Entry limit 25 runs per trial. A waitlist will be maintained when the limit is met.

Classes: Utility B/A, Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A, Novice C/B/A
Optional Titling: Beginner Novice B/A

Novice group exercises may be combined. Group exercises will be held after the individual exercises.

Policies: Only regular classes are eligible for High Score Awards. Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete in Rally or Obedience. Upon verification of being in heat by a veterinarian or by the Rally/Obedience Committee, the entry fee will be refunded if wished. All Breeds may compete, however, they are required to have an ASCA Tracking number. This number may be applied for at the show. Owners/Handlers entering Novice Obedience/Rally who has earned a RA or RE or an equivalent title in any other registry, must enter Novice B, Advanced B, or Excellent B Rally, as appropriate.

ASC of WA Entries: Day of entries added after the pre-entry closing date must pay day of entry fees. No refunds will be made if the show/trial cannot open due events beyond the control of ASC of WA. Entries must be on an official ASCA form with the agreement signed on the back. Information must be complete, legible, and indicate the day and whether AM and/or PM show. No mail will be accepted without waiver of signature and will be returned if this is not done. Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled prior to the closing date of pre-entries. Entry fees may be refunded if an owner presents the show committee, before the start of the show, a letter from a veterinarian stating the entrant should not participate due to health reasons. Returned checks from the bank will incur a \$20 fee. No entry will be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Directions To Site:

Traveling north/west on I-5, merge onto SR-16 West toward Bremerton. Continue 26 miles onto W State HWY 16. Merge onto SR-3 N toward Silverdale/Poulsbo. Take exit 45A toward Silverdale. Turn right onto Kitsap Mall Blvd NW toward Silverdale/Kitsap Mall. Turn left onto NW Randall Way. Take this road .5 mile and then turn right onto Silverdale Way NW. Turn left on NW Myhre Rd. Turn into the parking lot.

Notice To Exhibitors Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of these trials including the following: -All healthy, trained dogs are eligible to compete in ASCA Rally & Obedience trials. -Exhibitors should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion. -Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry. -Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the Rally and/or Obedience trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in sufficient control to perform all the obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the Rally and/or Obedience trial. -Exhibitors agree that if their dog(s) is(are) left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds. -No food, toys,

tents, crates or other aids or devices shall be permitted with 10' of the ring. -All dogs shall be on leash when not competing. -Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. -The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises. -Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. -The organizing committee may not refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization. Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed to enter the trial. Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels and division are included in the current ASCA Rally and Obedience Rules and Regulations Handbooks.
