Directions to the Fairgrounds

From North, South, and East:

Take I-39 to Hwy 10 West toward Marshfield. Continue Hwy 10 West for approximately 28 miles to Business WI-13 North. At the traffic circle, follow signs for Business WI-13 North (Central Ave). Follow Central Ave North to South Maple Ave (slight right). Follow S. Maple Ave to E. 17th St. Turn right onto E. 17th St and proceed 2 blocks to the Central Wisconsin State Fair Grounds. Turn left at the Round Barn and proceed to the parking area. The Lang 4-H building is in the center of the fairgrounds.

From West:

Take Hwy 29 East toward Green Bay. Take Exit 132 for WI-13 South toward Colby/Abbotsford. Follow WI-13 South for approximately 21 miles. In Marshfield, turn Right onto S. Central Ave and continue to E. 14th St. Turn left onto E. 14th St. In one block, turn right onto S. Maple Ave. Continue 3 blocks to E. 17th St. Turn left onto E. 17th St and proceed 2 blocks to the Central Wisconsin State Fair Grounds. Turn left at the Round Barn and proceed to the parking area. The Lang 4-H building is in the center of the fair grounds.

Bitches in Obedience & Rally Entrants Please Note: Entries will close if 30 obedience entries are received. Rally entries will be unlimited.

Bitches in Season Cannot Compete: any exhibitor whose bitch entered at these trials comes into heat prior to closing date may get a refund of their entries. After closing date a veterinary certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging the morning of the trial and entry fees will be refunded less \$5 per day entered.

Tracking Fee for Non-ASCA Dogs: All non-ASCA registered dogs will be required to have an ASCA QT Tracker Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10.00 per dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (Service member fee \$10:00). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. You will be able to apply for a tracking number the day of the show if your dog does not have one. Application can be found online at <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/trackapp.pdf>

“If your dog has not earned any ASCA titles, your dog is required to begin in Novice”.
ASCA title requires 3 qualifying scores under 2 judges.

PRE-ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY CLOSING DATE OF May 7th 2022

- Entries postmarked after this date will be charged gate entry
 - No refund of entries after pre-entry closing date
- Entries with missing or incomplete information will be returned and does not constitute an entry - \$35 returned check fee

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- All Aussies over six (6) months of age may be asked to show proof of ASCA registration. Be prepared to present registration papers on all dogs six (6) months of age or older as of the date of the show.
 - All dogs may be asked to show proof of rabies vaccination. In that event, a certificate from a licensed veterinarian is required.
- Pursuant to ASCA rules, any dog displaying clinical symptoms of a communicable disease will be removed from the trial site, with no refund of entries. In the case of removal of a dog that shows symptoms of any contagious disease, all dogs in the same household or traveling with said dog shall also be removed from show site. (Also per RRVASC policy). No refunds.
- Any dog that displays viciousness toward people or animals at any time on the show premises will be ejected from the show site for the entire show weekend with no refund of entries. There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and or handler are dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason.
- Physical abuse of any animal will not be tolerated. Any person on the show site reported to have physically abused an animal will be ejected from the show site for the entire show weekend with no refund of entries, and will be subject to disciplinary action per ASCA rules.
- No puppies less than 8 weeks of age are allowed on the show site. Absolutely no puppy sales allowed on the show grounds.
- Rock River Valley practices the *PUP Policy* (Pick it Up People). Anyone caught not cleaning up after their dog (indoors or out) is subject to ejection from the show site, no refund of entries. Please keep your grooming/crating area neat.
- RRVASC, its Board of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs, personal property and/or children. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- A 100% refund will be given for any request **received prior to closing date**. \$35 service charge for bank

- returned checks.
- Training on the grounds is prohibited.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times. Please stack crates wherever possible.
- Do not leave unattended dogs on grooming tables.
- No expenses or chalking in the building. Soft-sided crates limited to two.
