**No bitches in season will be allowed to compete.**

**All ASCA Rules will be followed! THIS IS NOT A MATCH!**

All dogs will be competing for obedience titles through ASCA. Each entry form must have a current registration number (ASCA or recognized registry) and be completely filled out, no exceptions. If your dog has earned titles through any other registry, but not ASCA, your dog will be required to begin in Novice. Attention Obedience and Rally Exhibitors! ASCA implemented a new policy as of 1/1/04 stating that every non-ASCA registered dog must acquire a 'tracking' number if you wish to compete. This is a one-time fee of \$20 per dog and a one-time \$20 ASCA service membership to establish the tracking number. You will be able to apply for a tracking number the day of the trial, if your dog does not have one.

### **EMAIL ENTRIES WITH PAYPAL PAYMENT ACCEPTED AS FOLLOWS:**

- Entries must be submitted on official ASCA entry forms.

- Forms must be filled in completely and signed. Please type or write legibly.
- Email completed entry forms to the correct trial secretary.
- Payments should be made via PayPal to **kentuckyasc@gmail.com**
- For payments to be accepted, please include your name and the events you are submitting payment for. Payments without proper identification will not be accepted.
- Please add a 5% processing fee when submitting your payment. This fee must be included at time of payment to be accepted.  
 For example: Jane Doe wishes to submit \$65 of entry fees via PayPal for Obedience and Rally. She would email her completed signed form to the show secretary and send \$68.25 (entry fees plus 5%) with the note "Jane Doe – Bluegrass 2 obed, 2 rally entries."
- Upon receipt of BOTH the properly completed entry form and the PayPal payment confirmation (with fee), your entry will be processed.

**No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA programs or not in good standing with ASCA.**

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

Please make all checks payable to "**OFKYASC**"

Payment in full must accompany all entries and be in US Funds. A \$30 NSF charge will be applied on all returned checks. ALL entries are non-refundable!

Conformation classes will receive flat placement ribbons. Rosettes offered for WD, WB, RWD, RWB, BOW, BOS, and BOB awards. Rosettes offered for Best Puppy, Best Opposite Puppy, Best Veteran, and Best Opposite Veteran. Junior Showmanship will receive flat placement ribbons. Rosettes offered for Best Junior, Reserve Best Junior, and all Peewee and Sub Jr entries.

Regular Obedience and Rally classes receive 1st – 4th place ribbons. Qualifying score ribbons to all qualifiers in Obedience and Rally classes. Rosettes provided for High in Trial, High Combined, HIT Junior, and New Titles. If expecting a Championship in Obedience or Rally, please email the Show Coordinator by August 10.

Obedience and Rally trials are open to all breeds and mixed breeds. This is not a match. Corrections and training are NOT allowed in the ring.

Crates and equipment may be left at the show site at your own risk.  
Water available on-site. No booster bath.

Please use designated exercise areas. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs. If an exhibitor is observed violating this policy at the show site or motels, they will be removed from our mailing list and not allowed to return to future shows.

No puppies under the age of 8 weeks allowed at the show site.

Any handler, owner, or spectator using excessive corrections or abuse towards a dog or exhibiting poor sportsmanship while at the show site will be asked to leave for the duration of the show weekend.
