Obedience Trial #1 Jan 2, 2022

9:00 – 9:30 a.m. – Registration for day of trial entries if available, move-ups & check-in for all obedience exhibitors. Judging begins at 10:00am. Classes will run in the following order: Utility B, Utility A, Open ODX B, Open ODX A, Open CDX B, Open CDX A, Novice C, Novice B, Novice A, Beginner Novice B, Beginner Novice A.

Obedience Trial #2 Jan 2, 2022

12:00pm – 12:30pm – Registration for day of trial entries if available, move-ups & check-in for all obedience exhibitors. Judging begins at 1:30pm. Classes will run in the following order: Utility B, Utility A, Open ODX B, Open ODX A, Open CDX B, Open CDX A, Grad Novice, Novice C, Novice B, Novice A, Beginner Novice B, Beginner Novice A.

The show site will open each day at 7:00a.m. **No dogs may be left at the show site overnight or unattended.**

Obedience Trial 1: registration 9:00 am to 9:00m..Trial starts at 10:00 AM

Obedience Trial 2: registration 12:00 – 12:30pm with trial starting at 1:00 pm

Pre-Entry Price: \$15.00 each class entered. Junior Entry Price: \$10.00 each class entered.

Day of Trial Price (if available): \$25 for each class entered. Junior Entry Price: \$15.00 each class entered.

If the trial fills, we will have a wait list.

Awards:

For obedience and rally, qualifying scores will receive a green ribbon; strip ribbons will be awarded for placements in each class. Rosettes will be awarded for High Scoring Australian Shepherd, High Scoring Other Breed, High in Trial Overall, High Combined, High in Trial Junior Handler in Rally and High Scoring Junior Handler in Obedience. In Rally, Qualifying scores of 195 and higher will receive strip ribbons

indicating an "X" qualifying score. New Title ribbons will be available for those finishing an Obedience or Rally title.

Special Notices for Exhibitors:

No training is allowed in the ring at these trials. No harsh training is allowed on the trial grounds at any time; this includes inside the building and outside the building. Please read the rules for the classes and events you are entered to make sure you have a full understanding of ASCA Rules and Regulations.

Bitches in season will not be permitted to show at these trials and are not allowed to be in the building or crated in the building.

All Entries must be on official ASCA entry forms only. No other forms can be accepted. All entries must be signed. Entry forms for obedience and rally are different. If entering both obedience and rally, you will need two different forms.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

All entries must be accompanied by a check or money order for the appropriate amount or will not be considered a valid entry and not be accepted for entry. Entry forms will be available at the check in table for Day of Trial Entries, as well as tracking number forms if needed.

No entry fees will be refunded. Make checks payable to NHASC. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be subject to a \$35 charge, and also reported to ASCA if restitution is not made in a very timely manner.

All dogs must have an ASCA registration number or an ASCA tracking number to compete with the exception of those who submit their application for a tracking number at the trial desk. No entry will be accepted without a tracking number, registration number or a valid application with a check made payable to ASCA for a tracking number. Dogs must be entered in classes they are eligible to compete (i.e. if you enter Open, you must have completed your ASCA CD with the dog you are entering).

The State of Texas requires a current rabies vaccination. All dogs over 12 weeks of age must have a current rabies certificate. A tag does not show proof of vaccination. Thank you for your cooperation. NO dogs Under 6 months of age will be permitted at this trial.

Any handler, owner, or spectator using excessive abuse towards a dog or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the Trial site for the duration of the Trial.

No entry will be accepted by persons or dogs not in good standing with ASCA.

Grooming, crating, food and dog treats must be kept at least 10 feet from the ring.

NHASC, their Boards of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
