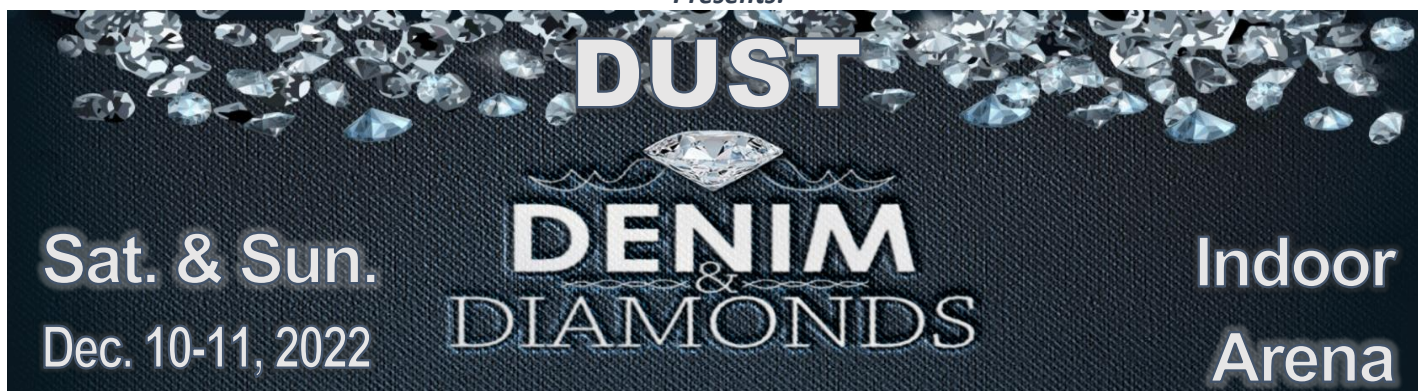

**General Information:** This is an ASCA sanctioned show and all ASCA rules apply ([www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org)). Dogs over six (6) months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available. High Plains ASC, the Show Secretary and Club Membership assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children or spectator. All dogs must be crated or leashed except while competing.

- **Entry Fees** will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies, or other events beyond the control of High Plains ASC. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, or the Judge.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA program or a person not in good standing with ASCA and/or High Plains ASC.
- Bitches in season are **NOT** allowed to compete in the Obedience Trials or the Rally Trials. Should a bitch be pre-entered in the trial(s), the owner may substitute the entry in that event.
- **VENUE:** These events will be held at Hobby Horse Farms indoor arena. Arena will be grated/leveled prior to the event to ensure even surface. The arena material is sand. **Indoor set-up space is plentiful and FREE of charge. Minimal electrical outlets (for dryers, etc.) are available; please plan to bring power strips and plan to share accordingly.** Building will be open at 8:30 a.m. **This building is not heated.**
- **ATTIRE: The theme of this event is: DUST, DENIM AND DIAMONDS. Judges and Exhibitors are encouraged to wear denim and their “bling” for fun.**

**PRE-ENTRY DEADLINE:** Pre-Entries open October 28, 2022 and must be postmarked no later than **November 27, 2022** to qualify for Pre-Entry Fee Rates. Telephone, facsimile, e-mail, or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be on the official ASCA entry form with proper fees included. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and class(es) entered. Withdrawals of entries will be accepted until the pre-entry closing; thereafter, no refunds will be made.
