Courses: Post Advanced (Cattle/Sheep) A -CCW both trials; Arena (H-Setout-CW/Fri & Sat),(A-CCW/Sun)

Stock Description:

Ducks: 5 head feathered ducks - Replacement Cost: \$40

Sheep: 3-5 head hair or wool sheep - Replacement Cost: \$250

Cattle: 3 head beef - Replacement Cost: Current Market Value

Entry Package Deal: If entering All Classes of Stock in All Trials (except Post Advanced) the Total Entries will be **\$770** per dog.

Entries:

Entries will be accepted in postmark order. In case of duplicate postmark entries, a random draw will be conducted to determine the order of acceptance. Waitlist entry checks will be held until entry is accepted. Waitlist entries not accepted into the trial will be refunded or destroyed. Confirmation will be sent if an email address is provided.

NOTE: Only the newest version of the Stockdog Entry Form will be accepted.

Selling runs is not permitted unless the trial is full. If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run, the transaction must be handled by the Trial Secretary. All offers to buy or sell runs must be submitted to the trial secretary by 7:30am daily.

Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a voided entry. There is a \$75 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of cash, Money Order or Cashiers' Check.

Lunch info: A 30 minute lunch break will be announced at the handler's meeting. We will run Cattle/Cattle and Ducks/Ducks simultaneously, lunch, Sheep/Sheep. Direction to the trial site: From I-54, the trial site is just north of Alamogordo and South of Tularosa. - From I-54, head West on La Luz Gate Rd (traffic light) .04 mile. -Turn right onto Riata Rd (just over the railroad tracks) go 5.2 miles. -Turn left onto Gardner Road (highly decorated home on corner) and proceed ¼ mile to #52 on left .

Awards

1st place awards to all classes. 1st – 4th place ribbons. Qualifying score ribbons to all qualifiers in Arena classes. LOBO will provide rosettes and awards for each trial for Arena class High Score Sheep Aussie, High Score Sheep Other Breed, High Score Cattle Aussie, High Score Cattle Other Breed, High Score Ducks Aussie, High Score Ducks Other Breed, High Started Aussie, High Started Other Breed, High-In Trial Junior, and Novice Handler.

Rosettes and Buckle Awards will also be provided for High Combined Overall:

Buckles will go to **High Combined WTCH Aussie; High Combined WTCH Other Breed; High Combined Non-WTCH Aussie; High Combined Non-WTCH Other Breed; Most Promising Started Any Breed.**

Rosettes and special award for High combined Novice and High Combined Junior.

Award Requirements: To be eligible for any buckle, a dog must be entered in all stock. All 6 arena trial scores compiled as follows: all started scores count for the started (any breed) buckle; all open and advanced scores count for the non-WTCH buckles (Aussie & OB); and advanced scores for the (Aussie & OB) WTCH buckle. Juniors must enter two different stock in all weekend trials to be eligible for the buckle. Please indicate if your dog has a WTCH.

Post Advanced High Combined & Reserve High Combined will earn a separate award. Dogs must be entered in both Cattle & Sheep in both trials to be eligible. Only qualifying scores will count toward the PA awards.

Notices to Exhibitors

- **PLEASE REMEMBER** – If you have an issue or complaint, please direct to our **Course Director, Cappy Pruett**
- In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. A Tracking Number Application can be downloaded at <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf>
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- Additional entries will be made from a waiting list established in order of receipt by post mark date.
- Scores from the Junior Handler and Novice Handler Division are not eligible toward certification or special awards (i.e., Started/Open/ Advanced, Sheep/Cattle/Ducks, Weekend High Combined, etc).
- Should the entered dog injure stock, owner of the dog will pay for veterinarian services or will pay the market value of the stock (at the stock owner's option).
- Other Breeds - All herding breeds and mixes thereof listed as eligible to compete in ASCA Stockdog Trials are welcome.
- Training devices (mechanical and/or electrical) will not be permitted on trial grounds.
- Bitches in season are permitted and will run in draw order. When not in the arena, they must remain in their crate, away from the competition area.
- Each owner/handler is responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be confined or on lead at all times, except when competing. Dogs are not allowed to run loose on the trial site.
- This trial will follow all rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America.
- Exhibitors are expected to pick up after their dogs.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Weather in New Mexico can be unpredictable. Be prepared for anything. Heat and cold can be an issue for the dogs, especially their feet. Be prepared with either vet wrap or booties if necessary. Bring your own canopies; chairs; extra water/meals. Cool-off tubs will be provided for dogs. Water will be available on site. Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.

WE NEED YOUR HELP! Stockdog trials are inherently labor-intensive and require untold hours of work – months before the event; all during the event; and even after. Please consider helping by re-setting the arena(s) at the end of each trial day to make ready for the next day. Awards will be given out after the arenas are set.
