Refund of entries - Pre-entries will be refunded upon written request if such request is received and/or postmarked prior to August 20, 2022. *No other entry refunds will be granted for any reason.*

All ASCA registered dogs over 6 months old must show proof of registration. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or any person not in good standing with ASCA. Checks returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check and exhibitors and/or owners for which a check has been returned will be reported to ASCA - NO EXCEPTIONS. NorCal will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Any exhibitor/owner with a check returned must pay all future NorCal event fees by cash, money order, and/or cashier's check.

A new title medallion will be awarded to any dog or bitch who finishes their ASCA Conformation Championship at one of these three NorCal ASC shows (applies to both Intact and Altered).

SHOW / TRIAL RINGS, DAY SET UPS, & ELECTRICITY ACCESS

The ring will be located on grass. Grooming is to be done at exhibitor set-ups and must be at least 20 feet away from the show ring. We recommend that you bring sun and wind protection. ***No day of show set ups are allowed on the show lawn until 2:00 p.m. Friday in order to allow for the show committee to set up for the show. Roping off or “pre-reserving” of day set up spots will not be allowed prior to 2:00p.m.on Friday.***

IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING ELECTRICITY HOOK-UPS – There is no electricity on the show lawn; however, generators are allowed but must be at least 20 feet from the show ring while in use.

OVERNIGHT RV/CAMPERS

There are RV spot available on a first come, first served, basis through the show site for \$45 per night (includes water and 30 or 50 amp hook-ups). All RV sites must be reserved through the show site by calling 916-682-1403. All RV fees are collected by Brookside Equestrian Park and should not be sent with your entries or paid to NorCal ASC. Prices are set by the show grounds owner and subject to change. NorCal ASC is not responsible for changes.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE & SHOW SITE RULES /INFORMATION

Brookridge Equestrian Park is a premier equestrian facility that has graciously extended the use of their grounds to local dogs clubs, like NorCal ASC, for conformation shows. As such, we expect all NorCal ASC participants, owners, and attendees to be respectful of any equine events that may be taking place on the grounds. Also, please watch for children and/or horses on the property, and be respectful of all facility employees and/or visitors.

- All children attending the NorCal ASC show must be under the direct supervision of an adult at all times. If any children associated with the ASCA event are found to be unsupervised outside of the NorCal ASC shows grounds, it could result in excusal from the show site and no refund of entries will be given.
- No one associated with the NorCal ASC show is to enter any arena, barn or building (with the exception of restrooms) that is not part of the NorCal ASC show site (grass lawn on which the show is held).
- All posted signs and speed limits must be adhered to while on the facility premises.
- Absolutely no dogs will be allowed off leash for any reason at any time. This is a working equestrian facility and this rule will be strictly enforced.
- There is no washing of dogs within or directly adjacent to the show grounds or at any of Brookside's equine wash racks.
- Brookside Equestrian Park, its owners or employees, reserve the right to remove anyone from the property for not following the facility rules (either posted on grounds or contained in this flyer), including those rules associated to COVID-19 protocols. Any exhibitor or owner excused from the ground for any reason will not be entitled to a refund of any entries or RV fees.
- **YOU MUST PICK UP AFTER YOURSELF AND YOUR DOGS!** This includes all trash, dog waste, and any excessive dog hair. Failure to do so may result in your being asked to leave the ground with no refund of entries.
