Be sure to fill out ASCA® stock trial entry forms completely (one per dog) and indicate T1, T2, T3 trial, and cattle/sheep/ducks, where applicable on one entry form. All entries must be accompanied by payment. Please write legibly! Incomplete or illegible entries will not be accepted. Acceptance of Entries: All entries will be put in order of postmark date beginning with the Pre-entry opening date. Entries postmarked after September 9th or received after September 12nd regardless of postmark, will be considered day of show entries. Day of show entries will be accepted until the trial fills. **No entries will be accepted after the first run of the day.** Once the trial fills, additional entries will be put on a waiting list as per ASCA rules unless the applicant requests otherwise. Applicants preferring an immediate return of their application and fees if the trial is full should include instructions with their application along with a self-addressed stamped envelope.

Divisions will run for all classes of stock: Advanced, Open, Novice, Junior, FEO and Started.

Stock to be Used: 5 head per run of ducks, 3-5 head per run of sheep, and 3-5 head per run of cross bred beef cattle. Cattle will be dog broke (have been exposed to dogs). Owners of dogs will be held responsible for all injuries to livestock during their runs. Replacement costs are: \$50.00 per duck, \$200 per sheep, and market value per cow unless posted otherwise at time of trial.

Stock Entry Limits:

Cattle – 16 runs/day unless pre-entries exceed this limit. If pre-entries exceed 16 runs/day we may offer up to 20 runs/day. At the time of pre-entry closing if there are fewer than 16 runs/day, we will allow gate entries up to 16 runs/day.

Sheep – 24 runs/day

Ducks – 16 runs/day

Awards for each Trial: Placement ribbons (1st thru 4th place) and rosettes for High in Trial - Cattle/Sheep/Ducks, High in Trial Aussie, High in Trial Other Breed. Most Promising Started Aussie and Most Promising Started Other Breed (highest Started run). High in Trial Open Working Junior, High in Trial Junior Handle. Ribbons will be given out at the end of each day.

Weekend Awards: High combine WTCH and High Combine Non-WTCH belt buckles will be awarded at the conclusion of Sunday's trail. Both awards will be based on highest combined scores (sheep, cattle, and ducks) accumulated over all three weekend trials. Both belt buckles are only awarded to Australian Shepherds. These awards are in honor of Wynona - HOF WTCH ASCA Ch / AKC Bronze GCh Buff Cap Winter Rose AFIDsm OFTDd RTDc.

Day of Trial Information:

- Draw (Run Order) will be posted prior to start of trial.
- Bitches in season will run in draw order.
- Bitches in season will remain crated when not competing.
- **All dogs must be on leash or crated when not competing. (Flex leads are not permitted on the grounds)**
- Harassing of stock will not be permitted – run may be called by judge or stock owner.
- Changes and/or substitutions, other than natural division progressions, must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing the evening before the trial.
- Move-ups are allowed with written notification to the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial.
- Entry fees will be refunded only when a dog has been certified by a licensed veterinarian as unable to compete due to sickness or injury. Owner will be responsible for all vet fees.
- Pre-entry deadline: Postmark no earlier than July 29, 2022 for Australian Shepherds and August 1, 2022 for all other herding breeds. Pre-entries will not be accepted after September 9, 2022 (postmarked). No telephone, facsimile, email, or incomplete entries will be accepted.
- **All entries must be on ASCA® entry forms with proper fees included.**
- Please use one entry form per dog.
- Note that the T1, T2, or T3 designation on a trial does not indicate or restrict the order in which the trials will be held.
- **Run limits and judging assignments are subject to change.**
- **Selling runs individual to individual will not be permitted.**
- If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run and there is a waiting list, the transaction must be handled by the trial secretary. All offers to sell runs must be submitted in writing at least one hour before the trial starts. No exceptions.
- Please clean up after your dogs.

Miscellaneous Items:

- Extended Flexi-type leashes are not allowed on the trial site.
- All ASCA® rules will be strictly enforced.
- Individuals will be responsible for any damage done to the stock and /or equipment. ASCA®, Rock River Australian Shepherd Club, and its club members will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to persons, dogs or equipment of any competitor or spectator.
- Non-ASCA® registered dogs may enter the stock trial without a tracking number, however, only those with a tracking number will be awarded ASCA® titles upon completing title requirements.

ASCA® Tracking Number: Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA® registered dogs—In order to have ASCA® qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA® titling certificates, each non-ASCA® registered dog will be required to have an ASCA® tracking number. This requires a one time fee of \$10.00/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA® member (minimum is Service Membership: cost \$10.00.)
