Aussie or Junior must be entered in all 6 shows and shown in at least 5 to be considered for High Point. Scores are tabulated based on 1 point per dog/junior defeated, Rally/Obedience dog (1 dog) must be entered in all 5 Trials and have the highest combined score including NQ scores.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation Program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. No sale of dogs on the show grounds

##### **Conformation: Regular Altered and Intact Divided by Sex**

6-9 month, 9-12 month, 12-15 month, 15-18 month, Novice, American Bred, Bred By Exhibitor,

Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Best of Breed

**Obedience:** Utility B/A, Open B/A/CDX/ODX, Novice B/A/C, Optional Titling Beginner Novice B/A, Sub Novice

**Rally:** Masters C/B/A, Excellent C/B/A, Advanced C/B/A, Novice C/B/A.

**Section 8:** All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or an ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned obedience trials. Photo copies of originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned obedience trials

#### **Obedience:**

Entries are limited to 25 runs per trial. After entry limits are reached there will be a waiting list for those entered. Move ups are permitted 30 minutes prior to each show. Refunds will be provided prior to the pre-entry deadline of May 19th, 2023. Group sits and downs will run after individual classes. Novice group exercises will be held after Novice individual exercises. No bitches in season may compete.

#### **Rally**

Entries will be limited to 30 runs per trial. After entry limits are reached there will be a waiting list for those entered. Move ups are permitted 30 minutes prior to each show. Refunds will be provided prior to the pre-entry deadline of May 19th, 2023. No bitches in season may compete.

### **Ribbons & Awards**

Flat ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>, Flat Ribbons to the winners BOSP, BOBP, BOSV, BOBV, RJH, BJH, Altered & Intact WD, RWD, WB, RWB, BOW, BOS, BOB

Awards will be given to Junior winners and Peewee handlers

New Title Rosette when a dog or bitch finishes a title

Obedience/Rally: Flat ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>, Rosettes: High Scoring Junior in Trial, High Combined Score in Excellent B & Masters B, High in Trial, High Combined, High Scoring Aussie, High Scoring Other Breed.

### **Directions to show grounds**

SOUTHBOUND: Take I-205 from north of Vancouver to Exit #9, OREGON CITY. Follow signs to 99E, which goes through Oregon City (it's about 8 miles from Oregon City to Canby). You can see the Fairgrounds to the right as you approach Canby. Look for FAIRGROUNDS road signs. OR Continue southbound I-5 through the Portland metropolitan area and take exit #282, Canby-Hubbard. Follow the directions to Canby and go to the north end of town. Look for the FAIRGROUNDS signs to the show site, which is on the west side of 99E. **WE WILL BE IN THE ORANGE LOT/GATE.**

NORTHBOUND: Take the DONALD-AURORA exit from I-5, turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp, proceed to Aurora (about 1 mile). Turn left onto 99E, go north through Barlow to Canby (about 4 miles). Go to the north end of town and follow FAIRGROUNDS signs to the show (to your left from 99E).

**WE WILL BE IN THE ORANGE LOT/GATE.**

### **Grounds and General Information:**

Show & Trial will be held outside on grass. Grounds open at 7 AM and close at 10 PM (Gates will be locked from 10 PM-7 AM daily). **Show grounds open Friday May 27th, 2023 after 3 PM, depart show grounds May 29th, 2023 by 3 PM.** There will be a designated grooming area. Electricity available for overnight RV's only.

### **Parking:**

Parking – in the show perimeter fence \$10 for the weekend or \$5 per day. Free parking only in **ORANGE LOT**. Extra vehicles along with paid RV or Camping must be parked in **ORANGE LOT** or they will be charged a \$10 per night parking fee. There will be other events on the grounds, so we must use the **ORANGE GATE**. This will be a ticket system, all payments can be made to NWASC and check in with Jewel.

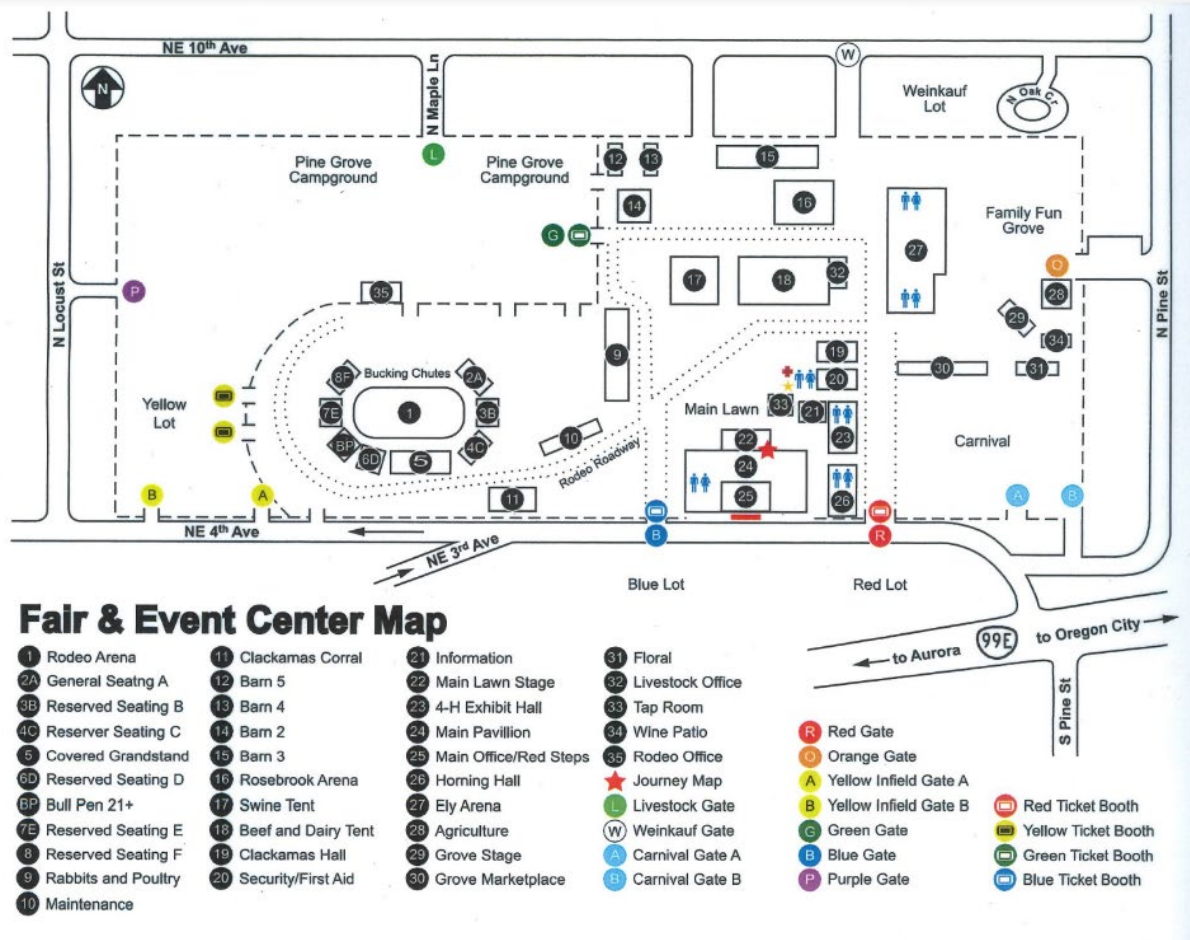
