Refunds:

- THERE SHALL BE NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the pre-closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal. Bitches in season may receive 50% refund if notification in writing or by email is received before the trial begins.
- There will be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW

Shows are held at Hidden Valley Obedience Club's fenced training field, next to the Mayflower Dog Park in Escondido, located at 3396 E Valley Pkwy, Escondido, CA 92027. Cross street is Beven Drive.

Show Ground information:

Day of Show parking is close by and free. Entry gate open and setups can start Friday at 2:00PM. Dry camping is available, no dumping, all generators off by 10pm. Port a potties are available on show grounds; grounds are on grass; pick up hair and don't leave any food on premises. Show site is located at a private facility.

Ring Surface: Outdoor/Show surface is grass

Grooming: No electricity available, Generators are ok to bring. Grooming in parking lot is ok, please do not take more than one additional spot next to your vehicle. Set ups can be left overnight. Bring Shade, tie-downs and generator if you need power

Food Options: Fast food and restaurants nearby. Lunch available on site (Donation recommended).

Weather: Please be prepared for any type of weather for both you and your dog. Bring shade and foul weather gear. Please stake all canopies.

JUNIORS: Pee Wee 3-5 & Sub Juniors 6-7 (no further competition), 8 - 12 & 13 - 17 (Divided into Novice & Open). Class winners to compete for Best Jr. Handler and Reserve Jr. Handler

NON REG: 2-4 months (divided by sex), 4 - 6 months (divided by sex) class winners to compete for BOB & BOS Puppy

**** VETERANS** will be shown immediately after puppies on SATURDAY AND SUNDAY ONLY**

ALTERED & INTACT: 6 - 9, 9 - 12, 12 - 15, 15-18, Novice, Am. Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black Tri, Open Red (divided by sex). Class winners to compete for Winners Dog or Winners Bitch; Winners Dog and Winners Bitch will compete with Specials for BOB

All classes will receive flat ribbons 1st thru 4th.

Rosettes to Best of Breed Puppy, Best of Opposite Sex Puppy

Rosettes to Best Junior and Reserve Junior. Flats for Sub Junior and Pee Wee

Rosettes to Best Veteran and Best Opp Veteran

Rosettes to WD, RWD, WB, RWB, BOW, BOS, BOB (Altered and Intact)

Rally Classes Offered and Run Order:

Masters C, B, & A, Excellent C, B & A, Advanced C, B, & A, Novice C, B & A

Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete per ASCA regulations.

Rally Awards

Qualifying ribbons, placement ribbons First through Fourth places. Rosettes for High in Trial, High in Trial Combined, High Scoring Aussie, and High Scoring Junior.

All non-ASCA registered dogs require an ASCA tracking number. No dog without an ASCA individual registration, LEP number or ASCA Q Tracker number may compete in any ASCA Rally Trial.

Trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA

Poor sportsmanship will NOT be tolerated. If anyone exhibits poor sportsmanship (i.e., yells at, curses at, harasses, etc.) any volunteer or competitor, he/she will forfeit their entries for the rest of the show weekend, and will be asked to immediately leave the show grounds.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s): Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Canine health: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Pomerado Australian Shepherd Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the ring. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Pomerado Australian Shepherd Club in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation
