OTHER INFORMATION:

- **Entry fee refunds will be issued after close of pre-entries only if there is a waiting list and somebody takes your run.**
- Substitutions will be allowed only with a dog owned by the same person making the original entry.
- Entry fees must be made with U.S. Check/Cashier's Check/Money Order.
- Entries received without proper signatures, fees, information, etc. will be deemed incomplete and will not be accepted.
- Registered Owner of dog shall be responsible for replacement cost of livestock at the following prices: DUCKS \$40 per head, GEESE \$50 per head. SHEEP - \$200 per head, CATTLE current MARKET Value.
- Confirmation of entries shall be made via email or self-addressed stamped envelope (if supplied).
- The Trial Committee will draw run order prior to the trial.
- Bitches in season will run in order.
- This trial shall be run under all ASCA Rules and Regulations.
A \$50 service fee will apply to all returned checks. Returned checks will not constitute an accepted entry.

From NW Valley:

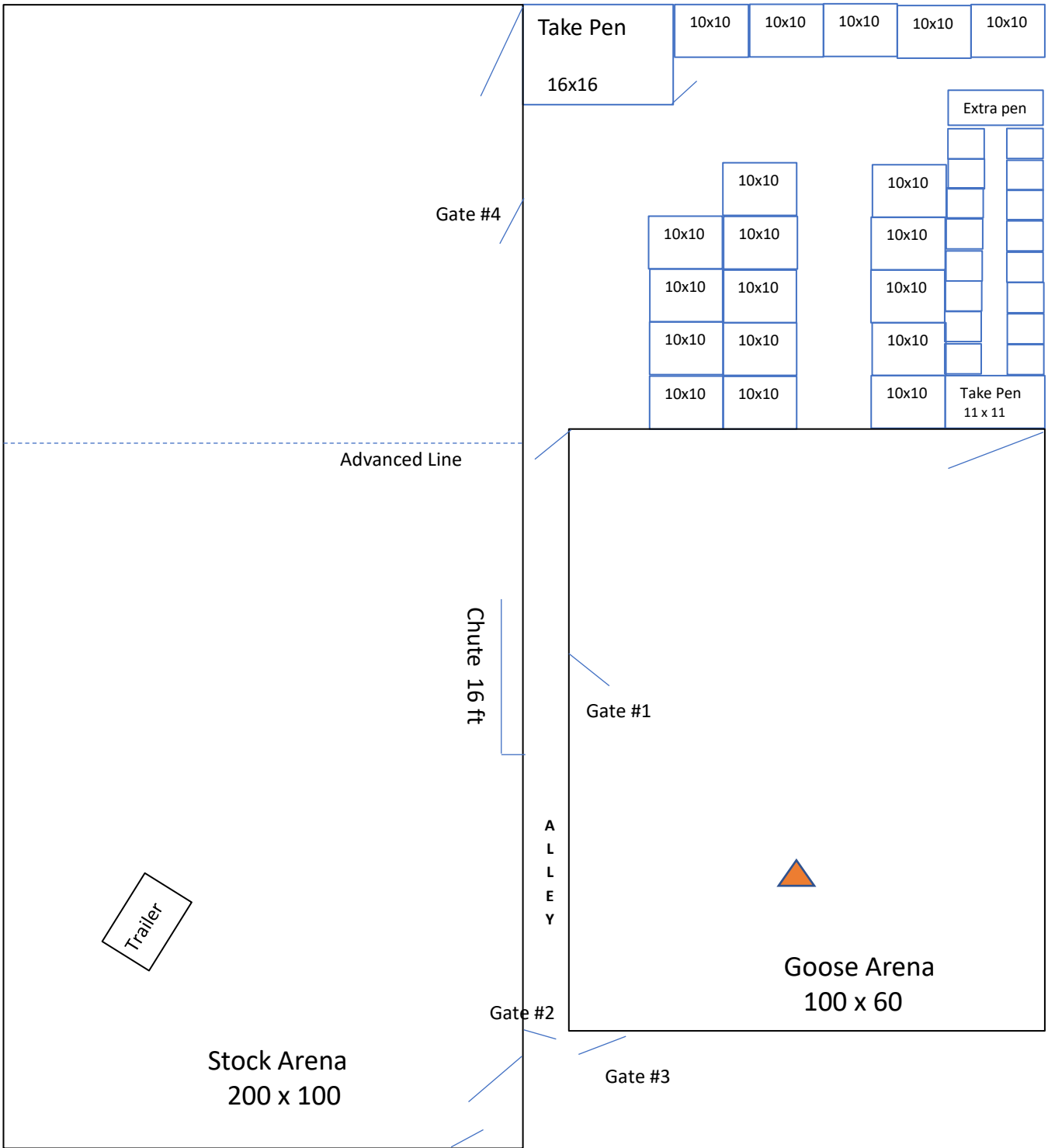
Take the 101 Hwy to the Northern Ave and exit West (right) onto Northern Ave; Northern will become the Northern Parkway just west of Dysart. Continue west on the Northern Parkway until Reems, exit south (left) onto Reems, turn west (right) back onto Northern Ave. Turn south (left) on Alsup. Fastlane is located about ½ miles south of Northern on the East side (left) of Alsup.

