- **Acceptance of “Day of Trial”/Late Entries**
We will now accept entries after the “pre-entry” closing date.
We will accept “Day of Show” entries until 8:30 AM on Saturday, 7:30 AM on Sunday, up to 350 runs per day.
You may also email or mail the entry after the pre-entry closing date if you don’t want to get to the trial so early. But I must receive it by 11:00 AM on the Thursday preceding the trial and, should you choose not to attend, you are still responsible for the entry fee.
- **Implementation of “Day of Trial” Change Fee**
Preliminary and final confirmation letters are sent to all exhibitors who pre-enter. Exhibitors should check their entry information and notify the trial secretary of any changes that need to be made. Changes requested at the trial will be assessed a \$15 secretarial processing fee per dog – regardless of who made the error.
PLEASE check your confirmations. This does not include move-ups for Sunday which are received within 30 minutes of the end of the trial on Saturday.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Late Entries

We will accept entries after the pre-entry closing date, up to published limits. Day of trial entries will be accepted until 8:30 AM on Saturday, 7:30 AM on Sunday.

Refunds

Full refunds will be granted prior to the pre-entry closing date. After that time refunds, less a \$5 a run administration fee, will be granted to injured dogs or bitches in season, with doctor’s letter, if the request is presented to the trial secretary no later than Wednesday before the trial. No refunds will be issued for amounts under \$10.

Eligibility

ASCA agility trials are open to ALL breeds, including mixes. Your dog does NOT have to be registered with ASCA to enter ASCA agility trials. However, to earn titles, you must have a QTracking number or an ASCA Australian Shepherd registration. A QTracking number application can be found on the ASCA website at

Championship Program (Division & Levels)

The Championship Program is the original ASCA Agility program.

The Junior Handler Division is open to any dog handled by an exhibitor who is 17 years of age or younger. Dogs entered in the Junior Handlers Division classes MAY jump 4” lower than their regular jump height.

The Veterans Dog Division will be as described in the ASCA Agility rulebook. Dogs entered in the Veterans Dog Division classes MUST jump 4” lower than their regular jump height.

Exhibitors may, at their discretion, enter at a level higher than they have titled. If they are registered to receive titles, higher level scores will be applied to unearned lower level titles. Note: Once dogs Qualify at the higher level, they cannot return to compete at the lower level.

ACE Program (Divisions & Levels)

The Standard Division is open to any dog 18 months or older. They can jump one height lower than their Championship Standard Division height. Course times for dogs in the ACE program will be 10% greater than the Standard Division dogs in the Championship program.

The Senior Dog Division is open to any dog age seven (7) or older. Dogs entered in the Senior Dog Division will jump 4” lower than their standard jump height the ACE program. Course times for dogs entered in the Senior Dog Division of the Regular Agility and Jumpers classes shall be 10% greater than the SCT for the Standard Division in the ACE program.

FEO

We will accept “For Exhibition Only” (FEO) entries. The minimum age for dogs entered “For Exhibition Only” is 15 months of age. Any dog younger than 18 months of age must jump at a lower height than their regular jump height. Dogs older than 18 months may enter FEO at any jump height and level. Please note that FEO scores will not apply to any ASCA agility titles.

Move-Ups

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted. Pre-trial move-ups must be received by 6:00 pm on the Monday preceding the trial.

Miscellaneous

Titles can be earned under one judge. Twenty points are required for jumpers & gamblers; thirty points for regular.

Height Cards and Measurements

Dogs entering the jump height classes 20" or less (with height less than or equal to 20"), that do not have a permanent ASCA, AKC or NADAC height card must be measured. Dogs entering 20+" or 24" jump heights are exempt.

Equipment

Rubberized Slatted Aframe & Dogwalk and slatless teeter will be used. Jumps, including double, (may be used at the judge's discretion) tunnels, 24-inch weaves, The A-frame shall be set 5'6".

Electronic timing will be used, including start notice and gamble horns.

Prizes & Awards

Qualifying and 1st through 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each class. A rosette will be awarded to dogs finishing their ATCH. Please note on your entry form if you are close to finishing an ATCH. A title ribbon for finishing of each regular level will be given.

- via I-76: Exit 2 Seville. Go South 0.6 miles. Turn RIGHT onto W.Greenwich Rd. for 0.6 miles. One Smart Dog is the driveway on your right after Ryan Rd.
- via I-71: Take Exit 209 to merge onto I-76 E/US-224 E toward Akron. Take Exit 2 Seville to merge onto OH-3 S/Wooster Pike toward Seville. Go South 0.6 miles. Turn RIGHT onto W.Greenwich Rd. for 0.6 miles. One Smart Dog is the driveway on your right after Ryan Rd.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial will be held according to ASCA Agility regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The ASCA Agility Rulebook is available at: www.asca.org
- ASCA, Medina SWARM Agility Club and Pinnacle Dog Sports will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor.
- All dogs must be on a leash when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create a disturbance may be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refunds will be made.
- Entries from individuals who are not in good standing with ASCA will not be accepted.
- Indoor crating space will be available. You are required to place a tarp, plastic or mat underneath your crates or X-pens. Please consolidate crating as much as possible. A committee member will have the right to consolidate crating as needed.
- Dogs are not allowed to relieve themselves on the building or shrubbery around the building.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement (including hotel site). FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the total cost for a QT number?

