AWARDS

First thru fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels.

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs.

Rosettes will be awarded for new titles.

Rosettes will be awarded for the following High in Trial awards:

CH Elite, CH Open, CH Novice, ACE Overall, Vet (CH), & JH.

HIT will be calculated based on highest total of qualifying points.

Ties broken by gambler points, then YPS.

No awards from this trial will be mailed.

If expecting to complete an ATCH or ACE-ATCH, please make a note on your entry form so we can order a Rosette for you.

EQUIPMENT

Trial equipment as follows: Rubberized, slatted A-frame (at 5'2") and dog-walk, rubberized teeter – unslatted, 4' jump bars, non-wing jumps, displaceable tire jump, tunnels, weave poles with 24" spacing. Equipment supplied by Agility Cues for You, Brooks, KY.

SHOW SITE / TRIAL INFORMATION

The trial will be run indoors on artificial turf in one 80' x 90' ring.

Follow on-site parking rules and directions.

Site has indoor restrooms. Site is climate controlled.

You will be required to clean up after your dog. Do not leave dogs unattended.

Lunch will be provided for VOLUNTEERS.

Indoor crating space available on a first come, first served basis.

Dogs requiring measurement should be measured prior to their first run.

Dogs with a wither height of 20" or less will need to be measured unless they have a permanent AKC, NADAC or ASCA height card.

- Double check on rates and charges. Call to confirm reservation before arriving.
- Please be honest about how many people and dogs will be staying in the room. Of course, as in standard agility procedure, all handlers/owners will pick up after their dogs. Please bag and dispose of dog waste properly.
- Do not groom dogs in rooms.
- Keep dogs off furniture. Please cover the motel's bedding with a sheet or blanket from home, whether or not you think your dog will get on the bed.
- Be sure to report any damage which may occur.
- Do NOT leave dogs unattended.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

Take I-65 North/South to Exit 121 (KY-1526 toward Brooks Rd).

Head West on KY-1526/John Harper Way (becomes Brooks Hill Rd).

Turn left onto KY 1020 S/Coral Ridge Rd. Go 1.4 miles.

Turn right onto Clear Run Dr. Go 0.3 miles.

Destination will be on the right.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America, with the Old Fashioned KY ASC as the sponsor club. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

- All ASCA® agility trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.
- Dogs do not need an ASCA® registration or QT number to participate in an ASCA® agility trial.
- If your dog is an ASCA® registered Australian Shepherd, fill in your dog's ASCA® registration number where designated on the entry form.
- If your dog is not an ASCA® registered Australian Shepherd and you would like to earn ASCA® titles, you need to obtain an ASCA® QT number for your dog. Any dog is eligible to get an ASCA® QT number (not just Australian Shepherds). Once you have an ASCA® QT number, use it as your dog's ASCA® Registration Number. The ASCA® Service Membership and QT Number Form can be obtained at the ASCA® website (<https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf>) and will also be available at the trial.
- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA® agility trials.
- Dogs must run WITHOUT a collar or harness of any kind.
- The handlers should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- No collars, leads, food, toys*, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start on lead, and then handing the lead to a steward. All dogs should be on leash when not competing.
- *See Agility Rulebook Section 9.1 "Handling Faults" for use of toys in ring.
- Exhibitors using toys for training in the ring will run in catalog order.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA® agility program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA® programs; or a member not in good standing with ASCA®.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Participation is a privilege afforded by the Host club and may be extended or withdrawn by the Host club's trial committee on suitable cause only. Refusal of such entries will be reported to ASCA®.
- The show is held on private property, please exercise your dog responsibly!
- A return check fee of \$25.00 will be charged for insufficient funds when checks are deposited.
- No substitutions of one dog's runs for another dog's runs regardless of the reason
- The Junior Handler Division is open to any dog that is being handled by a junior handler who is 17 years of age or younger. Dogs entered in the Junior Handlers Division classes may jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.
- The Veterans Division is open to any dog age seven (7) or older. Dogs entered in the Veterans Division classes will jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.
- A copy of the current ASCA® Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook may be downloaded free from the ASCA® web site: www.asca.org
- LEVELS: Exhibitors may enter at a level higher than they have titled, higher level scores will be applied to unearned lower level titles. Once you earn a qualifying score at a higher level you are NOT allowed to return to that lower level.

REFUNDS

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the pre-entry closing date. ALL REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS MUST INCLUDE OWNER'S NAME & ADDRESS.

JUMP HEIGHTS

Dog's Height	11" & under	14" & under	18" & under	20" & under	Over 20"
CH-Standard	8"	12"	16"	20"	20+ or 24"
Vets & ACE Std.	4"	8"	12"	16"	16+
ACE Senior	4"	4"	8"	12"	12+

- ASCA height rules allow dogs in 20+ category (measuring over 20" at withers) to jump in either 20+ or 24" jump height class if offered.
- Veterans must jump 4" lower than the dog's standard jump height.
- Junior Handlers may jump 4" lower than standard OR at the dog's standard jump height.
- Dogs with a wither height of <20" must be measured (or show an approved jump height card) unless they jump in 20"+/ 24" class (16"+ for veterans/ACE Std).
- A dog may be entered in a class at a jump height higher than they are eligible provided the dog is not entered in the Veteran Division classes.
- No dog shall ever jump lower than 4" in the Junior Handler or Veteran Division.
- 20"+ and 24" will be scored and placed together as one class.
- Refer to the current ASCA rule book for the current Breed Jump Height Exemption List.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON ENTRIES

- Entries received before entry opening date will NOT be accepted.
- Pre-entries must be POST-MARKED by pre-entry closing date.
- Day-Of Entries will be accepted if entry limits allow.
- Entries will be accepted for dogs without a reg./QT number.
- Please see the ASCA website for information on how to register.

- Do not mail your entries by any method that requires a signature.
- Entries must be submitted on the forms or copies of the forms supplied in this premium.
- Please double-check your entry form to ensure it is filled out completely and correctly.
- You must sign the release form.

After submitting your entry form, the last day for move ups before the trial will be Jan. 23rd. Trial Secretary will accept move-ups or changes by e-mail only. No changes will be accepted after this date. Move-ups will be allowed during the trial in-person within 15 minutes of last run on Saturday. Move up form will be available at secretary table.

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/ exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/ involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.