From SE Valley:

Take I-10 west to the 303 and exit north (right) onto the 303. Turn east (right) onto Glendale Ave., go approximately 1½ mile to Alsup: turn north (left) onto Alsup. Fastlane is located about ½ miles north of Glendale on the east side (right) of Alsup.

From Flagstaff:

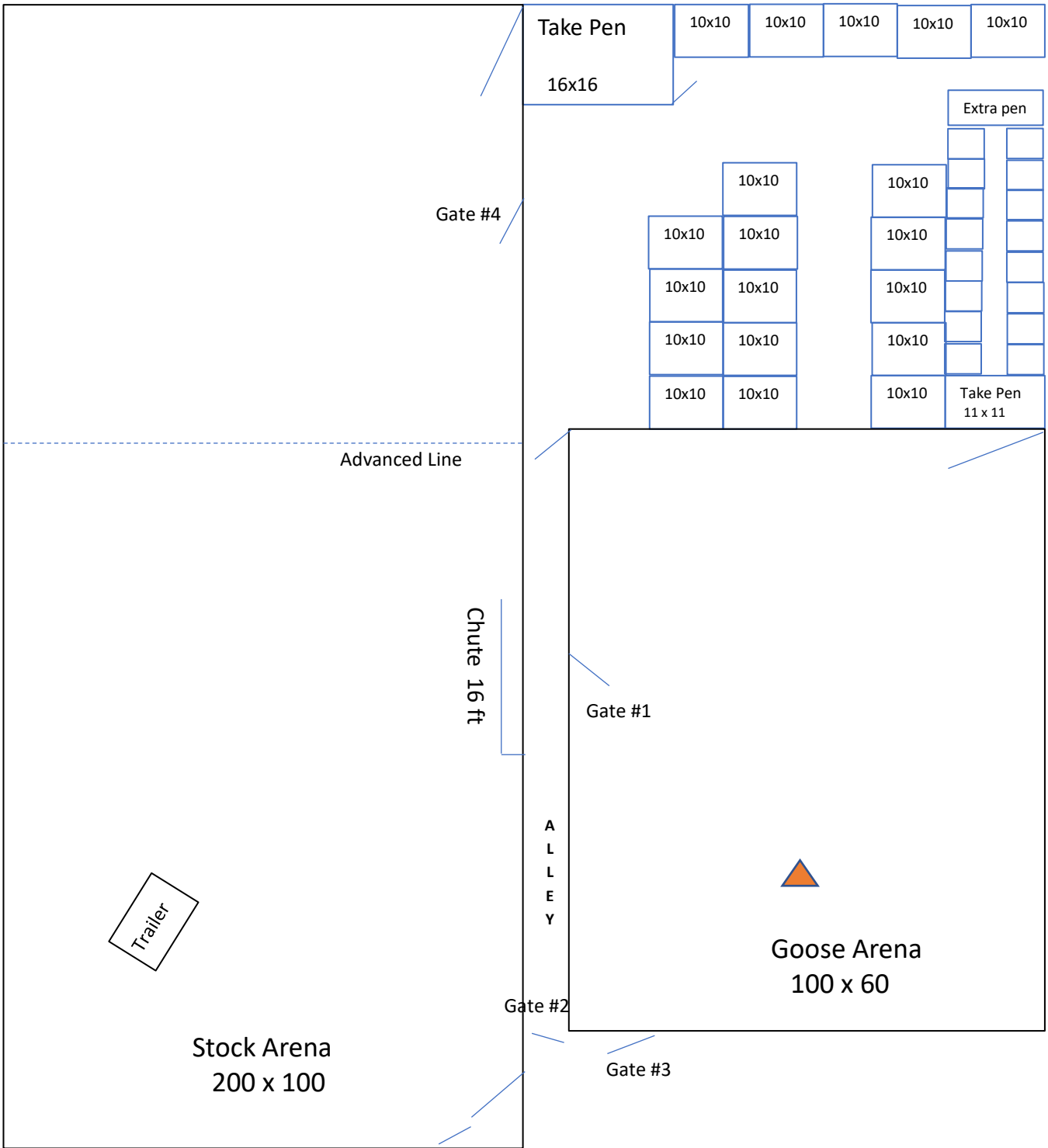
Take I-17 south to the 303 exit; take the 303 south to Glendale Ave and exit east (left) onto Glendale Ave, go approximately 1½ mile to Alsup: turn north (left) onto Alsup. Fastlane is located about ½ miles north of Glendale on the east side (right) of Alsup.



