**Directions to the show:**

From Loop 820, take Jacksboro Hwy (Hwy 199) west. Take Hwy 730 north for 6.8 miles. Make a right turn on Briar Road. Training building will be about a block up on the left.

**Trial Schedule for both days:**

Gates will be unlocked at 7:30 a.m.

8:00a.m to 8:15a.m. Registration and check-in.

8:30 a.m. Masters C/B/A Walk through

8:40 a.m. Masters C

All other classes to follow in the order listed on page 1 of this premium.

Lunch and breaks at judges' discretions.

**Fees: Please note the change in fees for 2024.**

Pre-Entry Price: \$18.00 for first regular class each dog, \$12.00 second regular class same dog/same trial. (Masters B and Excellent B, in the same trial).

Junior Entry Price: \$10.00 each class entered.

Day of Trial entries: \$25.00 each class entered

Day of Trial Junior Entry Price: \$15 each class entered.

Non-regular classes are \$10 for the first entry for each dog; \$8 for the second non-regular class entry and \$6.00 for the third non-regular class entry. For instance, Fido is entered in Novice Fast, Novice Pairs and Team Relay Rally, his entry fee for non-regular classes is \$24 which will be added to his regular class entry if he is entered in one of the regular rally classes.

Day of trial non-regular classes will be \$12 each.

**Awards:**Rally:

Qualifying scores will receive a green ribbon; X-Qualifying scores will receive a dark green ribbon; strip ribbons will be awarded for placements in each class.

Rosettes will be awarded for High Scoring Australian Shepherd, High Scoring Other Breed, High in Trial Overall, High Combined, High Scoring Junior Handler, High Scoring "C" Classes. New Title ribbons will be available for those finishing a title.

**Special Notices for Exhibitors:**

Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete in these trials.

Gates on Saturday and Sunday will open at 7:30a.m.

No harsh training is allowed on the trial grounds at any time. Please read the rules for the classes and events you are entered to make sure you have a full understanding of ASCA Rules and Regulations.

When not in a crate, dogs must be on leash and attached to a human except when in the ring being judged. No ex-pens allowed for crating inside the building. No tops or fronts of crates open when the owner/exhibitor is not sitting with the dog.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

All Entries must be on the CURRENT ASCA entry form only. Recent changes to the entry forms have been made. Please make sure you use the current entry form for rally. No other forms can be accepted. All entries must be signed. Rally entry forms can be downloaded at: <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/rallyentryform.pdf> .

All entries must be accompanied by a check or money order for the appropriate amount or will not be considered a valid entry and not be accepted for entry. Entry forms must be postmarked between 1/15/2024 and 2/15/2024. Do not send entries in a manner that requires a signature or a trip to the post office.

No entry fees will be refunded. Make checks payable to TCASC. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will be subject to a \$35 fee, and will also be reported to ASCA if restitution is not made in a very timely manner.

All dogs must have an ASCA registration number or an ASCA tracking number to compete, except those who submit their application for a tracking number with their entry. No entry will be accepted without a tracking number, registration number or a valid application with a check made payable to ASCA for a tracking number. Dogs must be entered in classes they are eligible to compete. Link to tracking number application: <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf>

NO dogs Under 6 months of age will be permitted at this trial.

The State of Texas requires a current rabies vaccination. All dogs over 12 weeks of age must have a current rabies certificate. A tag does not show proof of vaccination. Thank you for your cooperation.

Any handler or owner using excessive abuse towards a dog or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the Trial site for the duration of the Trial. No entry will be accepted by persons or dogs not in good standing with ASCA.

Grooming, crating, food, toys and dog treats must be kept at least 10 feet from the ring.

TCASC, their Boards of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
