**RVs & Camping** Either fully self-contained vehicles (RV's) or tent campers spots are available to exhibitors on show grounds for a nominal fee of \$20/per night for RV's and \$10 per night for tent campers. PLEASE SEND A SEPARATE CHECK IN WITH YOUR ENTRIES

**Arrival & Departure:** Exhibitors may arrive Friday August 26<sup>th</sup> to set-up no earlier than 4pm, Exhibitors must leave after the conclusion of the last show on Sunday in a timely manner.

**Show Facilities and Grounds:** All Events will be held on Grass. BRING YOUR SHADE. RV and tent camping will be on Grass, Porta-Potty's are provided.

**Potluck:** There is a covered picnic area, which the club will have a potluck for Saturday and Sunday lunch.

**Grooming:** There is limited electrical at the grassy area where the RV spots are located. Grooming spaces with electric on the grass in the RV area that did not have a space reserved are available. These may be rented day of show for \$10/day, limited quantity. Extension cords may be used for the \$10 fee if there is no longer space in the RV area. Please be mindful about where cords are run, cords can pose a tripping hazard to other exhibitor and their dogs.

Generators are allowed to be used between the hour of 6am, and 9pm only and not near any ring. Please be aware that carbon monoxide is hazardous can be harmful to you, your dog and others. It is advised you should have an exhaust flow pipe attached to the generator to vent the fumes upward and away from others.