In order to obtain a QT number for your dog, all owners must be members of ASCA. The cost for a basic Service Membership is \$10 per owner if not already a current member.

- Your membership is good for one year and does not need to be renewed unless you want to obtain another QT number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is in addition to the QT number fee of \$10 per dog.





A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be \$20. For two dogs, the cost would be \$30, etc.

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number in order to compete in Agility, Stock or UAD events, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You will need a QT number to enter an ASCA Sanctioned Obedience Trial, Rally Trial, Tracking Test or Dock Jumping.
- Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a QT number from ASCA.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

If you would like your dog's points recorded by ASCA and to receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you will need to obtain a QT number.

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—(1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s) and handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as “Applicant”). (2) “Releasees” here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents; as well as ASCA®’s affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees, judges, contractors, insurers, and agents. (3) Applicant enters into this Agreement in consideration for being allowed to submit an entry form and, if approved, to take part in related activities of ASCA® and/or its affiliates. (4) Applicant acknowledges entering into this Agreement voluntarily, after the opportunity to obtain independent legal review of it and to have questions about its likely meaning answered through such review. (5) Applicant accepts the terms of this Agreement not only on his/her own behalf but also for his/her successors, assigns, beneficiaries, heirs, parents/guardians, and anyone else who might raise a claim on his/her behalf or as a result of her suffering harm. (6) To the extent any provision or application of this Agreement turns out to be unenforceable, the rest of it still remains fully effective. (7) This Agreement is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice-of-law rules, and—to the extent permitted by law—any legal action by Applicant that names Releasees as one or more defendants shall be filed and heard solely in the state or federal courts serving the county of ASCA®’s headquarters: Brazos County, Texas. (8) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event. (9) Applicant represents that the dog(s) being entered is/are not known to pose a hazard to persons, other dogs, or property and that all required rabies and other vaccinations under the state and local law of the dog’s state of residence are current. (10) Applicant acknowledges awareness of and assumes the risk associated with his/her participation and that of his/her dog(s) in this event and related activities, among which are personal injury to Applicant and those affiliated with Applicant, injury to Applicant’s dog(s), and damage to Applicant’s property. As but a few examples, Applicant and/or his/her dog(s) may be injured from the condition of (or failure to warn of the condition of) floors, stairways, lighting, security measures or a lack of them, electrical devices, fittings, show rings, parking areas, motor vehicles, and unfamiliar animals and people. (11) Applicant releases Releasees from any claim or liability whatsoever arising from any injury, harm, liability, or demand in anyway said to occur during or in connection with related events, also waiving any right to assert such claims that he/she otherwise might have in the absence of this Agreement. (12) Applicant also agrees to indemnify Releasees from any claim that Applicant or those acting on Applicant’s behalf, for Applicant’s benefit, or in Applicant’s place, might assert against Releasees. The obligation in this regard extends even to Applicant’s paying settlements, judgments, and expenses and costs of legal defense incurred by Releasees. (13) The waivers, releases, and promises of indemnification undertaken by Applicant in this Agreement **EXTEND EVEN TO: CLAIMS ASSERTING NEGLIGENCE PER SE, CONDUCT THAT IS INTENTIONAL OR RECKLESS, CLAIMS OF FRAUD, CLAIMS INVOLVING DEATH, ACTIVITY THAT WOULD OVERLAP WITH ALLEGATIONS OF CRIMINALITY, AND/OR CLAIMS SEEKING EXEMPLARY DAMAGES.** They apply without regard to the basis of the claim (e.g., based on tort, breach of contract, common law, implied or express warranty, or otherwise). Applicant’s promised indemnification of Releasees also extends to claims third parties assert against Releasees said to be based on Applicant’s conduct. (14) **INFECTIOUS DISEASE—**Applicant’s promises and assumption of risks in this Agreement also extend to the risk and any asserted harm Applicant and the dog(s) may suffer from actual or threatened exposure to infectious disease, whether COVID-19 or otherwise, and Applicant accepts full responsibility for taking such measures as may be required or prudent to protect Applicant and well as other participants in the events. Applicant represents being aware of related recommend health practices, e.g., masking and distancing. (15) Applicant assigns to ASCA® the sole right to pursue any claim in connection with or arising in relation to the scheduled events that Applicant or those acting for Applicant otherwise might assert against any person or entity affiliated with ASCA®. (16) There are no provisions to this Agreement other than as spelled out here and they may not be modified except by formal ASCA® board action. This Agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum protection from liability allowable under the law.
