GENERAL INFORMATION:

- PLEASE NOTE that these trials have limited entries. Once the limits are reached, we will put all additional entries on a Waiting List and notify exhibitors of their status.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from any or all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- Pre-entries will be refunded only upon written request received prior to close of pre-entries. No other refunds will be granted.
- All entries must be submitted on the latest approved ASCA entry form, for the event in which your dog is entered. Entry forms are available on the ASCA website, at www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms.

- Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. Writer of the check will be required to pay a \$50 administrative fee, in addition to all bank charges associated with the returned check. If the issue is not resolved within 10 days, the writer of said check will be reported to ASCA.
- No class changes will be made after close of entries.
- No bitches in season will be allowed to participate in any class in this trial.
- Dogs must be a minimum of 6 months of age to compete in any class in this trial. The age of all dogs will be calculated as of April 29, 2023.
- No classes will be judged prior to the posted start times on the schedule but may be judged later.
- **Venue:** Rally and obedience courses will be performed within the CVSG facility, a climate controlled – 7000 sq. ft. indoor facility, with artificial turf, which consists of an 8 ft x 70 ft designated crating area, due to space constraints, crating out of vehicles is recommended/preferred. Food and beverages are only allowed in the crating area. Building will be open to exhibitors at 7:30 am.
- **Local Emergency Veterinarian:** CVSG, 401 E County Line Road Littleton, CO, 80122. 303-794-1188. Open after normal business hours for full service, emergency care.

 - **From the South:** I25 North to Exit 194, E-470 North/CO-470 West toward Grand Junction to Exit 20 follow signs for Broadway – keep right heading to County Line Rd E, turn left onto E Phillips Ave – turn left into the parking lot.
