General Information:

- All ASCA Rules and Regulations shall apply to this trial.
- No Pre-Entries accepted prior to a postmark date of July 15, 2022.
- Pre-Entries **MUST** be postmarked by August 19, 2022
- All entries postmarked after closing date of August 19, 2022 will be charged day of trial entry fee, if runs are available.
- Overnight entries accepted only if signature is waived.
- No DHL, UPS, telephone, email or faxed entries will be accepted.
- Substitutions will be allowed only with a dog owned by the same person making the original entry.
- Entry fee to be made by US check/cashiers check/money order and payable to CASA.
- Pre-entries will be refunded 100% for any written request received prior to the close of pre-entries. After close of pre-entries, entry fee refunds will be issued only if your spot is filled by a wait list or day of entry. You must submit your request in writing. Requests will be processed and filled in the order received.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent without written notice, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- Registered owner of dog shall be responsible for replacement cost of cattle at the current Market value.
- Confirmation of entries will be made via email.
- Bitches in season will run at the end of the run order and must be crated away from competition area.
- Please notify trial secretary prior to handlers meeting if you have a bitch in season.
- Exhibitor is responsible for the accuracy of dog/owner/handler information listed on the entry form.
- Trial is open to all eligible breeds listed in Appendix 5, ASCA Stockdog Rules and Regulations.
- Each dog that is not ASCA registered will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number in order to have trial points tracked and receive ASCA titling certificates. In the event your dog is not ASCA registered and does not already have a tracking number, it is a one time fee of \$20/dog. A minimum of an ASCA Service membership is required at the time of application to obtain a tracking number. Tracking Number application is attached.

- Entry forms are available on the ASCA website at www.asca.org and attached to this premium.
- The most current ASCA stock entry form must be used.
- **PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL ENTRIES ARE LEGIBLE. INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
- Please make sure your entry form includes the dog's call name and your email address.
- A \$50 service fee will apply to all returned checks.
- Entrants are responsible for all damage caused by themselves, their dogs and family members.
- All persons entering this dog trial/event, exhibitors, handlers, children or spectators hereby waive any claim for damages against Colorado Australian Shepherd Association, Australian Shepherd Club of America, Save The Cowboy Ranch, any members of the aforementioned clubs, the trial secretary, course director, judges or volunteers, in the event of any loss, damage, or injury to persons, dogs or property. It is understood working with livestock and trialing are inherently dangerous activities.
- Please stay in designated areas. All dogs **MUST** be leashed when not competing, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Parents are solely responsible for their children & are expected to keep them supervised & controlled at all times for their safety.
- Smoking only allowed inside your vehicle.
- This is private property. You must pick up after yourself and your dog.
- A setout dog will be used at this trial.

Weather: Please be prepared for any type of weather for both you and your dog. Bring your own shade and chairs, sunscreen, etc.

