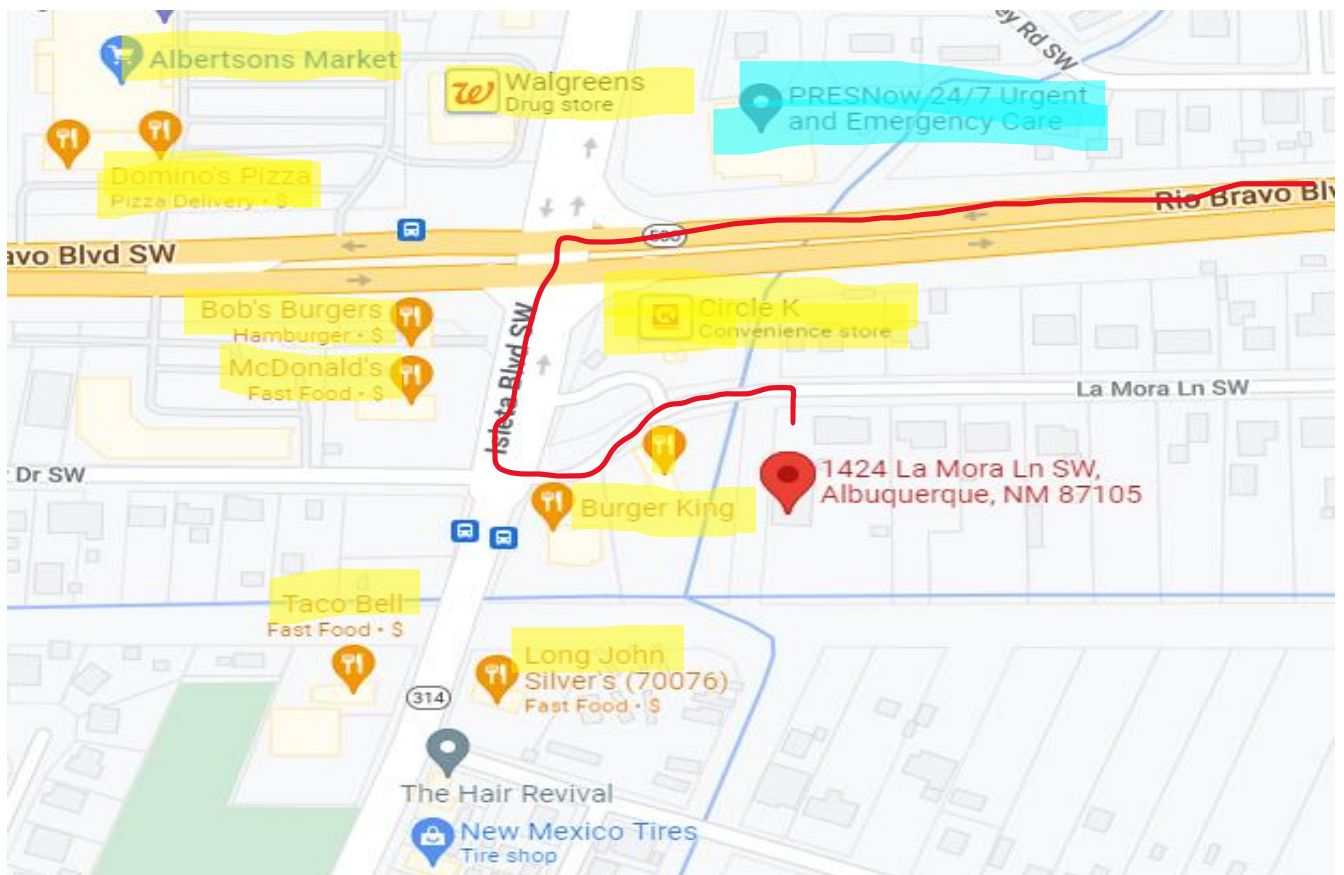

Entry Info: Pre-Entries must be postmarked no later than November 28, 2022

Day-of Entries will be accepted prior to each conformation show.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS OF ENTRIES: Checks will be deposited upon receipt.

Entries will be refunded in the form of vouchers for the next AASC or RRASC show if the show is cancelled for any reason. Weather for this time of year will be cold in the morning and “who knows” during the day in NM. We suggest you dress in layers.

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America, Inc. (“ASCA®”). Blank Entry forms will be available at the show.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA or AASC or RRASC. All ASCA rules apply.

IMPORTANT NOTICE & INFO:

Covid rules for the state of NM will be followed.
