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### ***CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS***

ASCA CANDIDATES shall:

1. Be a current adult ASCA full member in good standing.
2. A Director must be a current voting member of the Club and must have been a voting member of the Club for a minimum of eight (8) years prior to his or her election to the Board and must remain in good standing as a member during his or her tenure as Director. Must have access to e-mail when they are elected and take position on the Board.
3. Submit the following **electronically**:
  - Resume in electronic form on a plain 8 1/2 x 11 page (not including the candidate inquiry). Information should include, but is not limited to: address, email, and phone number as well as your vision for ASCA. Resume shall not exceed one page.
  - A completed "Declaration of Candidacy" form
  - Candidate Inquiry for publication in the Aussie Times and on the website
  - Signature on all candidate material must be in black or blue ink.

March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 is the deadline to **electronically** submit candidate's completed Candidate Inquiry to the Business Office.

Information and qualification statements will appear in the May/June AUSSIE TIMES.

All candidate material must be personally submitted by the candidate. ALL CANDIDATE MATERIAL MUST BE CAMERA READY. Non-compliance with the election requirements or filing instructions will result in the return of your candidate material by mail.