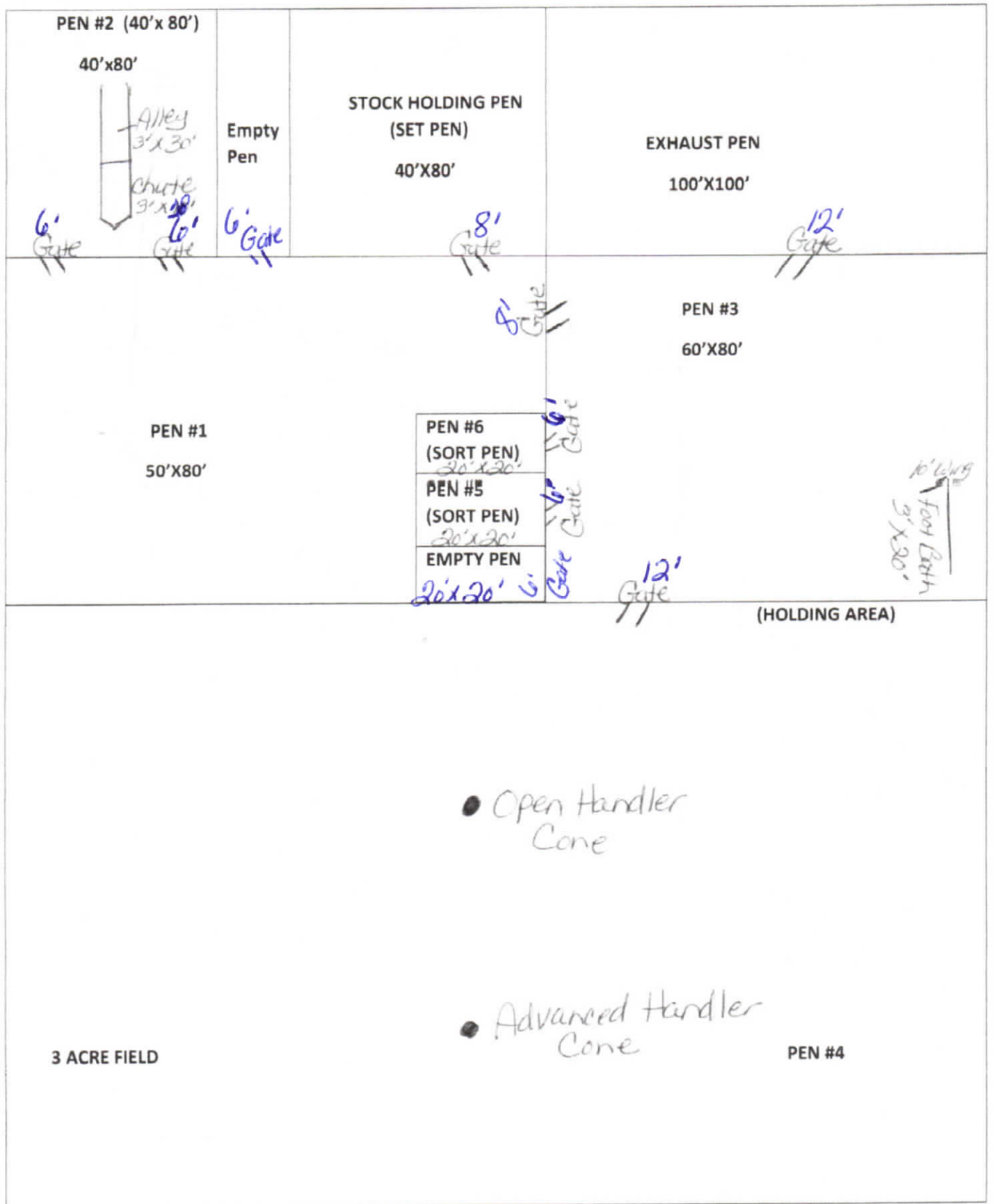

CASA – FARM TRIAL – CATTLE

TRIAL #1

20 minute limit

Warnings given at 10 minutes/3 minutes

All gates must be closed after each task

Tie broken by sort then gather

1. **PEN WORK:** Take 5 head of cattle from Pen #1 to Pen #2. (5 pts)
2. **ALLEY & CHUTE:** Move cattle from Pen #2 thru alley & chute. (20 pts)
3. **PEN WORK:** Move cattle from Pen #2 to Pen #1. (5 pts)
4. **PEN WORK:** Move cattle from Pen #1 to Pen #3 to gate at Pen #4 (5 pts)
5. **GATHER:** Handler and dog go to cone for gather. Advanced handlers stay at the cone for gather. Open Handlers can leave dog at cone and go halfway to send dog. Gather stock back past cone. (20 points)
6. **HOLD:** Take cows back to gate at Pen #4 and hold cows to the right side of gate at Pen #4 until Judge calls Hold. (20 points)(extra task)
7. **PEN WORK:** Move cattle from Pen #4 to Pen #3. (5 points)
8. **FOOT BATH:** Take cattle through foot bath. Advanced handlers have to stay behind handlers line. Open Handlers have no restrictions. (20 pts) (extra task)
9. **SORT:** Advanced handlers will sort 3 marked cows from Pen #3 into Pen #5. Put remaining 2 unmarked cows into Pen #6. Open handlers will sort 3 cows (marked or unmarked) from Pen #3 into Pen #5 and the remaining 2 cows into Pen #6. (25 points)
10. **PEN:** Take cows from sort pens to Exhaust Pen (5 points)

TRIAL #2

20 minute limit

Warnings given at 10 minutes/3 minutes

All gates must be closed after each task

Tie broken by gather then chute

1. **PEN WORK:** Take 5 head of cattle from Pen #1 to Pen #3. (5 points)
2. **GATHER:** Handler & dog go to cone for gather. Advanced handlers stay at the cone for the gather. Open handlers can leave dog at cone and go halfway to send dog. Gather stock past cone. (20 points)
3. **DRIVE:** Drive stock back to Pen #3. Advanced handlers must stay behind cone until stock reaches gate at Pen #3. Open Handlers can walk beside or behind dog. (20 points) (extra task).
4. **FOOT BATH:** Take stock through foot bath. Advanced handlers have to stay behind handlers line. Open handlers have no restrictions. (20 points)(extra task).
5. **PEN WORK:** Take stock from Pen #3 to chute area in Pen #2. (5 points)
6. **ALLEY & CHUTE:** Move all stock thru the alley and thru the chute into Pen #1. (20 points)
7. **PEN WORK:** Take stock from Pen #1 to Pen #3. (5 points)
8. **SORT:** Advanced handlers will sort 3 marked cows from Pen #3 into Pen #5 & put remaining 2 unmarked cows into Pen #6. Open handlers will sort any 3 cows from Pen #3 into Pen #5 & put remaining 2 cows into Pen #6. (25 points)
9. **PEN WORK:** Take cows from Pen #5 & Pen #6 to Exhaust Pen. (10 points)

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as “Applicant”). (2) “Releasees” here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant’s dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant’s dog/Applicant’s property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant’s dog/Applicant’s property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant’s dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant’s promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the total cost for a QT number?

The cost for membership (required) is **\$20 per owner** if not already a current member.

- Membership expires in one year and only needs to be renewed if applying for another dog after membership has expired.
- Owners will need to renew their membership each year to keep track of dog's scores/titles in the online member portal. To sign up for an online account, please visit www.asca.org and click "Register" under Member Login (must have member ID#).

Membership fee in addition to the QT number fee of **\$20 per dog**.

A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog and will not expire.





For one dog with one owner, the total cost is **\$40**. For two dogs with one owner, the total cost would be **\$60**. For one dog with two owners, the total cost would be **\$60**. (This is assuming no owners are current members or under 18).

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number to compete in ASCA Agility, Stockdog or Dock Jumping events, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You must have a QT number to compete in ASCA Obedience, Rally and Tracking Tests.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

To have ASCA keep track of your scores and receive title certificates for your accomplishments.