1. Take geese out of Take Pen & into Goose Arena. **Pen work 5pts**
2. Leave geese at end of arena, call dog off, take dog to cone & gather geese to cone. Adv handler send dog from side. Open handler dog at cone, handler may go halfway. **Gather 20pts**
3. Take geese into alley through gate #1, out gate #2 and back into goose arena through gate #3. Put geese into original pen through Take Pen. Adv handler must stay at gate #1 until geese are at gate #2. Open handler may go anywhere. **Location specific 20 pts**
4. Take 1 assigned pen of sheep and put into Take Pen. Take dog out through gate #4 into sheep arena. **Pen work 10 pts.**
5. Take sheep from Take Pen into arena, **Pen work 10pts**
6. Take sheep into chute, spray, open gate and exit chute. Adv handler must drive sheep into chute from Adv handlers line. Open may go anywhere along chute. **Chute 20pts**
7. Take sheep to and load into trailer/unload and go to Take Pen. **Location specific 20pts**
8. At Take Pen sort 3 sheep into Take Pen. Put remaining sheep into original pen through gate #4. Adv handlers must sort 3 marked sheep. Open handler must sort 2 marked plus 1 other. **Sort 20**
9. Take sheep out of Take Pen and put into original pen with remaining sheep.

Time allotted: 20 mins

Tie Breaker: #1 Alley, #2 Sort, #3 Pen



1. Take out 1 assigned pen of sheep and put into Take Pen. Take dog out through gate #4 into sheep arena. **Pen work 5 pts.**
2. Take sheep from Take Pen into arena, **Pen work 10pts**
3. Take sheep into chute, spray, open gate and exit chute. **Chute 20pts** Adv handler must drive sheep into chute from Adv handlers line. Open may go anywhere along chute.
4. Take sheep to and load into trailer/unload and go to Take Pen. **Location specific 20pts**
5. At Take Pen sort 3 sheep into Take Pen. Put remaining sheep into original pen through gate #4. Adv handlers must sort 3 marked sheep. Open handler must sort 2 marked plus 1 other. **Sort 25**
6. Take sheep out of Take Pen and put into original pen with remaining sheep. **Pen 5pts**
7. Take geese out of Take Pen & into Goose Arena. **Pen work 5pts**
8. Leave geese at end of arena, call dog off, take dog to cone & gather geese to cone. Adv handler send dog from side. Open handler dog at cone, handler may go halfway. **Gather 20pts**
9. Take geese into alley through gate #1, out gate #2 and back into goose arena through gate #3. Put geese into original pen through Take Pen. Adv handler must stay at gate #1 until geese are at gate #2. Open handler may go anywhere. **Location specific 20 pts**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the total cost for a QT number?

The cost for membership (required) is **\$20 per owner** if not already a current member

- The dog owner’s membership expires in one year and only needs to be renewed if applying for another dog after it has expired.
- Owners will need to renew their membership each year to keep track of their dog’s scores/titles in the online member portal. To sign up for an online account, please visit www.asca.org and click “Register” under Member Login (must have member ID#).

Membership fee is in addition to the QT number fee of **\$20 per dog**.

The QT number for the dog will not expire. If the owner is not a current service member, the total cost for one dog plus one owner’s membership is **\$40**. QT Numbers for two dogs with one owner’s membership would be a total of **\$60**. A QT Number for one dog plus two owners’ memberships would be a total of **\$60**. (This is assuming no owners are current members or under 18).

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number to compete in ASCA Agility, Stockdog or Dock Jumping events, unless you want to earn ASCA title certificates.
- You must have a QT number to compete in ASCA Obedience, Rally and Tracking Tests.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

To have ASCA keep track of your scores and receive title certificates for your accomplishments.
