BRIEFING at 8 a.m. all days for ALL levels and stock. Trial starts at 8:30 am or directly after handlers Meeting.
Cattle will run first, then Ducks and onto Sheep each day.

ENTRIES & FEES: No telephone, facsimile, email or incomplete entries will be accepted. All entries must be on the most current ASCA entry form with proper fees included. www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/stockdogentryform.pdf . The entry limit per Judge will be accepted in postmark order. If a class of stock is full the dog will be put on a waiting list.

Selling runs is not permitted unless the trial is full. If the trial is full and you wish to sell a run, the transaction must be handled by the Trial Secretary. All offers to buy or sell runs must be submitted to the trial secretary at least one half hour before the trial starts.

Stockdog Trial Awards

1st place awards to all classes. 1st- 4th place ribbons. Qualifying score ribbons to all qualifiers in Regular classes. The following special awards and rosettes will also be given:

MASC will provide rosettes and awards for each trial for Regular class High Score Sheep Aussie, High Score Sheep Other Breed, High Score Cattle Aussie, High Score Cattle Other Breed, High Score Ducks Aussie, High Score Ducks Other Breed, High Started Aussie, High Started Other Breed, High-In Trial Junior, and Novice Handler.

Rosettes and Buckle Awards will also be provided for High Combined weekend: High Combined WTCH Aussie; High Combined WTCH Other Breed; High Combined Non-WTCH Aussie; High Combined Non-WTCH Other Breed; Most

Promising Started Aussie and Most Promising Started Other Breed. Rosettes and special award for High Novice, and High Jr.

Buckle Requirements: All 4 Trial scores compiled as follows: all started scores count for the started buckles, open and advanced scores count for the non WTCH buckles, and advanced scores for the WTCH buckle. Please indicate if your dog has their WTCH.

Notice to Exhibitors

- Entry forms can be downloaded at <http://www.asca.org/Portals/0/stockentwfill.pdf>.
- In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum "Service" membership is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA qualifying scores earned when applying for a Tracking Number. A Tracking Number Application can be downloaded at <http://asca.org/Portals/0/trackapp.pdf>.
- Use **only ASCA entry forms** that require exhibitor's or parent/legal guardian's signature on the back.
- **Correct amount must accompany entry form.** Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. There is a \$50 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of cash, Money Order, or Cashier's Check.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of a public enemy, strikes, or other causes beyond the control of MASC. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. Exhibitors must be in good standing with ASCA and/or MASC.
- **Run order** will be determined by random drawing by members of the Trial Committee the week before the trial. Gate entries will run last.
- Additional entries will be made from a waiting list established in order of receipt. Additions will be made prior to the start of the trial and are at the discretion of MASC. Fees will be refunded to the original entrant before close of entries only if a replacement dog is entered in place of the absent dog.
- Dogs entered in the Novice Handler Division **may not** compete in any other division on the same class of livestock on the same day. Dogs entered in the Junior Handler Division may compete in any other division on the same class of livestock on the same day. Scores from the Junior Handler and Novice Handler Division are not eligible toward certification or special awards (i.e., Started/Open/ Advanced, Sheep/Cattle/Ducks, Weekend High Combined, etc.).
- **Should the entered dog injure stock**, owner of the dog will pay for veterinarian services or will pay the market value of the stock (at the stock owner's option) see ASCA's Agreement on the back of the entry form). Market value of the stock has been determined to be \$1000 for cattle, \$400 for sheep, and \$75 for Ducks.
- **Other Breeds** - All herding breeds, and mixes thereof listed as eligible to compete in ASCA Stockdog Trials. Non-ASCA registered Aussies are considered "other breed." See Appendix 1, ASCA **Stockdog Rules and Regulations**.
- Training devices (mechanical and/or electrical) will not be permitted on trial grounds.
- **Bitches in season** are permitted, and will run in catalog order.
- Tied scores within the same class will be broken by time.
- Each owner/handler is responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be confined or on lead at all times, except when competing. Dogs are not allowed to run loose on the trial site.
- This trial will follow all rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. For a copy of ASCA's rules, go to <http://www.asca.org/Portals/0/StockdogRules.pdf>.

MASC reserves the right to substitute a judge and/or provide an overflow judge, if deemed necessary. Questions or conflicts during the event should immediately be brought to the attention of the Course Director.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Owners/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing. Children must be under direct adult supervision at all times.

- Mesquite ASC (MASC), it's officers and members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. Trialing is inherently dangerous, ground/footing is uneven. Knowing this, you assume full liability for yourself, dog and stock if any damage is caused by you or your dog to stock or others. By attending this event on private property, you agree to clean-up after your dogs **AT ALL TIMES** and remove any/all trash items upon departure.

Livestock: Crossbred Barbs sheep 3 head (value \$400 each) Beef Cattle X 3 head (value \$1000 each) Ducks 5 head (value \$75.00 each). Goats mixed breed (250.00 each).

From Tularosa, NM

Go South on US-54 W/US-70 W/St Francis Dr to light at Intersection of La Luz Gate. Turn right onto La Luz Gate Rd 0.4 mi.

Go over Rail Road Tracks Turn left onto Chihuahua Rd 1.0 mi. then make a Sharp right onto Wildcat Ln 0.5 mi after the left bend in road 1st drive on Left. Look for a very large bullet on the right.

From Alamogordo, NM

Go North on US-54 W/US-70 W/St Francis Dr to light at Intersection of La Luz Gate. Turn Left onto La Luz Gate Rd 0.4 mi.

Go over Rail Road Tracks Turn left onto Chihuahua Rd 1.0 mi. then make a Sharp right onto Wildcat Ln 0.5 mi after the left bend in road 1st drive on Left. Look for a very large bullet on the right.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: April in New Mexico can still be very hot; heat can be an issue for the dogs, especially their feet. Be prepared with either vet wrap or booties if necessary. **Bring your own canopies; chairs; extra water/meals.** Cool off tubs will be provided for dogs. Dry camping- **RVs, Campers, Trailers, or Tents may camp at the trial site. Please contact Gloria Damewood 575-491-2818. Water will be available on site. There are fast food restaurants within 5 miles of the site.** Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.
