-9, 9-12, 12-15, 15-18, Novice, American Bred, Bred By, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed.
5. Exhibitors should be ringside for all classes, ready to be called in. It is the judge's discretion whether to delay a class, or to allow an exhibitor to enter the ring late.
6. Rosettes and prizes are given for Best Junior, Reserve Junior, Best of Breed Puppy, Best Opposite Sex Puppy, Best Veteran, Altered and Intact Winners Dog/Bitch, Altered and Intact Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch; Altered and Intact Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best of Winners.

### **General Information:**

1. **PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS**, at the show site AND hotels. **NO BATHING/GROOMING DOGS AT HOTELS!**
2. This is a large outdoor covered barn that is open on the sides. Rings and crating will be on dirt.
3. **ACCESS TO THE FAIRGROUNDS WILL BE AT 7:00 A.M. SATURDAY AND SUNDAY. No entry prior to 7:00 a.m.**
4. There are plenty of electrical outlets. Please use power strips/surge protectors to help avoid tripping the breakers.
5. **DOG/PUPPY SALES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Any person found to be selling dogs on the premises will be asked to leave and not return.
6. Puppies under the age of 2 months are prohibited from the show grounds, INCLUDING the RV parking areas.
7. Puppies/dogs over the age of 16 wks are required to have proof of rabies vaccination. Tags do not constitute such proof.
8. Eastex ASC, ASCA, and Grimes County Fair assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children. Children are to be supervised at all times.
9. Any handler, owner, or spectator being abusive towards a dog, not picking up their dogs' poop, and/or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the show site for the duration of the show weekend.  
**DO NOT LEAVE DOGS OVERNIGHT IN THE BARN.**
10. Please clean up your grooming setup areas before leaving.
11. **Entries on NEWEST official ASCA entry forms only. Copies may be made if signed statement is on the back. No other forms accepted. All entries must be signed on the back. Any entry form that is not properly completed does not constitute a valid entry, and armband numbers will NOT be issued until the entry form is complete and correct.** Conformation entry forms can be filled in online using "text entry" at <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/conentryform.pdf> then printed out, SIGNED on the back, and mailed in. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ON THE NEWEST FORM THAT HAS THE COVID-19 WAIVER!!**
12. Entry fees will only be refunded prior to the show closing, which is the day-of-show registration period. No entry will be accepted for a dog or from a handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Make checks payable to **Eastex ASC**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$30 service charge for returned checks. **EMAIL ENTRIES AND PAYPAL PAYMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR THIS EVENT.**
13. All dogs' ages will be calculated by their age on each day of show. Be prepared to present papers on all dogs six months of age or older. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
