Masters B, A & C; Excellent B, A & C; Advanced B, A & C; Novice B, A & C
TEAM rally offered day of show ONLY; if Trials do not fill

Please remember to include your Jump Heights.

Dogs in Masters & Excellent will run in jump height order.

Junior Rally exhibitors be sure to complete your entry form!

ALL ASCA® RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED

Per ASCA Rules NO Bitches In Season are allowed to run.

Rally Class entry is open to all Australian Shepherds that have a permanent individual registration or LEP Number and are over 6 months of age or older, or any dog over 6 months of age or older that has a tracking number issued by ASCA or a tracking number application completed and fees paid.

Fairground Accessibility for Exhibitors:

The Show Arena building will open at Noon on Friday, June 17, 2022 and at 9:00 am on Saturday & Sunday, June 18 & 19, 2022

Covered grooming area: You will be asked to stack crates if necessary.

Grooming Tables per exhibitor may be limited due to limited space.

X Pens Allowed, however may not be left unattended!

ABSOLUTELY NO CHALKING or BLOWING OUT of CHALK ALLOWED!!!

NO GROOMING IN THE EXHIBITION ARENA

NO CRATING or seating allowed within 10 feet of the rings.

There will be NO reserving or holding set up space at this facility.

ALL exhibitors are required to keep their grooming & crating area clean!

NO dogs are ALLOWED to be left in the show/groom building unattended.

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOGS!

IF you do not you will be asked to leave with no REFUNDS!

All dogs and equipment must be removed from the building within ONE HOUR after the conclusion of the show on Sunday, June 19, 2022 or you will be charged an hourly rental rate of \$50.00 per hour for the building.
