All Regular Rally Classes Offered starting with Masters, then Excellent, then Advanced, then Novice

Awards

Strip ribbons for placements in each class. Rosettes and prizes will be awarded for High Scoring Australian Shepherd, High Scoring Other Breed, High Combined, and High Scoring Junior Handler. Qualifying scores will receive a green strip ribbon. Qualifying scores of 195 or higher will receive dark green strip ribbons indicating an "X" qualifying score. New title ribbons will be available for those finishing a Rally title.

Entry Limits and Refunds

40 runs per trial – Entries will be returned once maximum is met

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From the East, North & South: Hwy-95 merges with Hwy-12 West; stay on Hwy-12 across bridge and turn right onto Main Street Bypass; turn right onto 18th Street and continue on Dike Bypass toward Snake River Ave; turn right onto Snake River Avenue; at traffic circle take 1st exit and continue on Snake River Avenue (becoming Tammany Creek Road; go approximately 6.5 miles beyond traffic circle and Snake River Four Paws facility is on your left. 987 Tammany Creek Rd, Lewiston ID 83501

From the West: From Hwy-12 turn right at first stoplight onto 15th Street; at 2nd stoplight turn left onto Fleshman Way; when crossing Southway Bridge, stay in right lane to exit off bridge toward Snake River Avenue; at stop sign turn left onto Snake River Avenue (becoming Tammany Creek Road). Go approximately 6 miles and Snake River Four Paws facility is on your left. 987 Tammany Creek Rd, Lewiston ID 83501.

SITE INFORMATION

These events will be held indoors on dirt, rubber, or turf (facility is currently dirt, but hopefully, rubber or turf should be laid by trial dates). Ample shade, parking and crating areas are available. There will be NO food concession on site. Fast food restaurants are within 15-20 minutes of the trial site. Snacks and drinks will be provided for workers.

Please clean up after your dog and yourself at the trial site. Those not cleaning up will be dismissed from the trial at the discretion of the trial committee.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ASCA Rally and Obedience trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs. You will need a **QT** number to enter a Rally or Obedience trial. If your dog is not ASCA registered and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA tracking number and include it on the entry form.

An ASCA Service Membership and Tracking Number form is available at <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf>

The postmark (not the delivery date) will determine the entry order. Any Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient signature.

There will be a \$25.00 service fee for any returned check. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Confirmations and other communications are sent primarily via e-mail. It is your responsibility to make sure the secretary's e-mail address (jerriedavidson7909@gmail.com) is allowed by your spam blocker, and to change options that strip attachments from e-mails.

Final confirmations will be sent to the e-mail address provided on the entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the confirmation within 7 days of the closing date, contact the Trial Secretary Jerrie Davidson.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

These trials are sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America with Hells Canyon Australian Shepherd Club as the sponsoring club.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of these trials including the following:

- All healthy, trained dogs are eligible to compete in ASCA Rally & Obedience trials.
- Exhibitors should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the Rally and/or Obedience trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in sufficient control to perform all the obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the Rally and/or Obedience trial.
- Exhibitors agree that if their dog(s) is(are) left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- No food, toys, tents, crates or other aids or devices shall be permitted with 10' of the ring.
- All dogs shall be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.
- The organizing committee may not refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization. Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels and division are included in the current ASCA Rally and Obedience Rules and Regulations Handbooks. A copy of these handbooks may be downloaded free from the ASCA website: www.asca.org.
