**Veterans:** 7 to under 10 yrs, 10 to under 13 yrs., and 13+ yrs, (divided by sex)

**Altered & Intact:** 6-9, 9-12 12-15, 15-18, Novice, American Bred, Bred By, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed.

- Rosettes and prizes will be given for Best Junior, Reserve Junior, Best of Breed Puppy, Best Opposite Sex Puppy, Best Veteran, Best of Opposite Sex Veteran, Altered & Intact Winners Dog/Bitch, Altered & Intact Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch, Altered & Intact Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, and Best of Winners. There will be 5 Altered Premiers and 10 Intact Premier rosettes per sex. Rosettes will be given for class placements 1-4.

- Limited, temporary ring-side crating will be available, but NO grooming or grooming tables will be allowed in the Exhibit Hall, and crates must be removed at the end of the day.
- Judging will be on concrete with matting.
- NYASA, ASCA, and the Brazos County Expo assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children. Children are to be supervised at all times.
- Any handler, owner, or spectator being abusive towards a dog or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the show site for the duration of the show.

### **Entry Information**

- Entries postmarked before the opening date, July 1, 2022, or postmarked after the pre-entry closing date, Sept 30, 2022, will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
- Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if written notice of cancellation is received prior to October 29.
- Show Secretary is Linda Braun, 518-428-8778.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35 service charge for returned checks.
- All dogs' ages will be calculated by their age on October 29, 2022.
- Do not send copies of registration papers with entries, but be prepared to present papers on all dogs six months of age or older.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations.
- No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program, a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- This show will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.
