These trials are sanctioned by ASCA. All ASCA trial rules & regulations apply.

AWARDS:

Obedience: 1st-4th place ribbons for each class; Qualifying ribbons for scores of 170 or higher; Rosettes for High in Trial in the regular classes, Highest Combined Score in Open B and Utility and Highest Scoring Junior Handler in the regular classes.

Rally: 1st-4th placement ribbons for each class. Qualifying ribbons for scores of 170 or higher; X-qualifying ribbons for scores of 195 or higher. Rosettes for High in Trial in the regular classes, Highest Combined Score in Masters B and Excellent B and Highest Scoring Junior Handler in the regular classes.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

Dogs must have an ASCA registration number, a LEP number or a QTracker number to participate in these trials. More information about and an application for a QTracker number is available at <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf>.

No entry will be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA Obedience/Rally or all ASCA programs; nor from a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Pre entries must be postmarked by Wednesday June 7, 2023 and received by 6:00 pm Wednesday June 14, 2023.

The daily entry limit for these trials is 60 runs. Once the daily entry limit is reached, the trials for that day will close. No pre entries nor day-of-trial entries will be accepted for trials that have closed. Neither will entry fees will be refunded for trials that have closed.

Pre entry fees: \$20 per class; \$15 discounted price for the second class that a dog is entered in at any one trial. (Note: there are two trials each day. This discounted price is only available for dogs entered in two classes in the *same* trial.)

Day-of-trial entries (for entries NOT postmarked/received by the pre entry deadlines): the entry fee is \$25 per class. There is no discounted price for additional classes. Day-of-trial entries (if available) will be accepted between 7:00-7:45 am for the morning trial and until 15 minutes before the afternoon trial. *Please contact the trial secretary before arriving to verify day-of-trial availability.*

Juniors pay half the pre entry or day-of-trial entry fees.

The entry forms were updated on **October 8, 2020**. Only these entry forms will be accepted.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$40 service charge for returned checks.

TRIAL HOURS:

The property will be open on trial days from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm: it will also be open the day before the trial from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm for set ups.

SITE INFORMATION:

The trials will be held at the 3987 N Livermore Ave in Livermore, CA. There is plenty of parking near the rings, but limited shade: well-staked canopies are recommended.

The rings are sited on well-groomed grass. Crates and chairs are welcome along the periphery of the field. (Canopies and x-pens are welcome everywhere else.) Warm-ups are permitted on the grass—but please potty your dog each time before entering the field.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

From San Jose: Take I-680N to I-580E (toward Livermore). Continue about 8 miles: exit at N Livermore Ave. At the end of the off ramp turn left (north). Continue about 2 miles. The trial site is on the right.

From Tracy: Take I-580W. After descending the Altamont pass, exit at N Livermore Ave (the fourth exit). At the end of the off ramp turn right (north). Continue about 2 miles. The trial site is on the right.

OVERNIGHT PARKING AT THE TRIAL PROPERTY:

Abundant overnight parking for RVs and car-camping is available. (Electrical hookups are not available, but water is available for filling RV tanks). Generators are allowed: if you intend to use them during trial hours or between 10:00 pm and 6:00 am you will be asked to park at a distance so as not to disturb others. There is no charge for overnight stays—but please reserve your spot with Rick Anderson (amoeba@pobox.com) when entering the trials.

Directions to Sage: left out of property onto N Livermore Ave; right onto I-580 W; in 7 miles exit at Dougherty Rd; turn right at end of off ramp and immediately merge into the left lanes; left turn at first light onto Dublin Blvd; in about one mile pass under the freeway; then at the traffic light turn right onto Amador Plaza Rd; in about 0.2 miles Sage is on the right, immediately past the REI. **It is recommended you verify this information before coming to the trials.**
