Obedience

Regular Obedience – Utility B/A, Open, (ODX/CDX) B/A, Novice - levels B/A/C, Veterans can jump 4" lower
Optional Titling Class: Beginner Novice levels B,A, Graduate Novice,
Each trial will start with Utility. Novice group stays will be after the individual exercises
Limited to 60 entries for the day

Entries

Pre-entries: Open on 12/8/2023, close on 2/9/2024 or when the trial is full. Once the trial is full – you can request to be put on a waitlist or have your entry refunded. If the pre-entries fill the trial, there will be no day of show entries taken

No refunds after the pre-entry closing date***

***ENTRY CHECKS WILL BE SHREDDED IF THE TRIAL IS CANCELED.

Covid Guidelines: ASCNE will comply with all ASCA guidelines and Massachusetts State Law.

Please make sure you are aware of all guidelines in effect on the date of the show.

Day of show entries:

Will only be accepted if the trial does not fill during the pre-entry process. Same day move ups are allowed

Trial 1 - Entries taken 7:30 - 8:30. Trial starts at 9:00

Trial 2 - Entries taken 7:30 -10:00. Trial starts 1/2 hour after trial 1 ends

ASCA Information

- For information regarding what classes you may enter, refer to the rulebooks on the ASCA site: ..

- The Novice A Class is for handlers that have not placed a CD title on a dog from ASCA or any registry and the dog does not have an CD title from any registry.
- All dogs competing for ASCA titles are required to start at Novice and work through Utility regardless of titles awarded by other Registries.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA

Registration & Tracking

All Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months must be registered.
Effective January 1, 2004: All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or and ASCA tracking (QTracker) number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. The handler will be issued a receipt by the Registration table valid for sixty (60) days to allow the Business Office time to issue the tracking number. Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned Obedience or Rally Trials. Bitches in Season

- Handlers must notify the Show/Trial Secretary at least thirty minutes before the start of the trial if they plan to compete with a bitch in season.
- BIS must be crated (not placed in an exercise pen) at least 50 feet away from the obedience rings
- BIS must always wear pants in or within 50 feet of any obedience rings
- When it is time for BIS to compete, the team(s) will be allowed to warm up in proximity to the obedience ring(s) for a reasonable amount of time.
- BIS will compete, after all run offs and awards are completed, for legs and scores only.
- BIS entered in two trials on the same day will be allowed to run at the end of the first trial and again at the end of the second trial.

Site Information

- Show site is indoors on matting
- The show site is available Sunday at 7:30 AM until 3:00 PM or a half hour after the show is completed.
- Flexi-leads are not allowed in the building

Directions

From Rt.95 South of Attleboro **exit numbers could be changed

Take Exit 2A (Newport Ave.) to the 1st light. Take that left onto Cottage St. Go approximately one mile and turn Right onto Read St. Take 2nd Right onto Pond St. Watch for the Orion Industrial Park on your right (3/10 mile). Turn into the park, we are the second building on the left.

From Rt.95 North of Attleboro **exit numbers could be changed

From Rt. 95 North of Attleboro: Take Exit 3A Rt. 123. At the 2nd set of lights take a right onto County St. Follow along and after the Stone E Lea golf course take a left onto Read St. (There are signs for the animal shelter). Take the 2nd right onto Pond St. Turn right into the Orion Industrial Park in approximately 3/10 mile. We are the 2nd building on the left.

From Rte. 195 East or West **exit numbers could be changed

Take Massachusetts Exit 1. Follow 114 A (north). In approximately one mile you will reach a fork in the road, bear to the right (Grist Mill Restaurant will be on your left). This is Arcade Street. You will come to the intersection of Route 44. Go Straight across and continue on Arcade to the end. This is the Jct. of Route 152. Take a right onto 152 North – Newman Ave. Follow along for about 5 miles. You will come to the intersection of Central Ave. continue ½ mile and take a left onto Pond Street. Watch for Orion Industrial Park on the left (2/10-mile). Turn into the park, we are the second building on the left.
