#### **Rally:**

Master C/B/A, Excellent C/B/A, Advanced C/B/A, Novice C/B/A. **No bitches in season are allowed to participate. Rally is limited to the first 35 entries per show. No entry will be accepted after 35 dogs.**

#### **Obedience:**

Utility B/A, Open B/A/CDX/ODX, Novice B/A, Optional Titling Beginner Novice B/A, Sub Novice – Group sits and downs after individual classes. **No bitches in season are allowed to participate. Obedience is limited to the first 25 entries per show. No entry will be accepted after 25 dogs.**

**Section 8:** All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or an ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned obedience trials. Photo copies of originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned obedience trials.

### **Directions to show grounds**

**SOUTHBOUND:** Take I-205 from north of Vancouver to Exit #9, OREGON CITY. Follow signs to 99E, which goes through Oregon City (it's about 8 miles from Oregon City to Canby). You can see the Fairgrounds to the right as you approach Canby. Look for FAIRGROUNDS road signs. OR Continue southbound I-5 through the Portland metropolitan area and take exit #282, Canby-Hubbard. Follow the directions to Canby and go to the north end of town. Look for the FAIRGROUNDS signs to the show site, which is on the west side of 99E. **WE WILL BE IN THE ORANGE LOT/GATE.**

**NORTHBOUND:** Take the DONALD-AURORA exit from I-5, turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp, proceed to Aurora (about 1 mile). Turn left onto 99E, go north through Barlow to Canby (about 4 miles). Go to the north end of town and follow FAIRGROUDNS signs to the show (to your left from 99E).

**WE WILL BE IN THE ORANGE LOT/GATE.**

**Show grounds open Friday May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022 after 3 PM, depart show grounds May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 by 3 PM**

**Grounds and General Information:** Show & Trial will be held outside on grass. Grounds open at 7 AM and close at 10 PM (Gates will be locked from 10 PM-7 AM daily). No designated grooming area, however we ask that you keep your grooming setups at least 20 feet from the rings. Electricity may be available within the fairgrounds, but preference will be given to overnight RV's.
